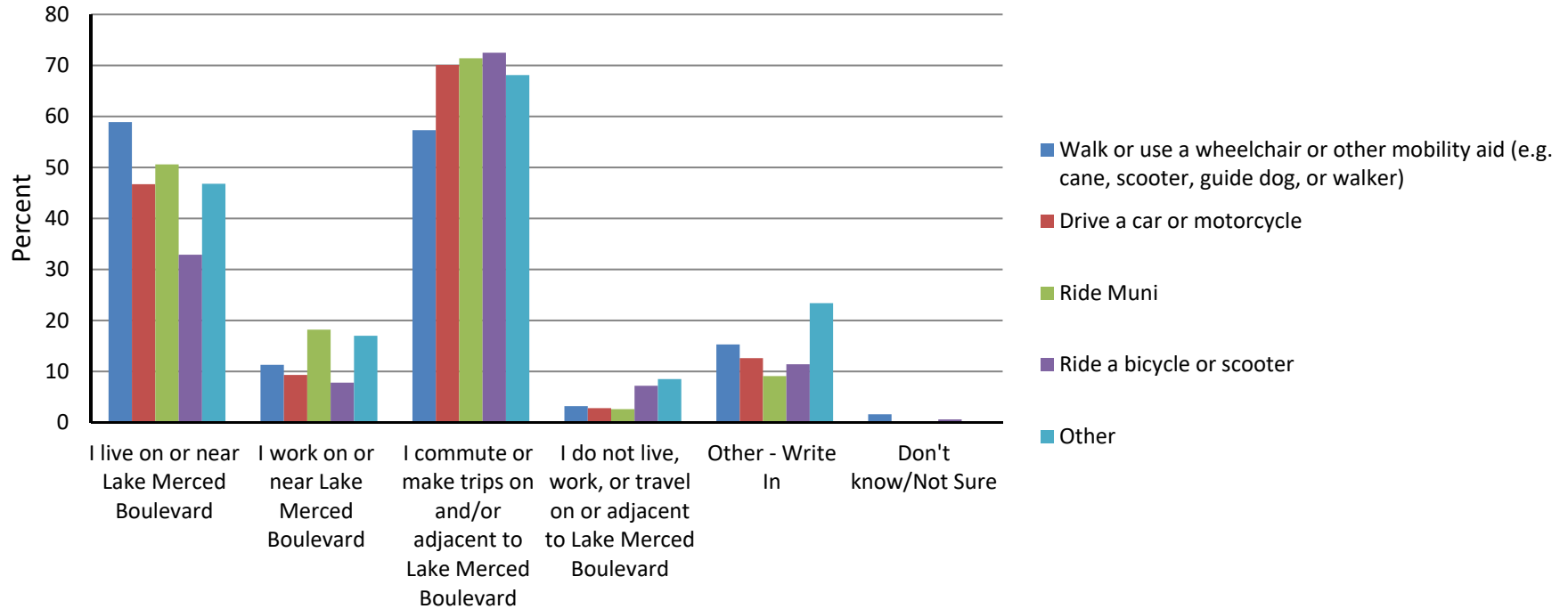

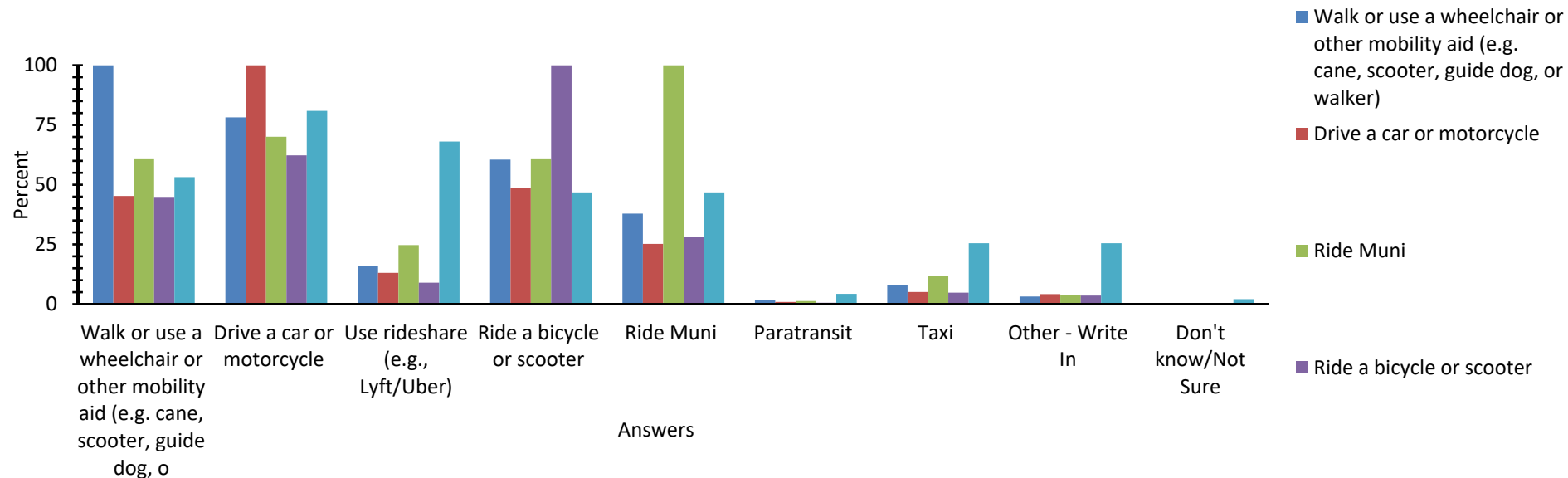

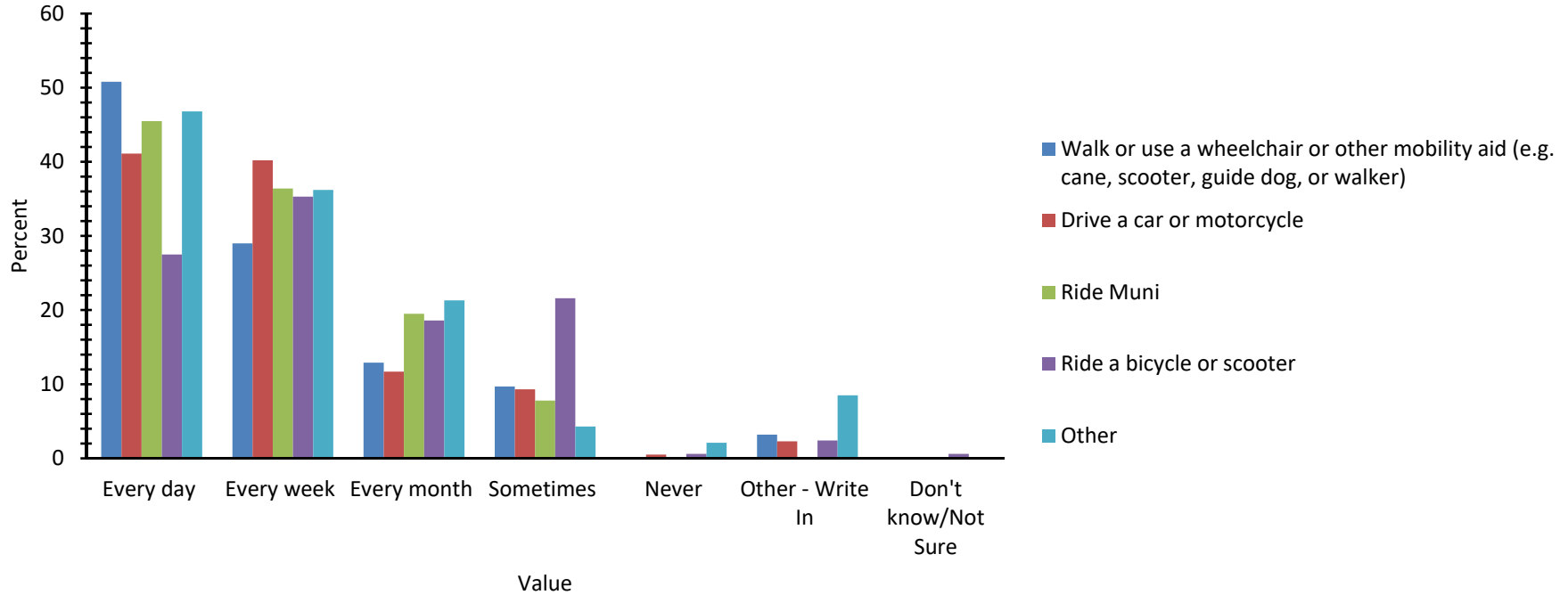


Between 45%-50% of drivers also walk & bike along Lake Merced Blvd.

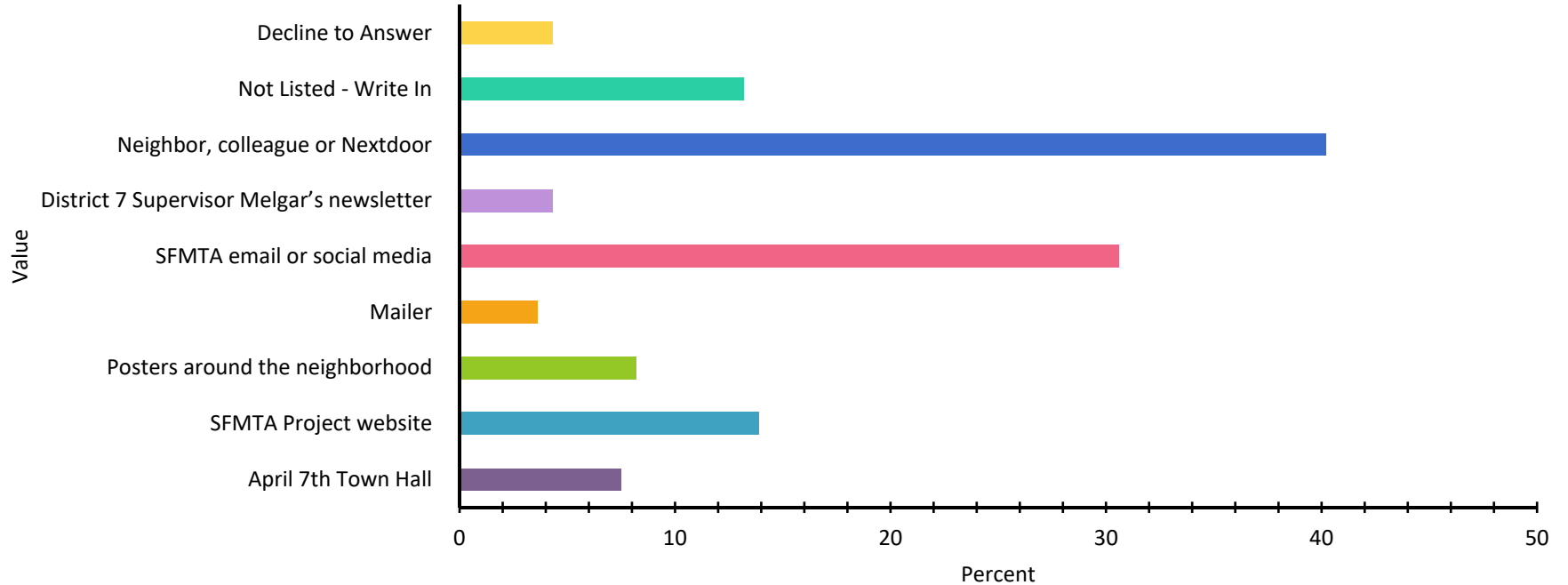

More than half of all survey takers regardless of the mode visit Lake Merced at least on a weekly basis.

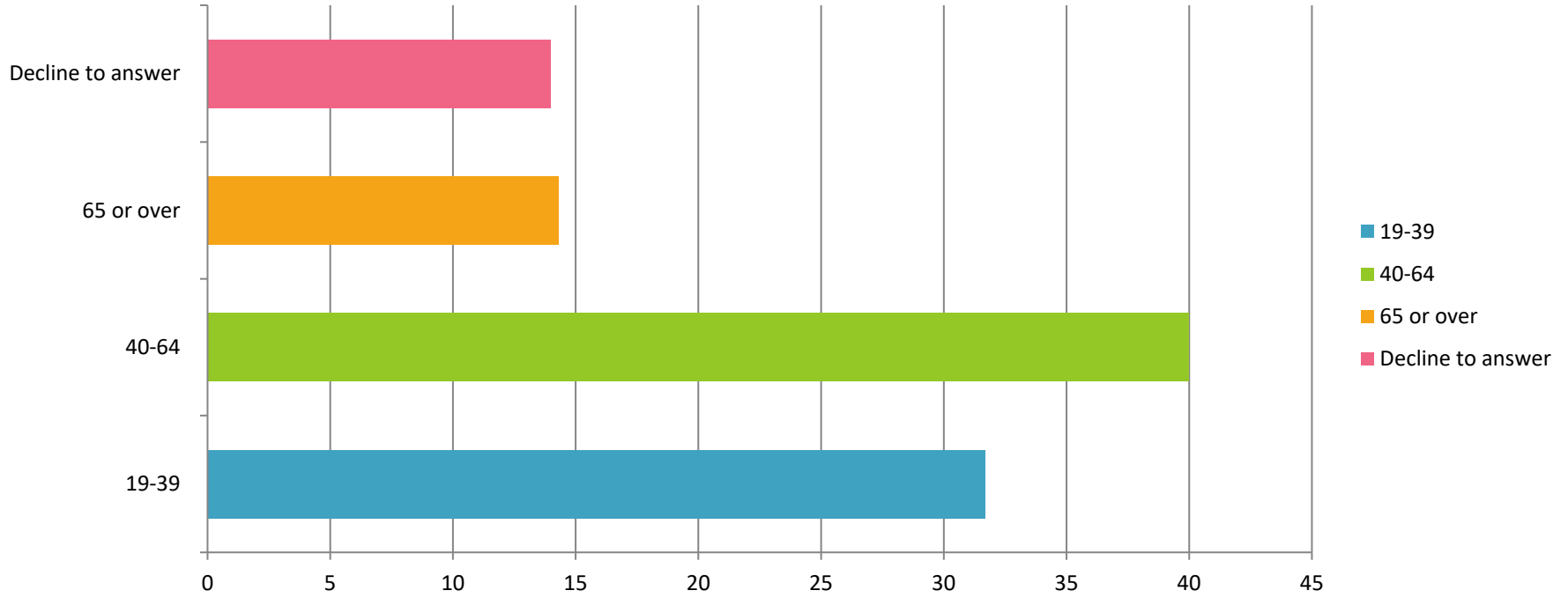

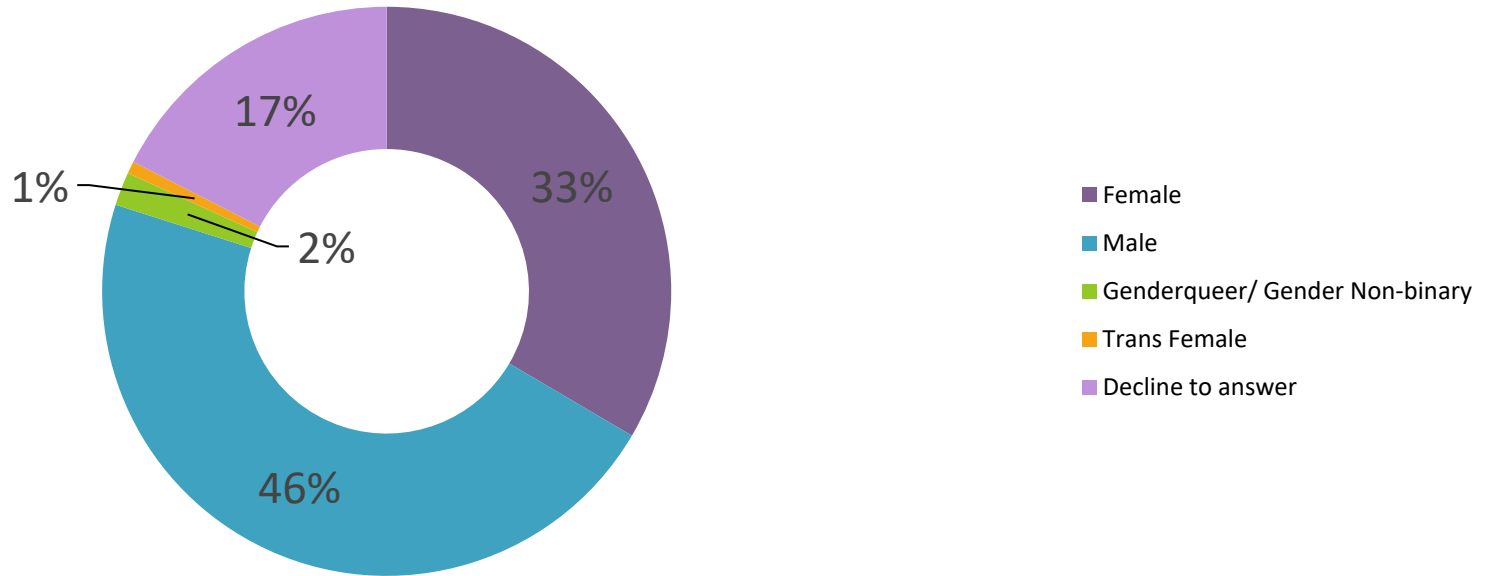

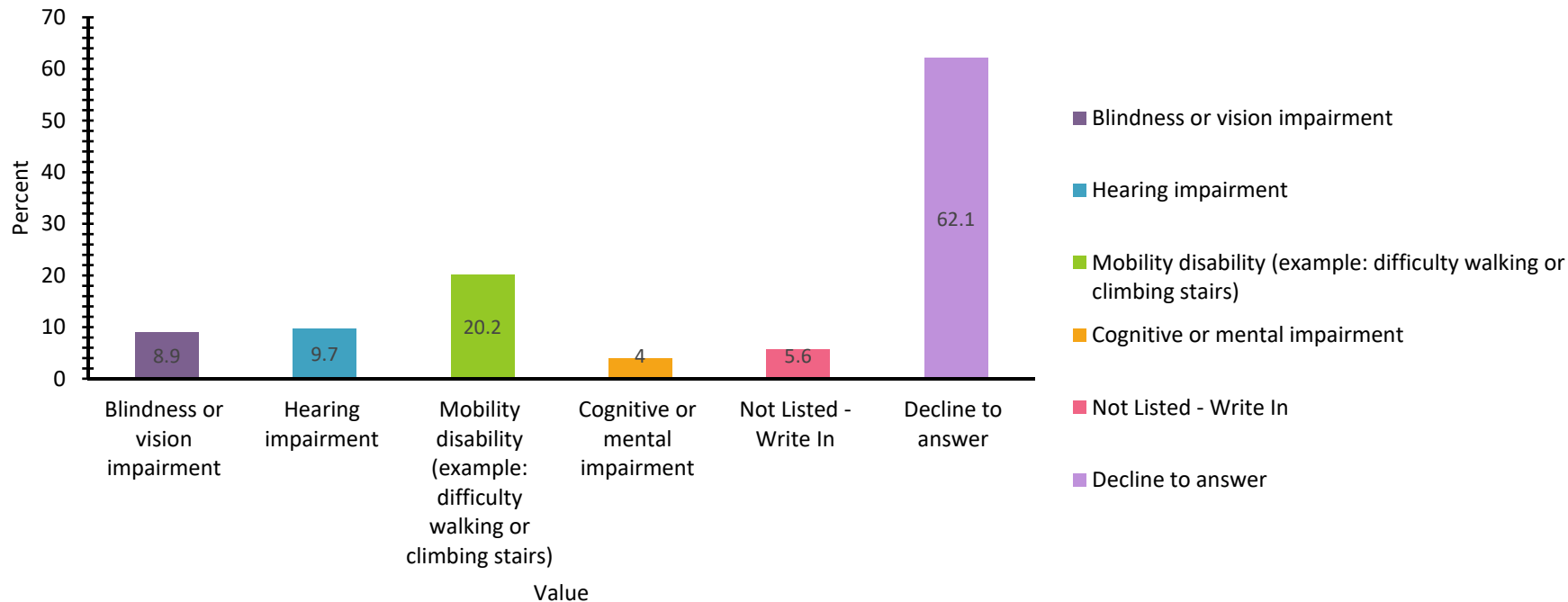

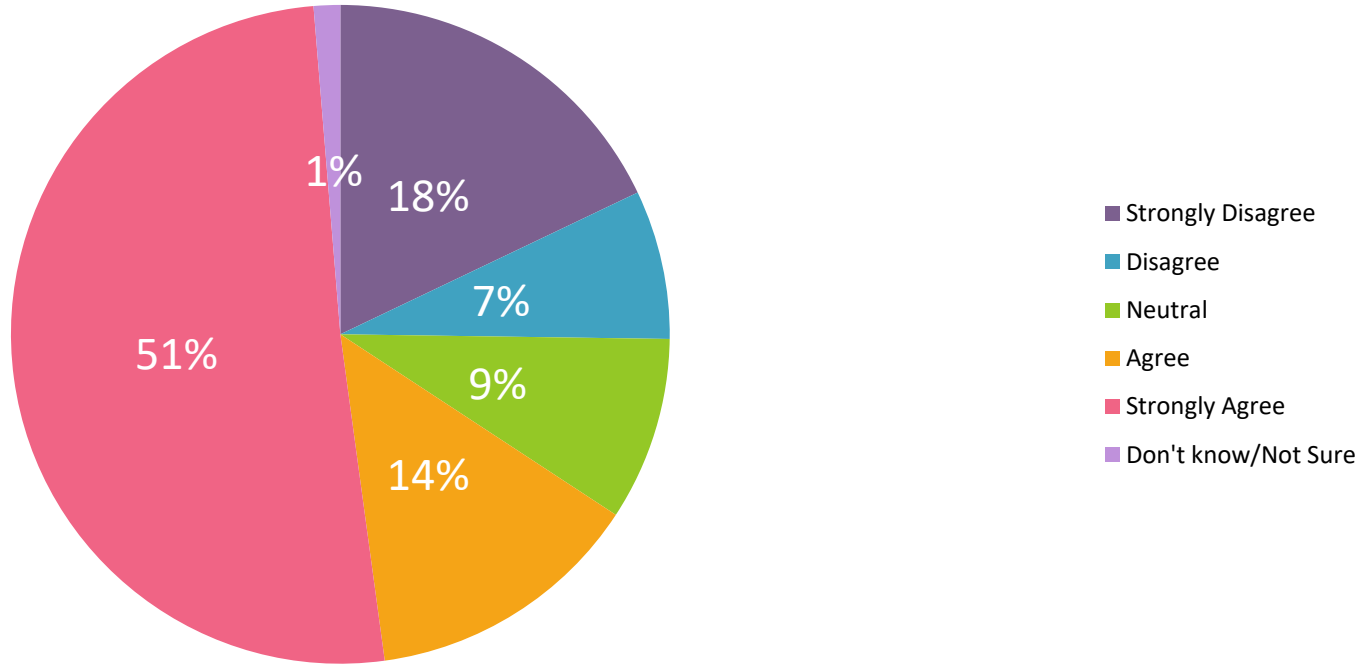

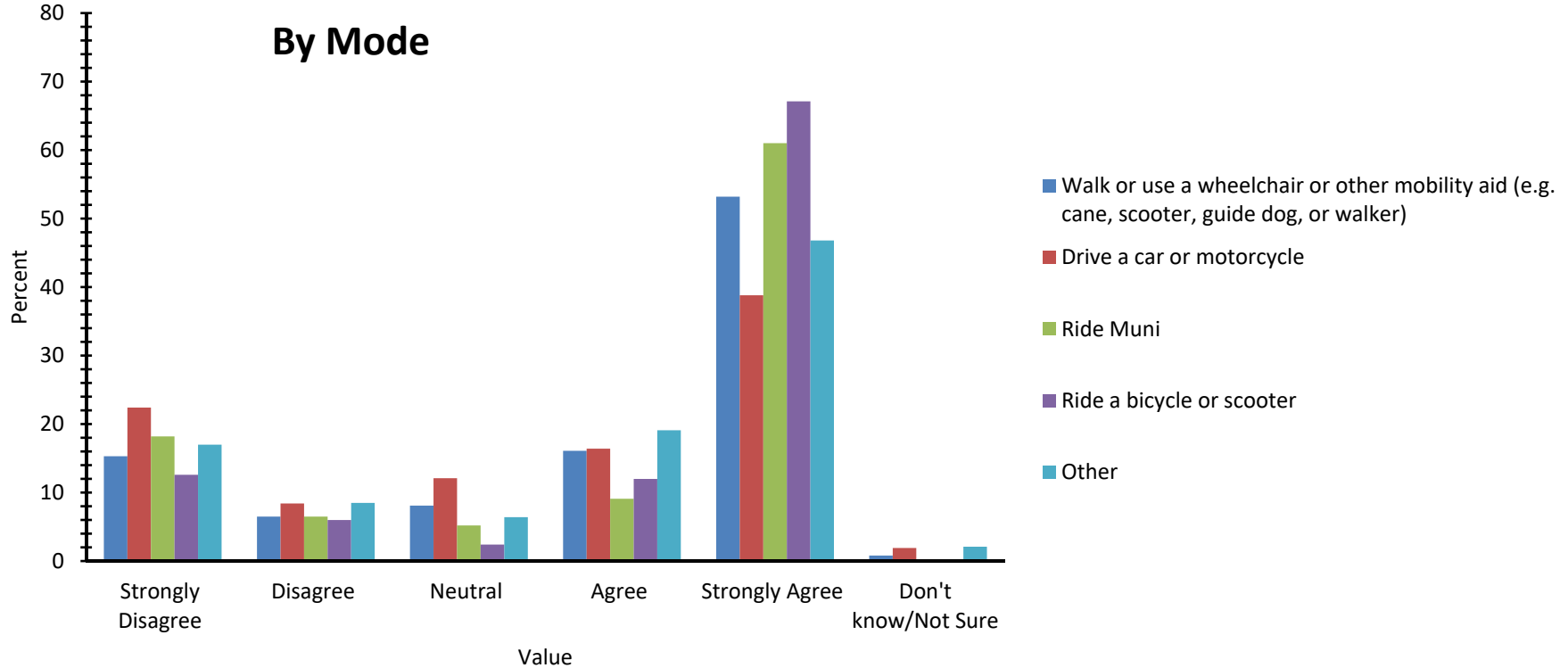

More than 1 out of every 2 people strongly agree that traffic safety improvements are needed along Lake Merced Blvd

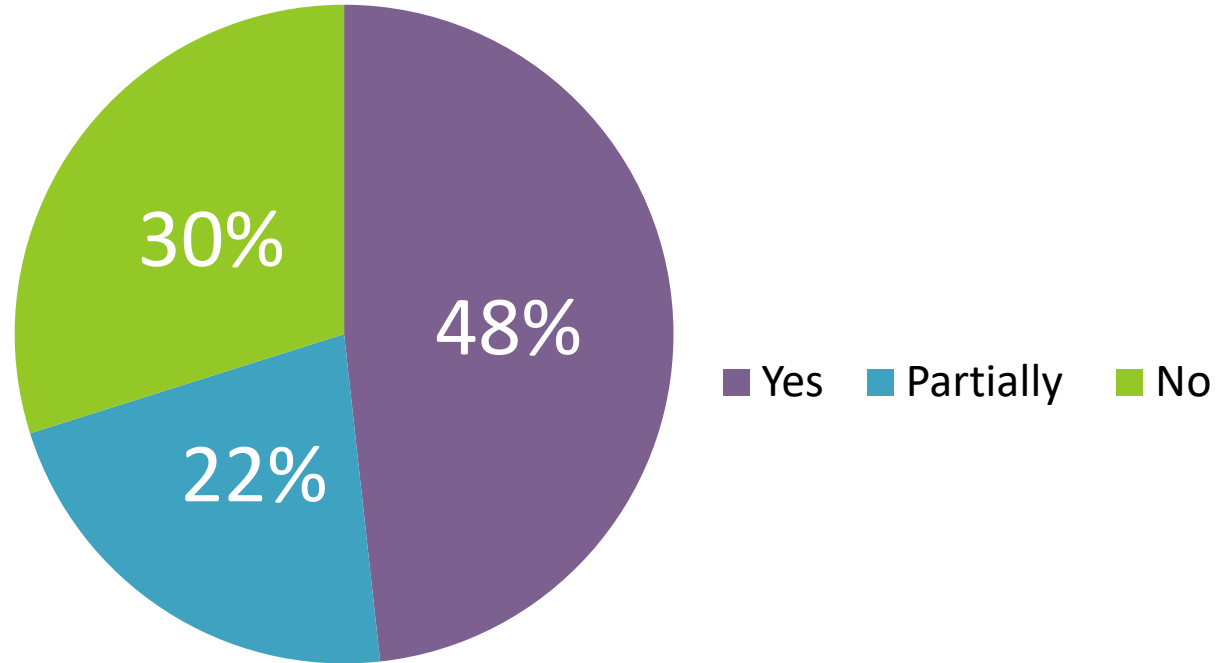

Not only bicyclists or pedestrians want safety improvements; more than half of respondents strongly agree traffic safety improvements are needed for all.

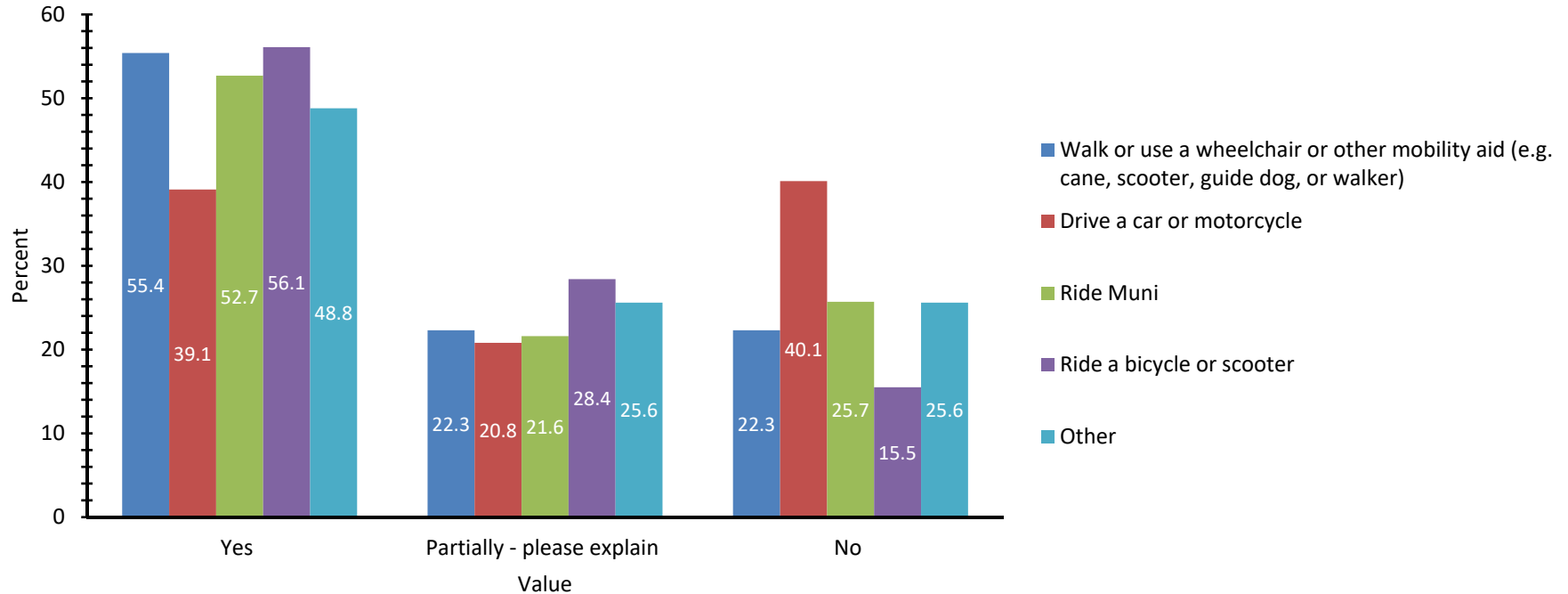
Do you support the proposed design for the Lake Merced Quick-Build Project across all five sections?

Do you support the proposed design for the Lake Merced Quick-Build Project across all five sections?

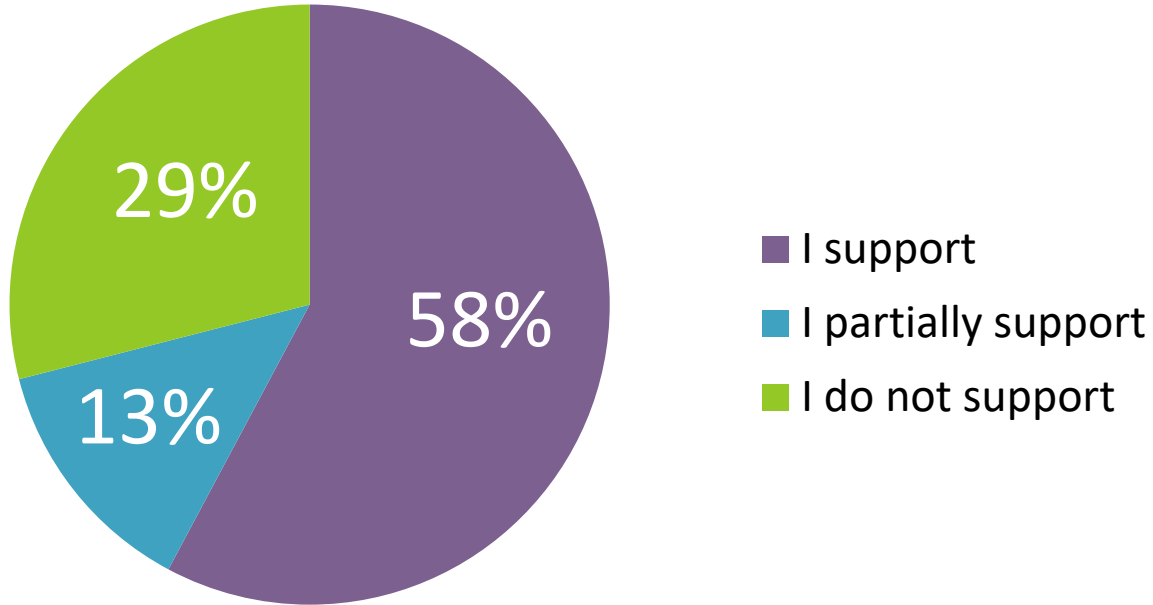


From the comments, the SFMTA heard that many who partially support the project would like to see more improvements/additional bike infrastructure.

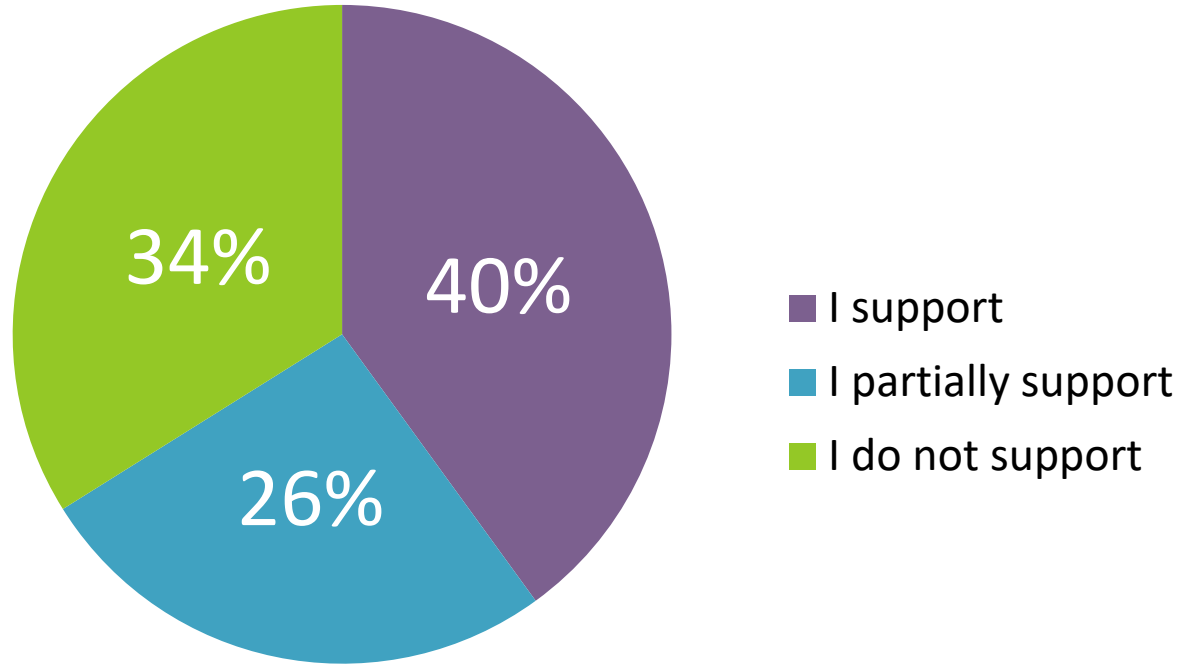
Do you support the proposed quick-build project improvements along Lake Merced Blvd between John Muir Dr & Brotherhood Way?

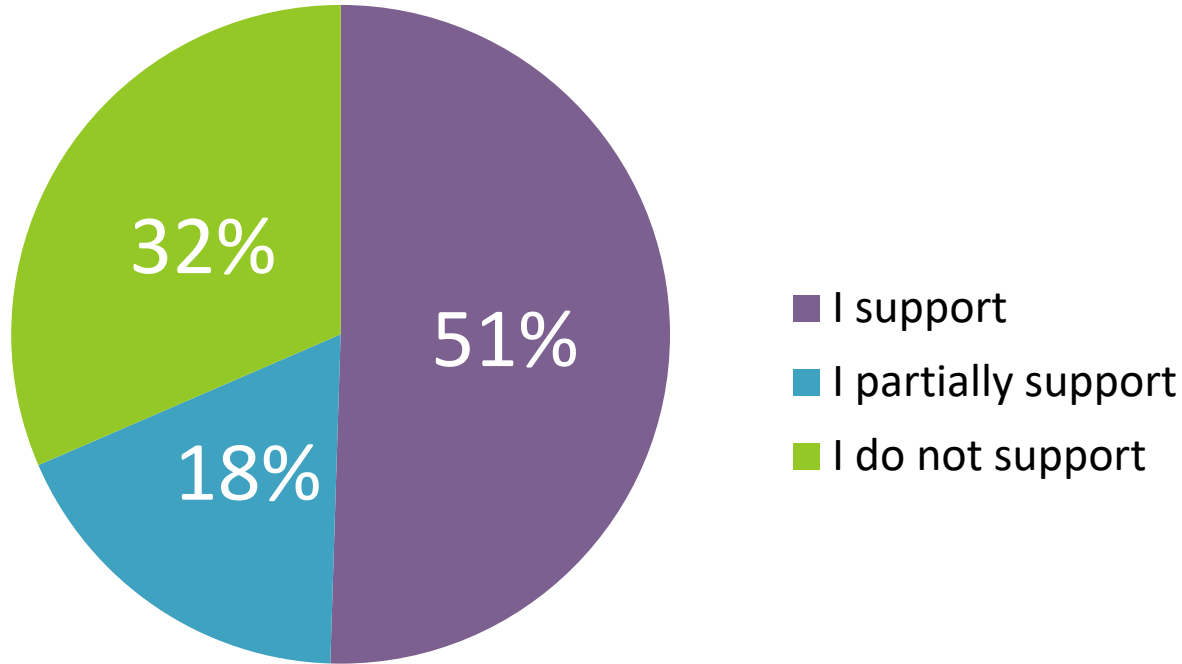

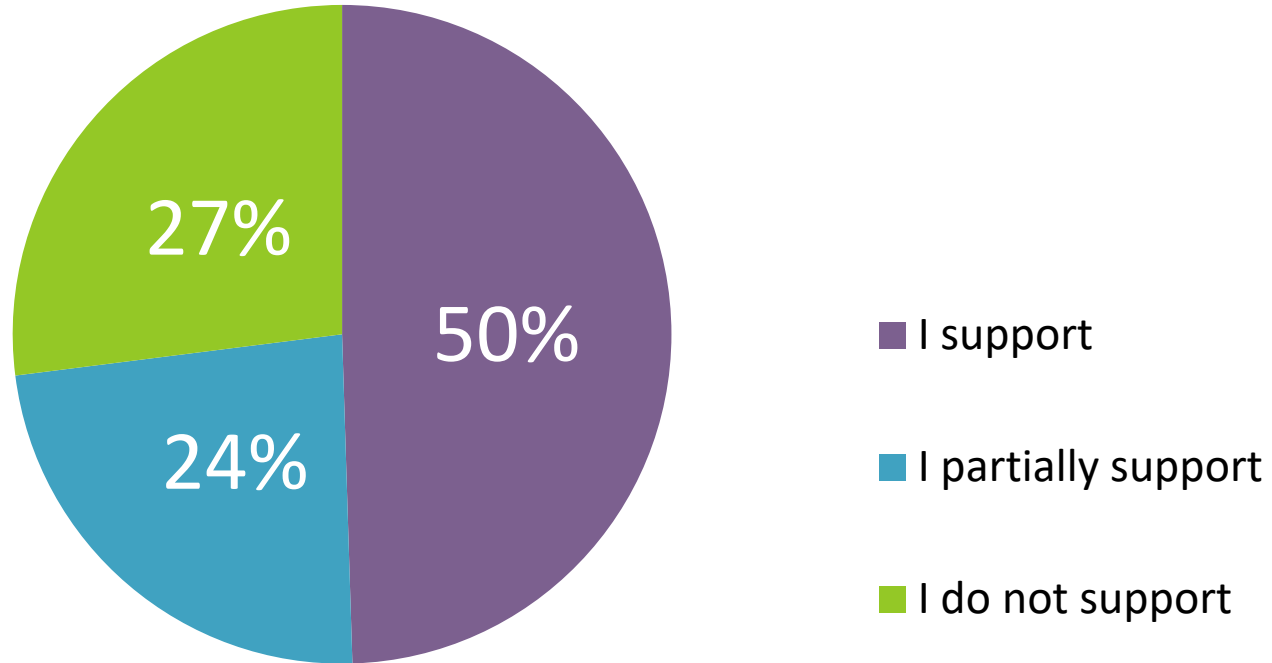
Do you support the proposed quick-build project improvements along Lake Merced Blvd between (future) Vidal intersection to Middlefield Dr?
