Sustainable Streets Division Directive Order No. 6734

Pursuant to the public hearing held on February 2, 2024, traffic movement and safety may be improved by the changes approved below. The Environmental Clearance for these items is noted on Order No. 6730.

1. ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA Z (Eligibility only, no signs)

3822-3830 24th Street (Supervisor District 8) (Requires approval by the SFMTA Board) Gerry Porras, gerry.porras@sfmta.com

The proposed modification would add RPP eligibility to the residents of 3822-3830 24th Street so they can purchase parking permits for their vehicle to park within RPP Area Z.

Public Comments: No comments.

Public Comments: Received emails prior to public hearing in support and requesting for additional STOP signs and marked crosswalks. Received comment during public hearing regarding added traffic on Wawona due to construction projects on Taraval and Vicente and possible re-evaluation after construction is completed.

Public Comments: Comment in support. Question raised regarding the number of additional locations with similar improvements.



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Decision: Approved by the City Traffic Engineer for implementation.

Public Comments: Comments received in opposition due to concerns for traffic circulation and the need for a transit boarding island based on boarding and alighting activities. Question also raised regarding environmental clearance.

The Transbay Howard Streetscape Project will improve pedestrian and bicycle facilities provide new and upgraded traffic signals, prepare for future growth in the area, and improve the sense of safety for all users of the nearly one-mile-long project corridor.

Public Comments: Comments received in opposition and support during public hearing. Concerns raised regarding potential conflicts between two-way bicycle traffic and pedestrians/vehicle/shuttle bus traffic at Moscone Center. Question raised regarding possible signal infrastructure improvements with the proposed No Turn on Red restrictions. Concerns raised regarding possible impact to the walkability in the area. Concerns also raised regarding the reduction in the number of traffic lanes on Howard. Question also raised regarding effective hours of loading zone and bus zone usage.

Decision: Noted approval path. Approved by the City Traffic Engineer to forward to the SFMTA Board for final approval and implementation.

GENERAL COMMENTS:

- Question raised regarding recent signal and striping changes at 19th and Sloat and whether they were SFMTA or Caltrans work.


Whether or not the City Traffic Engineer's decision is considered a Final SFMTA Decision is determined by Division II, Section 203 of the Transportation Code. If the City Traffic Engineer approves a parking or traffic modification, it is considered a Final SFMTA Decision. If the City Traffic Engineer disapproves or declines a parking or traffic modification, a member of the public must request additional review by the SFMTA of that decision which shall be conducted pursuant to Division II, Section 203 of the Transportation Code before the decision becomes a Final SFMTA Decision. Final SFMTA Decisions, whether made by the City Traffic Engineer or the SFMTA Board, can be reviewed by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to [Ordinance 127-18](#). Decisions
