

Draft proposed bus stop relocation/removal recommendations

Principles for bus stop re-location:

- 1) Moving bus stops from the nearside of intersections to the farside, so buses don't get stopped at red lights as often
- 2) Removing or consolidating closely-spaced stops to improve travel time reliability
- 3) Expand substandard bus zone lengths

- Block-specific feedback on existing transit/parking/loading/ safety challenges to inform draft project design



Overview



"Geary East" contract: Van Ness to Market Street

- All water mains are installed. Service connection work is underway between Stockton and Kearny streets.
- Sidewalk bulb-out work remaining on Geary at Mason and at Kearny.
- Begin private Verizon conduit work on Geary, pending cost share agreement.



"West Surface" contract: Stanyan to Van Ness

- Work in "Segment A" at Steiner (Hamilton Rec Center) is nearly finished.
- Only work remaining in "Segment B" is the Buchanan crossing as well as railings and median pavers. Tree plantings are planned as well.
- Red thermoplastic is planned to begin west of Van Ness.


