## **SFMTA Transit and Traffic Advisory for Thursday, March 28, 2024 through Wednesday, April 3, 2024**

**San Francisco**—The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) releases the following upcoming event-related traffic and transit impacts for this week from Thursday, March 28 through Wednesday, April 3, 2024.

### **Events at Chase Center**

**Thursday, March 28 to Tuesday, April 2:** There will be multiple events to take place at the Chase Center:

- **Thursday, March 28:** First concert performance by [Bruce Springsteen](#) will start at 7:30 p.m. Doors will open at 6 p.m.
- **Sunday, March 31:** Second concert performance by [Bruce Springsteen](#) will start at 7:30 p.m. Doors will open at 6 p.m.
- **Tuesday, April 2:** The Warriors will play against the [Dallas Mavericks](#). Game will start at 7 p.m. Doors will open at 5:30 p.m.

### ***Supplemental Muni Service***

- Muni will operate supplemental **78X Arena Express** service.
- **Pre-event express shuttle service** from 16<sup>th</sup> Street BART Station to Chase Center will start two and a half hours before each game/event and will end one hour after game/event starts.
- **Post-event express shuttle service** from Chase Center on 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 16<sup>th</sup> Street BART Station will run until the area clears.

## Events at Chase Center *continued*

### ***Special Event Parking Rates***

During basketball games and other major events with more than 10,000 expected attendees at the arena, **parking meters close to the arena will charge a special event rate of \$10 per hour**. These rates help reduce congestion and keep parking spots available in the neighborhoods near the arena, discouraging circling for free or cheap parking. Start times for special event rates vary based on the start time of the event. ### ***Street Closures***

To accommodate events that will take place at the arena, the following street closures will be enforced two hours before and one hour after each event:

- 16<sup>th</sup> Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Warriors Way between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Northbound 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between 16<sup>th</sup> Street and Warriors Way will also be closed approximately 30 minutes before and 45 minutes after an event.
- Only local access will be allowed on Northbound Illinois Street between Mariposa and 16<sup>th</sup> streets.

### ***No Parking Zone***

To facilitate loading and pick up for Muni customers and patrons, NO PARKING will be in effect at these locations during events:

- 16<sup>th</sup> Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Warriors Way between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Terry Francois Boulevard
- Between the 500 and 700 blocks of Terry Francois Boulevard (TFB)

### ***Taxi Stands***

There is one taxi stand located on southbound Terry Francois Boulevard.

Ramp Taxis should use the loading zone on eastbound Warriors Way at Bridgeview Way.

### ***Additional Passenger Loading***

- 4<sup>th</sup> Street which connects to Chase Center via Gene Friend Way pedestrian path which cuts through UCSF campus.
- Owens Street connects to Chase Center via Gene Friend Way pedestrian path which cuts through UCSF campus.

### **Easter Sunrise on Mount Davidson**

**Sunday, March 31:** The annual Easter Sunrise Service at Mount Davidson Cross will begin at 7 a.m. The SFMTA will provide supplemental Muni service on the 36 Teresita route beginning at 5:30 a.m. until the start of the service from Forest Hill Station to Myra Way and Dalewood Way. After the service concludes, Muni will provide service from Myra Way and Dalewood Way to Forest Hill Station.

## **CONSTRUCTION WORK AND OTHER UPDATES**

### **NEW: F Line Motorization**

**Since Monday, March 25 and continuing through Saturday, April 6**, various construction projects will occur on Market Street that require Muni service adjustments. The full route of F Market and Wharves line will operate on Muni buses that display “F Market” during the construction. There will also be minor reroutes to the 5 Fulton, 5R Fulton Rapid and 19 Polk Muni lines.

### **UPDATE: L Taraval Improvement Project—Segment B**

The L Taraval Improvement Project is a multi-agency collaboration to improve safety, accessibility, and transit reliability, and to rehabilitate aging rails, utility lines and roadway pavement along the L Taraval line between Sunset Boulevard and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue and on Ulloa Street near West Portal.

Work to install new rails, boarding islands, boarding ramps and curb ramps continues throughout the corridor. The last remaining area of track installation work between 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Sunset Boulevard is in progress. Street base work continues in multiple areas. During street base work, the block will be closed between 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. for cement pouring and curing on one side of the street at a time. Parking and road restriction will be in place and release once the cement cures at the end of the day.

**Construction work performed and at locations:**

**Taraval Street**

- **15<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> avenues:** Curb ramp, boarding platforms and street base
- **19<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> avenues:** Street base work, build accessible and boarding platform
- **23<sup>rd</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> avenues:** Reconstruct sidewalks, boarding islands and accessible boarding platforms and street base
- **31<sup>st</sup> to 34<sup>th</sup> avenues:** Construct boarding island and platform
- **34<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Sunset Boulevard:** Track removal and installation

**Ulloa Street**

- **Forest Side to 15<sup>th</sup> avenues:** Sidewalk and driveway reconstruction, street base work and boarding island

**Nighttime work is scheduled from Sunday through Friday, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sundays through Fridays**

- **Ulloa Street between 15<sup>th</sup> and Forest Side avenues:** OCS prep work for installation, removing and reconstructing existing poles, upgrade the Overhead Contact System (OCS) that powers the trains. Work on any given block will vary and is expected to take a few hours to a few days per location. OCS work is expected to be completed in June 2024.

The L Bus now runs between West Portal and the SF Zoo. Customers can transfer to a train at West Portal Station to travel downtown. An interactive bus reroute map with temporary bus stop relocations citywide during construction can be found on [Interactive Bus Reroute](#).

**During construction, the L Taraval bus stops are being relocated. The inbound bus stop at Taraval Street and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue has been relocated across the intersection until fall 2024.**

**The following L Taraval bus stops are being rerouted temporarily during construction:**

- **48 Quintara/24<sup>th</sup> Street (Effective from Monday, Jan. 1 to Friday, April 12, 2024)**
  - Inbound
    - From 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Ulloa Street to Madrone Avenue and Ulloa Street, northwest corner

- Outbound
  - From Ulloa Street and Lenox Way to West Portal Avenue and Ulloa Street, southeast corner
  - From 14th Avenue and Ulloa Street to Taraval Street and 14th Avenue, northeast corner
  - From 14th Avenue and Taraval Street to northeast corner
  
- **L Taraval Bus / L Special / L Owl (Effective from Monday, Feb. 12 to Friday, April 12, 2024)**
  - Inbound
    - From Taraval and 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to Ulloa Street and 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, southwest corner
    - From Taraval Street and 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue to northeast corner (*28 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue stop*)
    - From Taraval Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Santiago Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, southwest corner
    - From Taraval and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue to northwest corner
  - Outbound
    - From Ulloa Street and Forest Side Avenue to Ulloa Street and Lenox Way, northwest corner
    - From Taraval Street and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Taraval Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, southeast corner
    - From Taraval Street and 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue to southwest corner (*28 Line Stop*)
    - From Taraval Street and Sunset Boulevard to northwest corner
  
- **L Taraval Bus / L Special / L Owl (Present to Fall 2024)**
  - Inbound
    - From Taraval Street and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue has been relocated to the southeast side of the intersection

## **ONGOING**

### **Masks Recommended**

Masks are no longer required, but are encouraged in any SFMTA facilities, transit hubs or on vehicles including Muni buses, streetcars, light rail vehicles or cable cars or in taxis or on paratransit.

### **ONGOING: Essential Trip Card Discount Program**

The SFMTA's program, [Essential Trip Card](#) (ETC) Program, assists people with disabilities and older adults to make essential trips using taxis. The program provides two to three round trips at an 80% discount per month, i.e. rider pays \$6 to receive a value of \$30 or pays \$12 to receive a \$60 value. If essential needs require it, riders may receive additional value up to \$120 of taxi service per month.

To qualify for the program, customer must be either age 65 or older or an adult with disabilities. Eligible adults may apply for the ETC program by calling the Paratransit Mobility Management office at 415-351-7053.
