## M Ocean View Transit and Safety Project

The SFMTA is proposing street and transit stop changes focused on improving the M Ocean View in the Ocean View neighborhood between Junipero Serra Boulevard and the Balboa Park BART station. These proposals would improve transit reliability for M Ocean View riders, enhance accessibility for people with disabilities and improve safety for all users of the street.

Otherwise, the SFMTA Board of Directors will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome of the public hearing. Certain, final SFMTA Decisions, whether made by the City Traffic Engineer or the SFMTA Board, can be reviewed by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to [Ordinance 127-18](#). ◆ California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Appeal Rights under S.F. Admin. Code Chapter 31: These items are pending environmental clearance by the Planning Department. If the Planning Department issues a CEQA exemption determination or negative declaration, which may be viewed online at [www.sf-planning.org/ceqa-exemptions-map](http://www.sf-planning.org/ceqa-exemptions-map), action by the SFMTA Board of Directors shall constitute the Approval Action for the project. Following approval of the item by the SFMTA Board, the CEQA determination (if a CEQA exemption determination or negative declaration is issued), is subject to appeal within the timeframe specified in S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.16, typically within 30 calendar days of the Approval Action. For information on filing a CEQA appeal, contact the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors at City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, Room 244, San Francisco, CA 94102, or call (415) 554-5184. Under CEQA, in a later court challenge, a litigant may be limited to raising only those issues previously raised at a hearing on the project or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors or other City board, commission or department at, or prior to, such hearing, or as part of the appeal hearing process on the CEQA decision.
