



Teacher Permit Fact Sheet

- The SFMTA Residential Parking Permit Program issues Teacher Parking Permits under the authority of the San Francisco Transportation Code. The number of permits allowed for each school is determined by SFMTA Sustainable Streets. Your school administrator or a designated representative must determine which teachers receive or share permits.
- Permits are intended for use by full-time teachers only and should not be assigned to other school employees.
- It is the responsibility of the school administrator or designated representative to collect the permit fee for each permit requested. Please refer to SFMTA.com/RPP for the most recent annual permit fee. Full payment, along with completed application should be mailed to:

- It is the responsibility of the school administrator or designated representative to distribute permits and monitor the use of permits among qualified teachers.
- **It is the responsibility of the school administrator to collect permits for summer use and again for the new school year in the fall.**
- Any lost or stolen permits will not be replaced.
- Fee changes every June 30th of each year. All permits expire on September 30th of each year regardless of purchase date.
