
Score Card: 38 Geary Transit Lanes in the Richmond

Shorter trips for Muni customers

38/38R Geary travel times were up to 13% faster than pre-COVID levels after transit lanes were installed in spring 2021, even as traffic volumes began approaching pre-COVID levels.

Up to 13% faster



Number of daily Muni trips affected: 20,000 +

Transit lanes beneficiaries and equity

- 30% 38/38R Geary riders have household income <\$35,000
- >50% 38/38R Geary riders are people of color
- 83% 38/38R Geary operators say improvements make their job easier

Minimal traffic impacts
Change in peak-hour traffic speed, fall 2020 vs. spring 2021

Geary Boulevard	Control streets (25th Avenue, Arguello)	Parallel streets (Clement/Euclid, Anza, Balboa/Turk)
- 8% to -10%	- 6% to -9%	- 2% to - 4%

Peak-hour traffic speed reductions on Geary were similar to control streets, reflecting the citywide increase in traffic. Parallel streets had smaller speed reductions than Geary, indicating diversions to other streets are likely minimal.

Temporary emergency transit lanes and other transit improvements were installed along segments of Geary Boulevard in winter 2020-21 and evaluated in spring 2021.

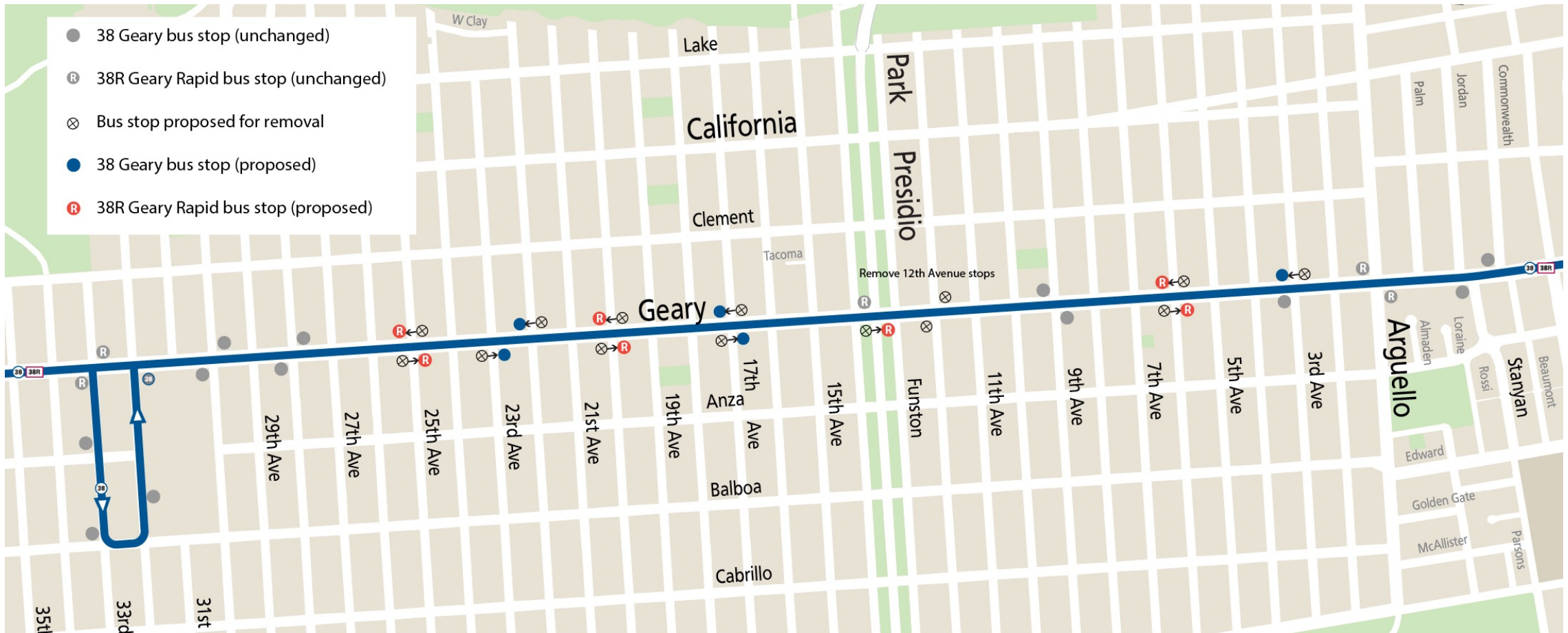
Draft proposed bus stop relocation/removal recommendations

Principles for bus stop re-location:

- 1) Moving bus stops from the nearside of intersections to the farside, so buses don't get stopped at red lights as often
- 2) Removing or consolidating closely-spaced stops to improve travel time reliability
- 3) Expand substandard bus zone lengths

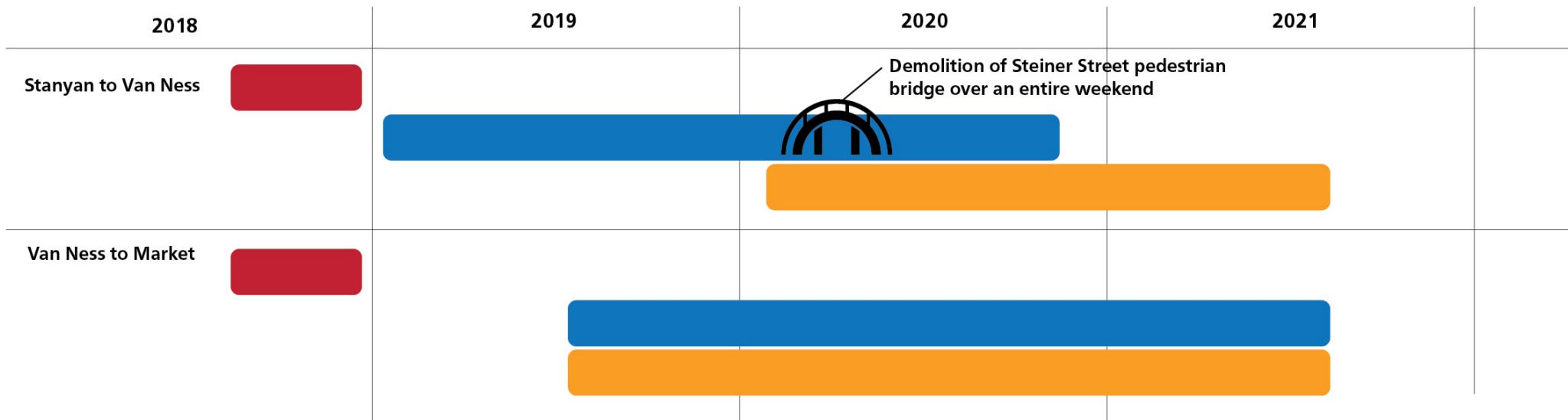

“Geary East” contract: Van Ness to Market Street

- All water mains are installed. Service connection work is underway between Stockton and Kearny streets.
- Sidewalk bulb-out work remaining on Geary at Mason and at Kearny.
- Begin private Verizon conduit work on Geary, pending cost share agreement.



11. Geary Rapid Project update

“West Surface” contract: Stanyan to Van Ness

- Work in “Segment A” at Steiner (Hamilton Rec Center) is nearly finished.
- Only work remaining in “Segment B” is the Buchanan crossing as well as railings and median pavers. Tree plantings are planned as well.
- Red thermoplastic is planned to begin west of Van Ness.
