RESOLUTION No. 230221-016

WHEREAS, In 2018, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) published the Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan (PTASP) Rule, requiring each public transportation agency to develop a new safety plan, referred to as the PTASP, and implement a Safety Management System (SMS), and;

WHEREAS, The PTASP Rule is designed to change the safety culture of a transportation agency by making safety everyone's responsibility, empowering employees to play a role in safety and encouraging employees and contractors to report safety concerns to senior management, and;

WHEREAS, This update to the PTASP is required by federal law to include new requirements established in the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), and;

WHEREAS, The PTASP must be approved by a committee comprised of frontline and management staff, and;

WHEREAS, On July 28th 2022, the Joint Labor Management Safety (JLMS) Committee was formed by the SFMTA, pursuant to 49 U.S.C 5329 (d) (5), and;

WHEREAS, On December 30, 2022 the JLMS approved the SFMTA's 2023 PTASP pursuant to 49 U.S.C 5329 (d) (5), and;

WHEREAS, The PTASP must be approved by the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors, and;

WHEREAS, On February 9, 2023, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency, under authority delegated by the Planning Department, determined that the Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan is not defined as a "project" under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15060(c) and 15378(b); and,

WHEREAS, A copy of the CEQA determination is on file with the Secretary to the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors and is incorporated herein by reference; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors does hereby approve the SFMTA's 2023 Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan.
