Mayor's Office of Housing & Community Development (MOHCD)

Mission: To coordinate the City's housing policy & provide financing for the development, rehabilitation, & purchase of affordable housing in San Francisco; AND to strengthen the social, physical, & economic infrastructure of San Francisco's low-income neighborhoods & communities in need.

Policy Goals:

- ✓ Mayor Lee's Housing Production Goal - 30,000 units by 2020
- ✓ Transition Age Youth Housing Goal - 400 units
- ✓ 10 year Plan to End Chronic Homelessness - 3,000 units by 2014

- ✓ 22,000 square feet of open space w/ species selected for carbon sequestration properties with Department of Urban Forestry
- ✓ Indoor Air Quality Mitigations (Article 38) + Green Buffer
- ✓ Request for proposals: Late 2015/Early 2016

Site constraints:

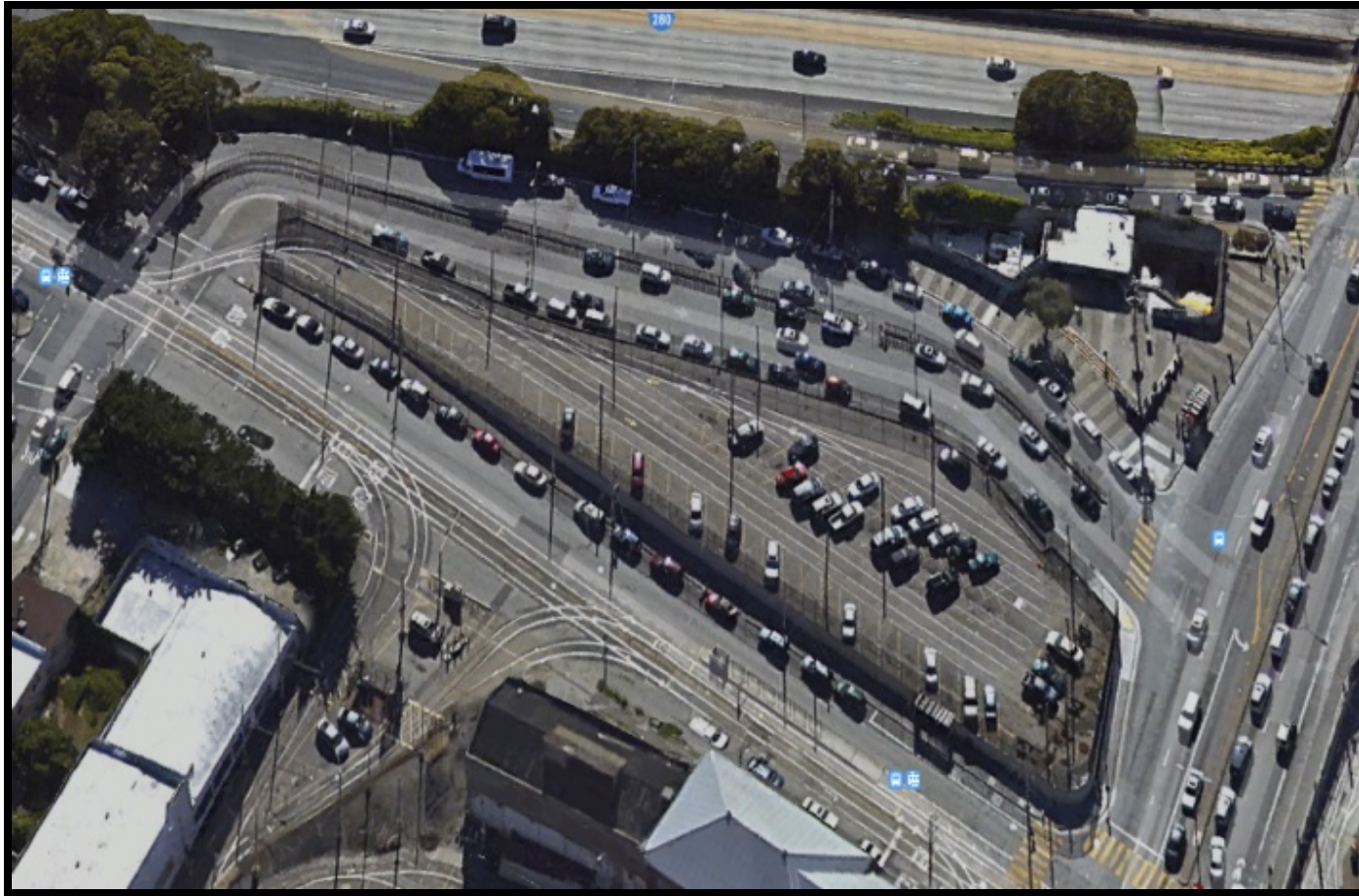
- 85-foot building height limit on corner, 45-foot on San Jose
- BART Zone of Influence (52.5 foot setback from tunnel)
- Zoned NCT-Neighborhood Commercial Transit

Program Potential:

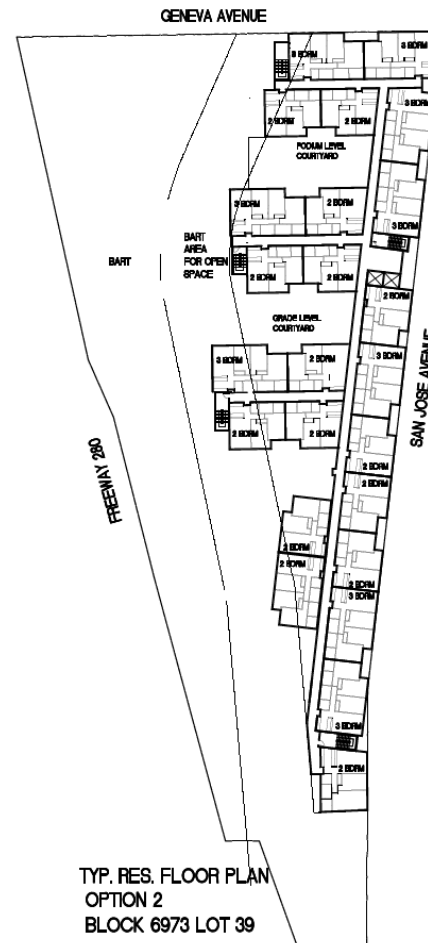
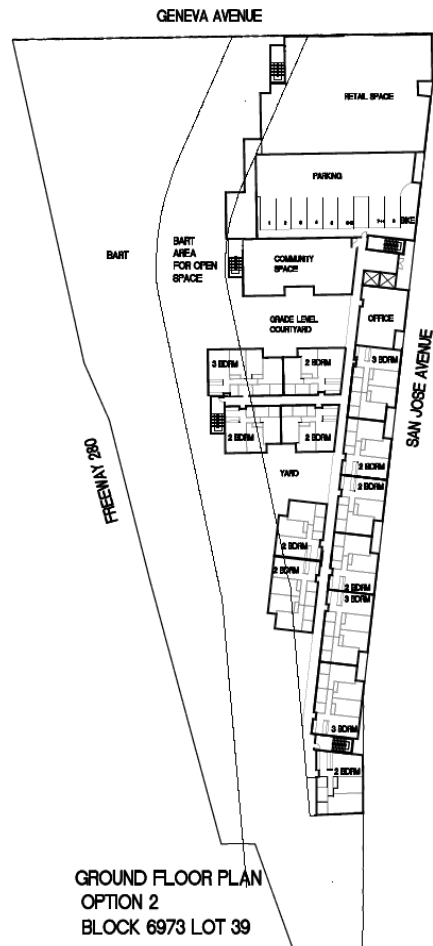
Population: Families? Transition-Age Youth (TAY)? Seniors?
