ESTABLISH – YELLOW ZONE, COMMERCIAL LOADING, 30-MINUTE TIME LIMIT, 8AM TO 6PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

39 Isis Street, east side, from the south property line to 18 feet northerly and 5 feet southerly (23-foot zone)
