Date of Request: June 17, 2019

Request: Total number of Robbery, Burglary, Vandalism, Larceny Theft, Homeless complaints, and Suspicious Persons within the area of Van Ness Business Corridor (On Van Ness Ave, from Green Street to Mission Street), from 11/01/2017 – 6/17/2019. Total Arrests for aforementioned crime types within the area of Van Ness Ave, from Green Street to Mission Street, from 11/01/2017 – 6/17/2017. Additionally, comparative statistics for the time periods of October 20, 2018 through February 19, 2019 vs. February 20, 2019 through June 17, 2019.

Response:

Crime Incidents:

A search was conducted using Crime Data Warehouse via Business Intelligence for UCR Part I crime incidents, and selected crimes including Vandalism, Lodging without Permission, and Narcotics-related incidents, having geographic coordinates within Van Ness Ave, from Green Street to Mission Street, between January 1, 2017 and June 17, 2019.

Comparative data is also provided for the time periods of October 1, 2018 through February 19, 2019 and February 20, 2019 through June 17, 2019. Year-to-date comparative data is provided from January 1 – June 17, for 2018 and 2019.

Arrests:

San Francisco Police Department does not have an arrest database that can be used to provide exact counts of persons arrested for these crime types. A search was conducted in Crime Data Warehouse Business Intelligence Tools Person Schema for Persons Booked or Cited in connection with incidents having geographic coordinates falling within the requested area.

Notes for Arrest Data:

1. Approximately 2% of arrests are duplicates. This is where an arrestee is entered on a supplemental report differently than the original incident report.
2. Incident crime categories do not reflect criminal violations or arrest charges. Counts reflect the number of persons booked or cited in connection with incidents described as falling within the provided categories. Incidents may have multiple category descriptions, therefore, arrests cannot be added from multiple categories to determine the total number of arrests
3. This report includes a count of persons booked or cited for an incident in which an initial or supplemental report listed an occurrence date value within the queried time period. This date indicates an event occurred related to an incident during this time period. Actual date of arrest for persons booked or cited is not available.
4. Arrests connected to incident reports generated via the Coplogic online reporting system will only be included if a Supplemental report containing arrest information was added to Crime Data Warehouse.
5. Not all citations are included in Crime Data Warehouse - only those in which an incident report was generated.

Please note: The majority of location values for Coplogic incidents were not available in CDW until October of 2017. Incident counts for crime types reported via Coplogic cannot be compared for the requested time periods. In order to facilitate a more accurate comparison, statistics are also provided below without Coplogic records. Incidents in CDW that do not have geographic coordinates were not included in this search. Results are provided in the following tables.

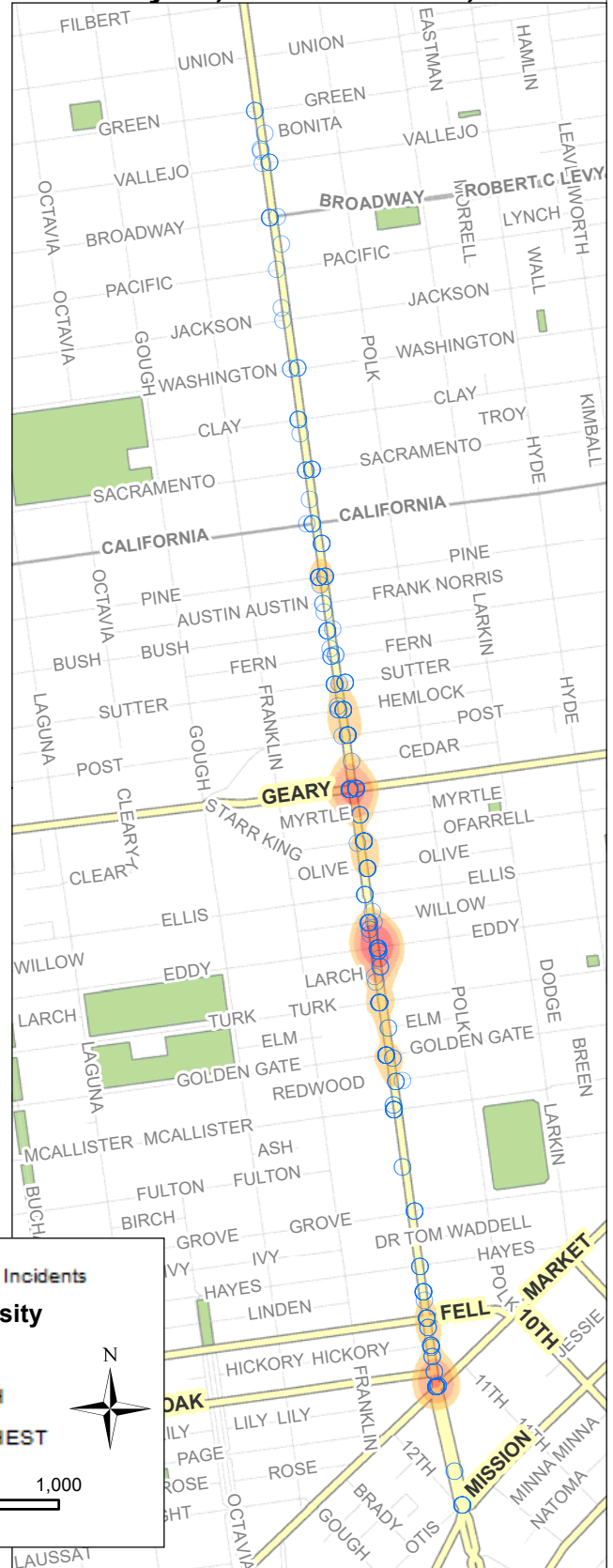
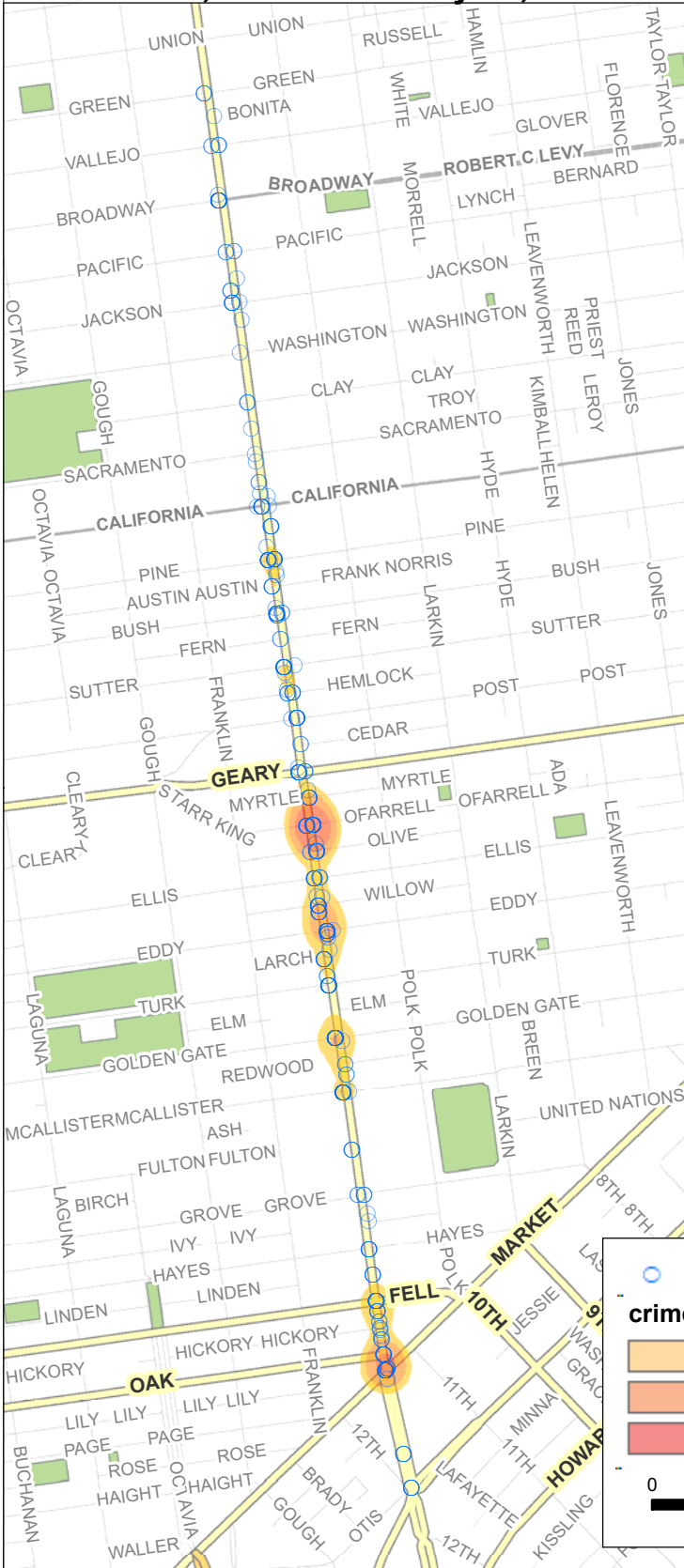


Van Ness Business Corridor Crime Incidents October 20, 2018 - June 17, 2019
