RESCIND - 2-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 9 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA S PERMITS
ESTABLISH - GENERAL METERED PARKING, 2-Hour Time Limit, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY
18th Street, south side, from Noe Street to Hartford Street

ESTABLISH - RED ZONE
18th Street, south side, from Noe Street to 25 feet west

ESTABLISH - METERED YELLOW ZONE, COMMERCIAL LOADING, 30-MINUTE TIME LIMIT, 7 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY
18th Street, south side, from 35 feet to 65 feet west of Noe Street.

ESTABLISH - GREEN METERED ZONE, 15-MINUTE TIME LIMIT, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY
18th Street, south side, from 65 feet to 85 feet west of Noe Street.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION / COMMENTS

The south side of this block of 18th Street has several businesses. The SFMTA proposes to introduce meters as a parking management tool to increase parking turnover. Legislation will result in approximately 10 metered parking spaces. Existing Residential Parking Permit eligibility will remain. Daylighting at the stop sign will help increase pedestrian visibility.
