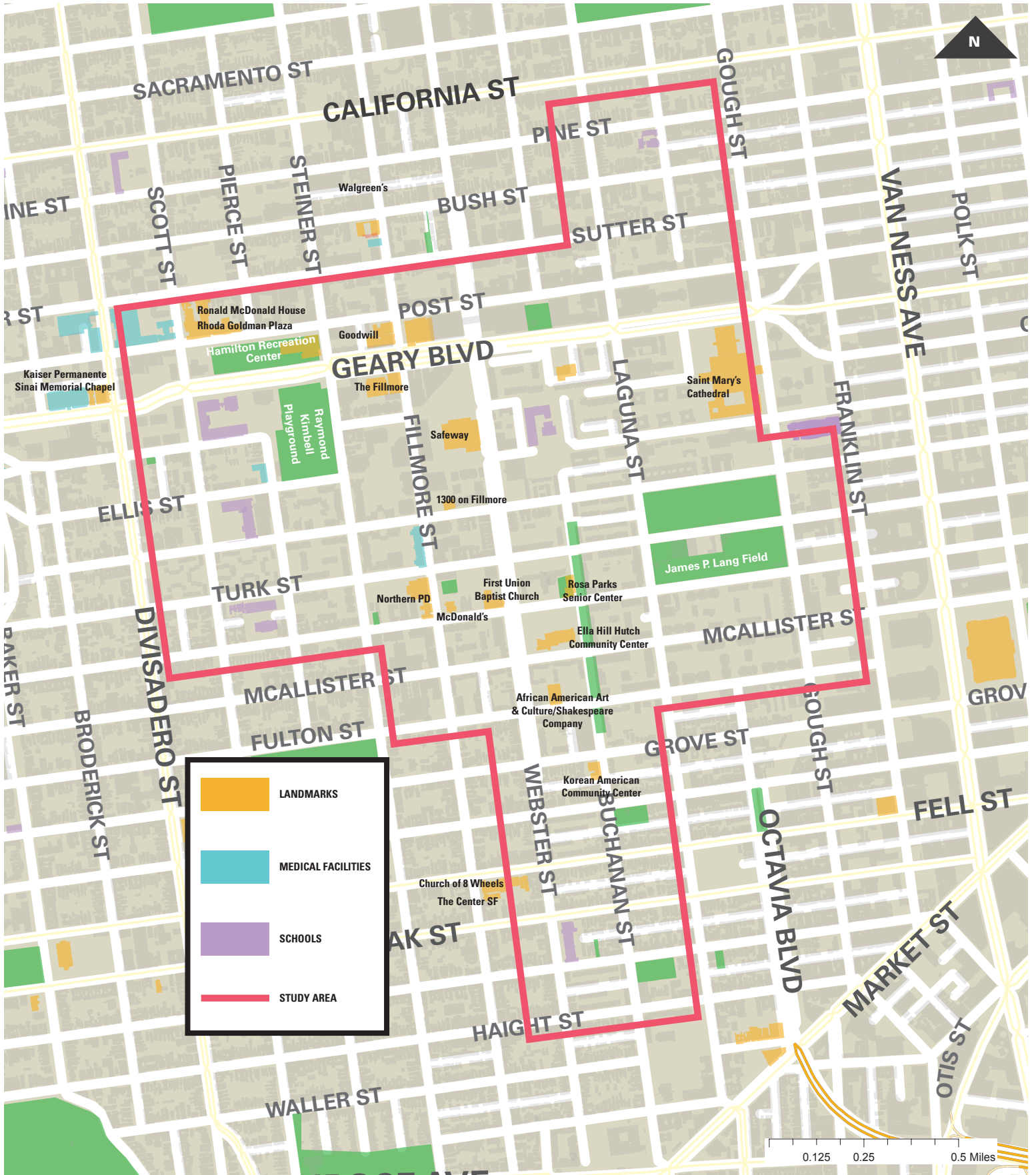




Western Addition

Community-Based Transportation Plan



ABOUT THE STUDY AREA

In 2002, the MTC identified an original study area for the Western Addition Community Based Transportation Plan. In 2014, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA), acting with guidance from the District 5 Supervisor, London Breed, revised this original study area. The Supervisor recommended schools, community centers, senior housing and affordable housing be considered through incorporation in the new study area.

The new study area is roughly bounded by Sutter Street to the North, Divisadero Street to the west, Fulton Street to the South, and Gough Street to the east. However, this rectangular area is modified in several ways. For instance, the study area extends south of Fulton Street along Buchanan and Webster Streets until Haight Street, in order to include some major affordable housing sites. Affordable housing sites along Laguna and Octavia Streets north of Sutter Street to Pine Street were also incorporated. Also a portion of the Gough Street corridor between Eddy and Fulton Street are part of the study area. Lastly, McAllister Street from Divisadero to Steiner Streets is not included in the study area.
