## **Sloat & Skyline: Walking Tour**



Today we are going to observe the existing conditions at Sloat and Skyline for people walking, driving, biking, and riding transit. Your observations and input will help inform the upcoming design alternatives analysis as part of this project.

As you travel around the intersection, here are some questions to think about:

- Do I feel safe walking at this location? What if I were biking?
- Is it clear to me where I need to look for approaching vehicles?
- Are the pedestrian and transit facilities in good condition and accessible?
- If I were driving a car right here, would it be clear to me how to proceed through the intersection? What about if I were on a bicycle?
- As a driver, do I have visibility and space to see approaching pedestrians?

**Follow the numbered diagram to make your way through the intersection.** Begin at the southeast corner of the intersection and travel clockwise around it. Before crossing any travel lanes, check for oncoming vehicles.
