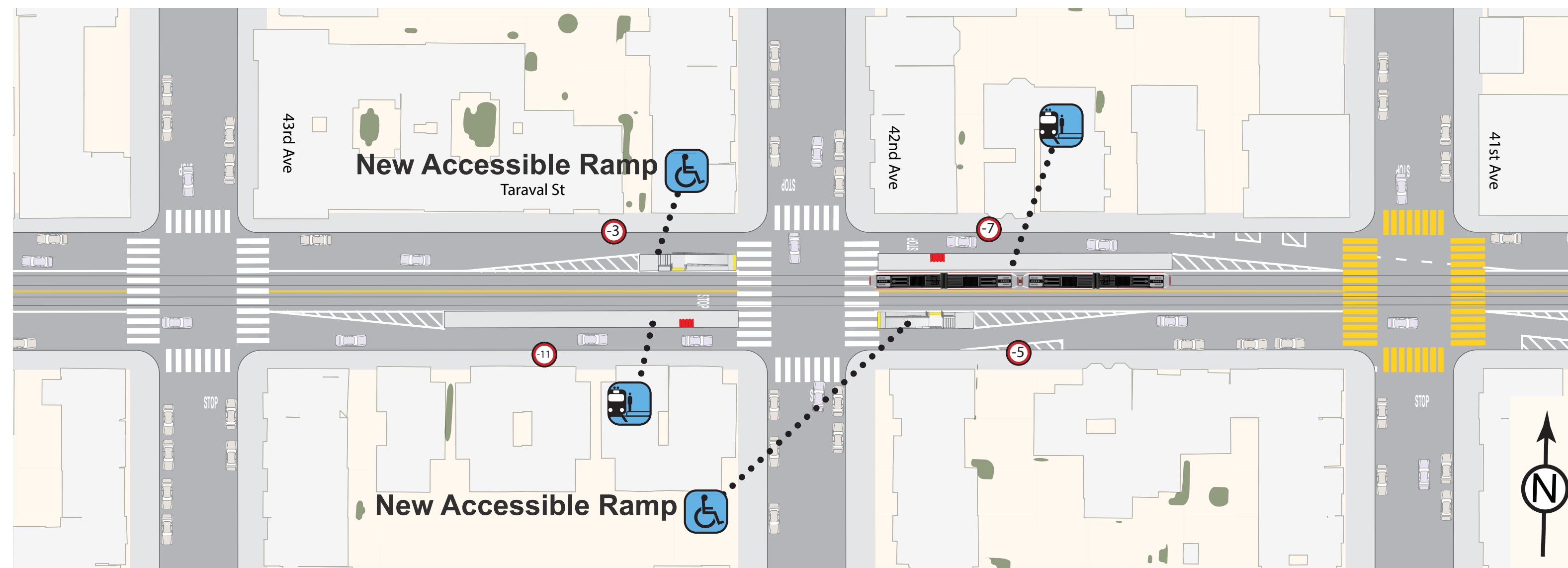


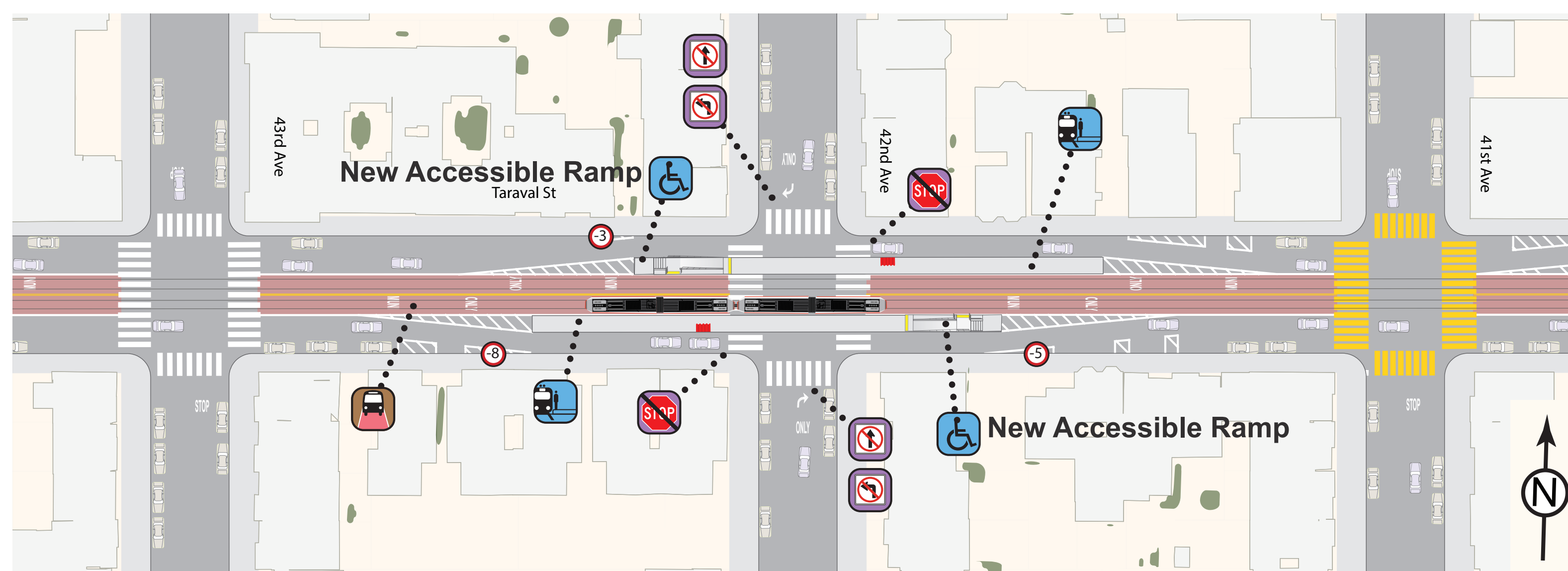

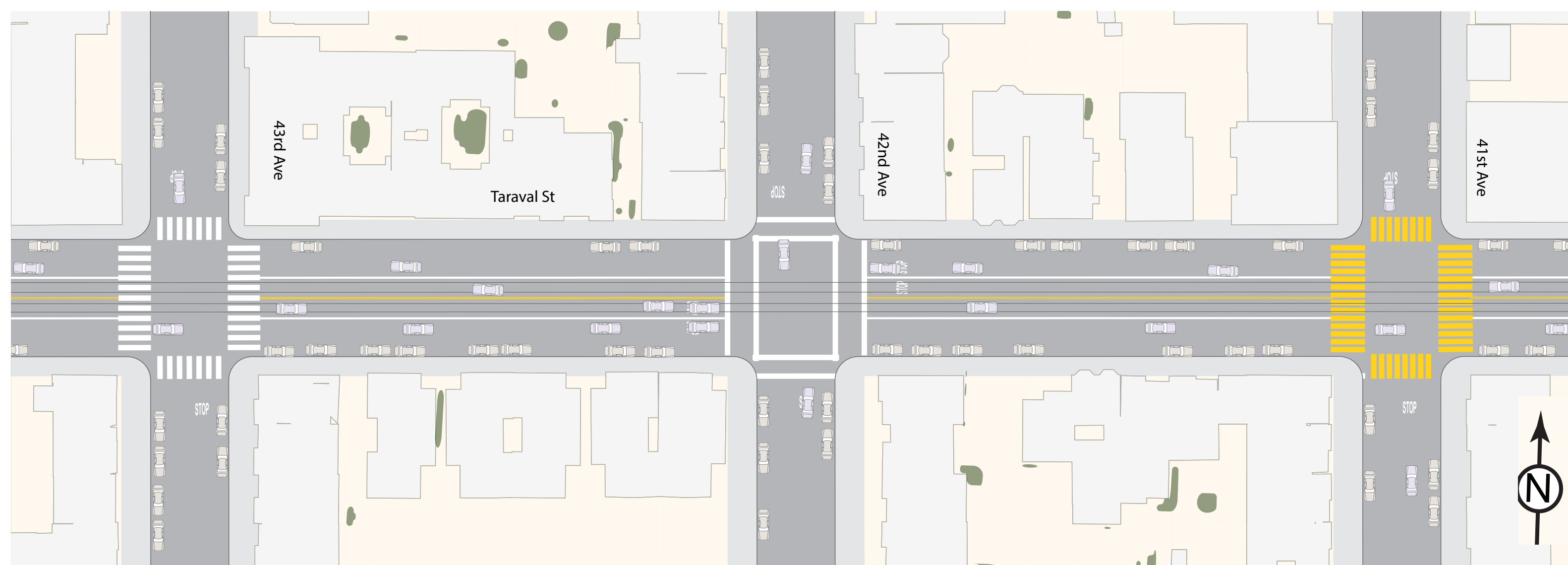

Design Elements



New Boarding Islands at 42nd Ave and Taraval

- Islands provide a safe place for customers to get on and off the train.
- An island with a ramp would allow wheelchair access to the stop.
- Would remove 26 parking spaces in Option 1 or 22 spaces in Option 2



Remove Stop Signs on eastbound and westbound Taraval St at 42nd Ave

- Removing a stop sign at this intersection saves time by eliminating an extra stop from the route.
- Other traffic calming and safety measures would be added to slow down speeding cars without affecting Muni.



Right Turn Only from 42nd Ave onto Taraval

- Creating boarding islands through the intersection would calm traffic and reduce delays to Muni.



New Transit Lanes on Taraval St from 15th Ave to 46th Ave in both directions

- A transit only lane gives Muni vehicles their own lane separate from regular traffic.
- This helps Muni bypass traffic congestion, which saves time and improves reliability.

Goals



Reduce delays and improve reliability by meeting stop spacing standards



Provide a safe space to get on and off the train



Provide an accessible ramp and platform for customers with wheelchairs
