







#### Daily SF trips increase ~50,000 every year





#### Mode share – Drive trip distances

SFMTA needs to understand more about the drive trips that are being taken in order to keep driving at 50% or reduce it further.

Private Auto Trip Distance	SF (1,007)	Non-SF (7,212)
One mile or more	85%	97%
Less than one mile	15%	3%
Don't know/Don't remember	1%	<0.5%





I commute by bike	3%	3%	2%
I ride a few times a week	4%	5%	3%
I ride regularly	4%	5%	4%
I ride a few times a month	12%	6%	17%
I've taken a few trips [in the last year]	9%	10%	7%
I have not ridden a bike, but wanted to	23%	21%	26%
I have not ridden a bike and don't want to	45%	50%	41%
