PURPOSE

To approve various routine parking and traffic modifications.

STRATEGIC PLAN GOALS AND TRANSIT FIRST POLICY PRINCIPLES:

- 4. Make streets safer for everyone.
- 5. Deliver reliable and equitable transportation services.
- 6. Eliminate pollution and greenhouse gas emissions by increasing use of transit, walking, and bicycling.

This action supports the following SFMTA Transit First Policy Principles:

- 1. To ensure quality of life and economic health in San Francisco, the primary objective of the transportation system must be the safe and efficient movement of people and goods.
- 2. Public transit, including taxis and vanpools, is an economically and environmentally sound alternative to transportation by individual automobiles. Within San Francisco, travel by public transit, by bicycle and on foot must be an attractive alternative to travel by private automobile.
- 3. Decisions regarding the use of limited public street and sidewalk space shall encourage the use of public rights of way by pedestrians, bicyclists, and public transit, and shall strive to reduce traffic and improve public health and safety.

ITEMS

The following items were considered at Public Hearing on April 19, 2024

A. ESTABLISH – PERPENDICULAR PARKING, Carroll Avenue, south side, from Hawes Street to 85 feet westerly (Requested by merchant).

Modification A would establish perpendicular parking on a portion of the south side of the 1300 block of Carroll Avenue, to provide more parking availability for a small business located there.

- B. ESTABLISH TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANY TIME, Bosworth Street, north side, from east crosswalk at Lyell Street to 107 feet westerly (Requested by SFMTA).
 - Modification B would remove parking on the north side of Bosworth Street to accommodate an adjustment to the existing westbound Class II bike lane on Bosworth Street at Lyell Street.
- C. ESTABLISH RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA Y (Eligibility only, no signs), 660-690 King Street (Requested by residents).

Modification C would add RPP eligibility to the residents of 660-690 King Street so they can purchase parking permits for their vehicle to park within RPP Area Y

D. ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA I (Eligibility only, no signs), 900 block of Valencia Street (all addresses not currently part of RPP Area I) (Requested by residents).

Modification D would expand RPP eligibility to the residents of the 900 block of Valencia Street so they can purchase parking permits for their vehicle to park within nearby RPP Area I. We received the request from a resident of the block and we are expanding eligibility to all addresses:

- G. RESCIND TOW AWAY, NO STOPPING ANY TIME, 7 AM TO 9 AM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, Bush Street, south side, from Grant Avenue to Kearny Street (Requested by SFMTA).
- H. RESCIND METERED YELLOW ZONE, 6 WHEEL COMMERCIAL LOADING, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, ESTABLISH METERED YELLOW ZONE, 6 WHEEL COMMERCIAL LOADING, 7 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, Bush Street, south side, from 6 feet to 84 feet west of Claude Lane (stalls #409, #413, #415, #417) (Requested by SFMTA).
- I. RESCIND METERED YELLOW ZONE, COMMERCIAL LOADING, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, ESTABLISH METERED YELLOW ZONE, COMMERCIAL LOADING, 7AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, Bush Street, south side, from 25 feet to 55 feet west of Kearny Street (stall #407), Bush Street, south side, from Mark Lane to 20 feet west of Mark Lane (stall #421), Bush Street, south side, from 50 feet to 70 feet west of Mark Lane (stall #427) (Requested by SFMTA).

Modifications G–I would rescind the tow away restriction between 7:00 AM and 9:00 AM and to expand the commercial meter zone hours.

- J. RESCIND 2-HR RPP, EXCEPT AREA HV PERMITS, 9 AM TO 9 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, ESTABLISH GENERAL METERED PARKING, NO TIME LIMIT, 9 AM TO 6 PM MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, Gough Street, west side, between Fulton Street and Grove Street (Requested by SFMTA).
- K. ESTABLISH RED ZONE, Gough Street, west side, from Grove Street to 20 feet northerly (Requested by SFMTA).

Modifications J–K would establish general metered parking on an existing RPP block to increase parking turnover. This proposal will not affect address-based eligibility for residents

- or businesses to obtain a RPP permit. Current RPP permit holders will retain their permits and can park on adjacent RPP blocks.
- L. RESCIND -- BUS ZONE, Eddy Street, south side, from Mason Street to 121 feet westerly (Requested by SFMTA).
- M. ESTABLISH -- GENERAL METERED PARKING, 7AM-6PM, NO TIME LIMIT, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, Eddy Street, south side, from 20 feet west of Mason Street to 100 feet westerly (creates 80-foot zone for four stalls) (Requested by SFMTA).
- N. ESTABLISH -- RED ZONE, Eddy Street, south side, from Mason Street to 20 feet westerly (creates 20-foot zone for hydrant and daylighting), Eddy Street, south side, from 100 feet west of Mason Street to 121 feet westerly (creates 21-foot zone for hydrant) (Requested by SFMTA).
- O. RESCIND -- YELLOW METER LOADING ZONE, 7AM-6PM, MONDAY THOUGH FRIDAY ESTABLISH -- BUS ZONE, Eddy Street, south side, from 80 feet east of Taylor Street to 140 feet easterly (removes 60-foot yellow zone for meters #400-01370, 400-01350, and 400-01310, and extends far side bus zone by 60 feet) (Requested by SFMTA).

Modifications L—O would consolidate the Eddy Street/Taylor Street and Eddy Street/Mason Street bus zones into one extended bus zone at Eddy Street/Taylor Street and establish general meter parking at the existing Eddy Street/Mason Street bus zone (Requested by SFMTA).

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

The proposed traffic and parking modifications are subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). CEQA provides a categorical exemption from environmental review for operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301.

The SFMTA, under authority delegated by the San Francisco Planning Department, has determined that the proposed parking and traffic modifications in Items A-O (Case No. 2024-003315ENV, April 9, 2024) are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301.

The proposed action is the Approval Action for Items A-O as defined by San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 31.
