15 Fell Street, south side, from 0 feet to 42 feet west of parking meter stall #1 (42-foot zone to be replaced by the metered motorcycle parking and relocated white zone described below).

ESTABLISH – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, AT ALL TIMES

15 Fell Street, south side, from 0 feet to 42 feet east of parking meter stall #11 (42-foot zone).

ESTABLISH – METERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING,

“5” Fell Street south side, from 42 feet to 64 feet east of parking meter stall #11 (44-foot zone).

ESTABLISH – METERED YELLOW LOADING ZONE, 7AM TO 6PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

“180” Fell Street, north side, from 106 feet to 146 feet east of Franklin Street, at parking meter stalls #32 and #34 (40-foot zone).

ESTABLISH – PART-TIME PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 9AM TO 9PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

380 Fulton Street, north side, from 10 feet to 70 feet east of the west property line, at parking meter stalls #328, #330, and #332 (60-foot zone).

ESTABLISH – GREEN ZONE

484 Union Street, north side, from 18 feet to 38 feet east of Grant Avenue (20-foot zone).
