
PROJECT BACKGROUND

- Phase implementation








PROJECT BACKGROUND

Winter 2015: Focused Circulation Study

Spring 2016: Public Outreach – Permanent Design Concepts

Summer 2016: Environmental Review for Permanent Improvements

Fall 2016: Public Hearing for Permanent Improvements

2016 – 2017: Final Design for Permanent Improvements

2017: Construction of Permanent Improvements Begins
