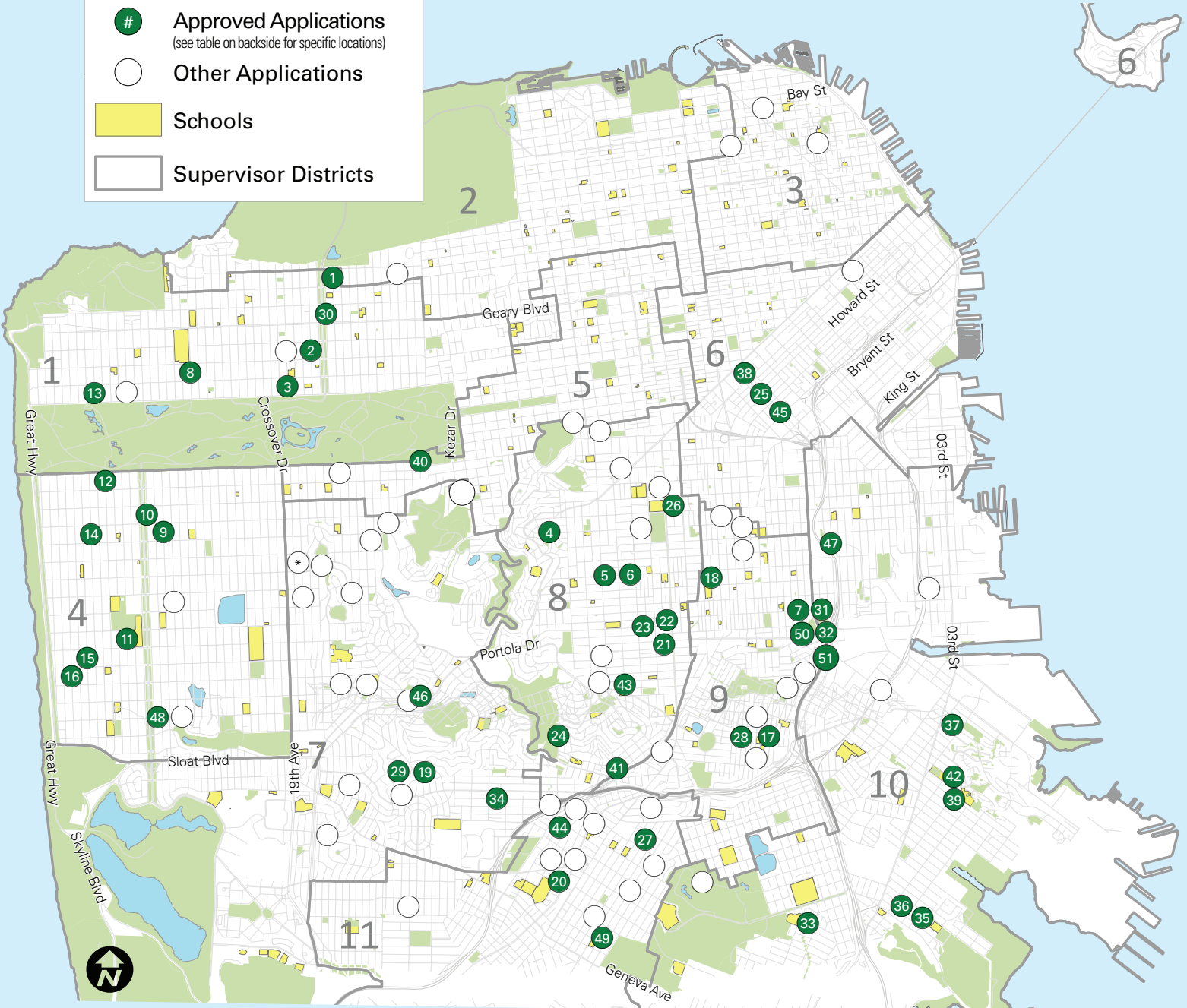

2015/2016 Applications

Traffic Calming Program Facts

102 applications were submitted to the 2015/2016 Program, **2.5x** as many applications as in the previous year.

Almost twice as many applications were accepted in 2015/2016 compared to the previous two years of the program combined.



Speed Humps are the preferred traffic calming measure. They are low-cost, do not affect parking, reduce the speed at which most people drive, and **nearly eliminate egregious speeding (30+ mph) on many residential streets.**

Vehicle speeds are the primary factor when considering applications, since **a person hit by a car going 30 MPH is six times more likely to die than a person hit by a car moving at 20 MPH.** Other factors include daily traffic volumes, history of collisions, and proximity to schools, parks, and transit/bicycle routes.



12-20 months is the target turnaround time between the traffic calming application deadline and installation of traffic calming devices.
