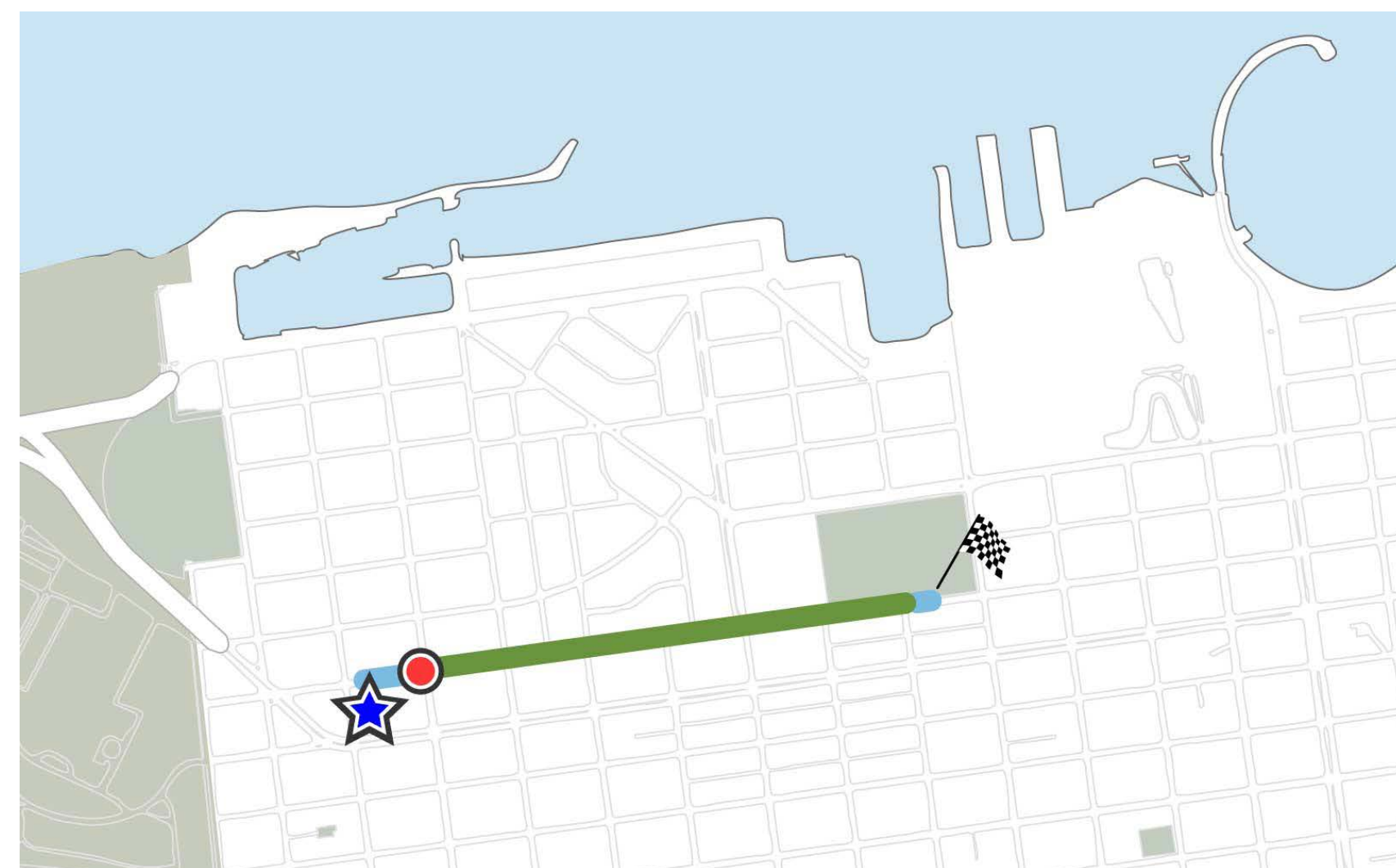

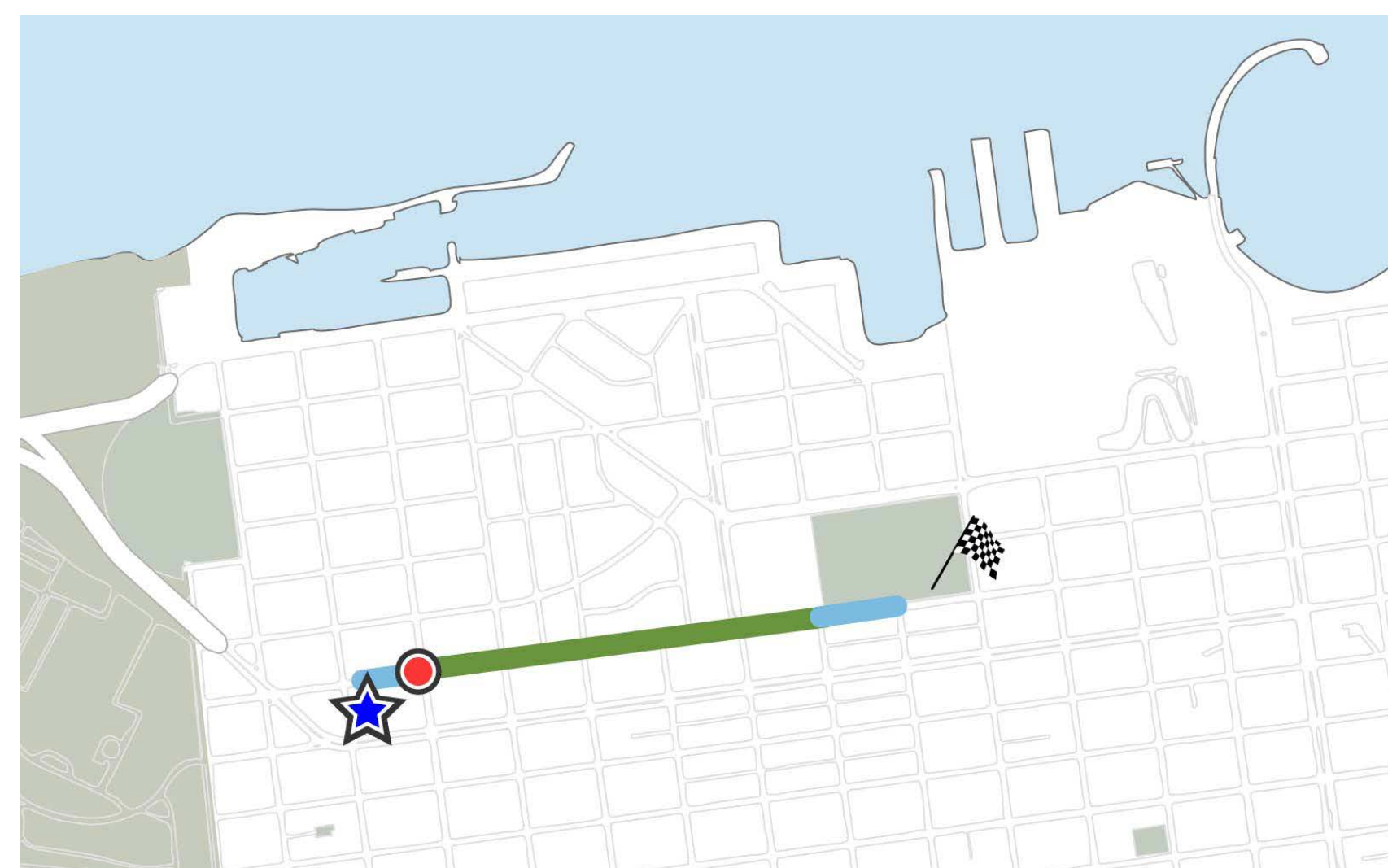

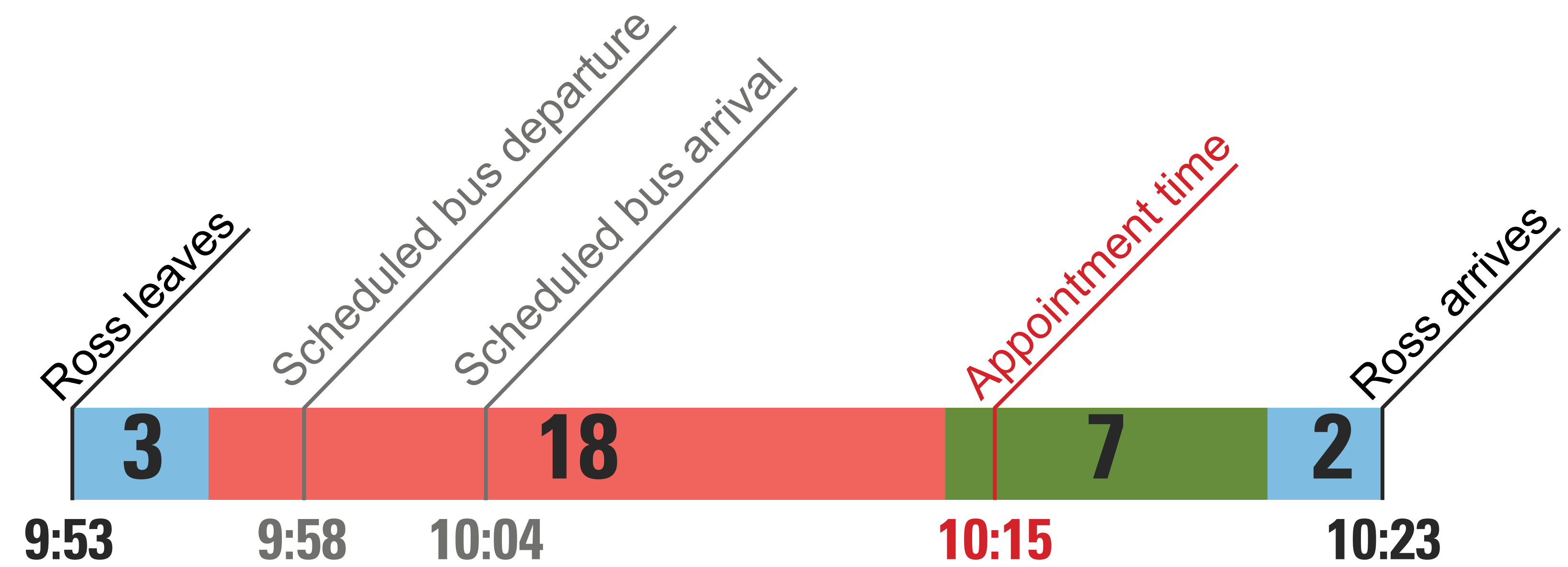


Going to the rec center:

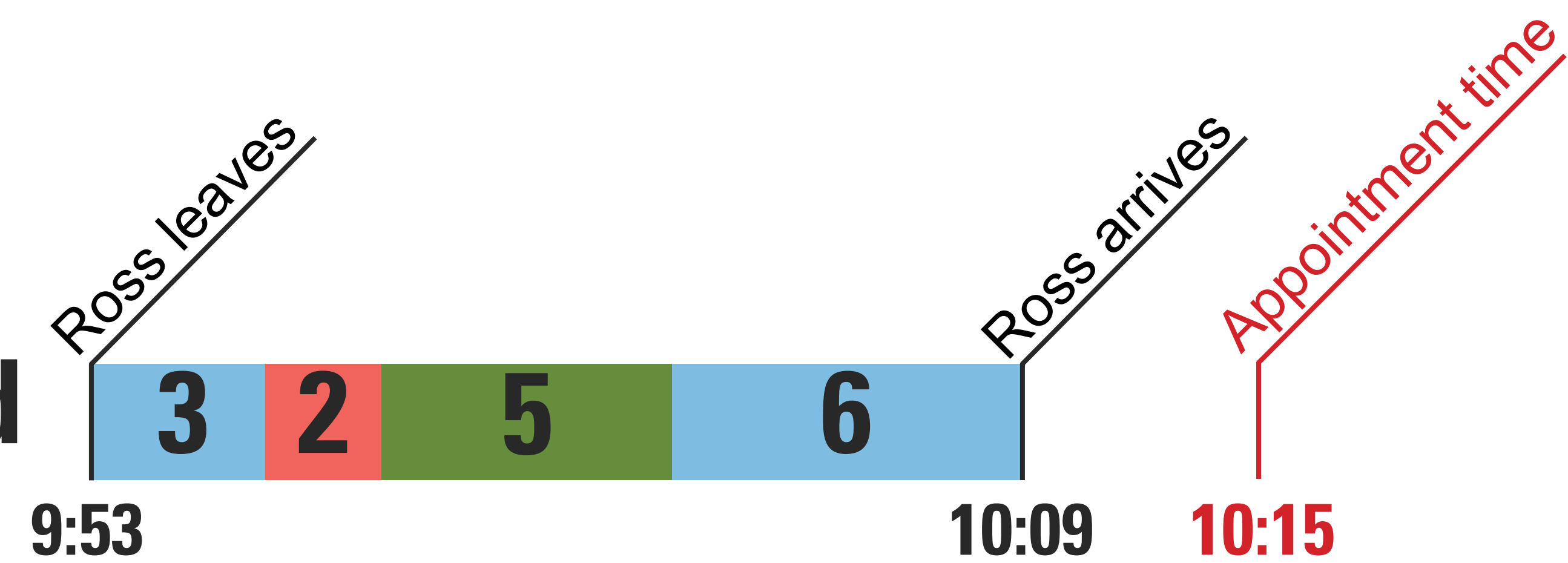
Ross' travel time

Muni Forward helps:

Removing stops along the route makes Muni more predictable.
