Summer 2015:	Crosswalks, Painted Safety Zones, No Turn on Red, Signal Timing
Fall 2015:	<i>Curb Management Workshop</i>
Fall/Winter 2015:	Vehicle/Bicycle Lane Guidance and Signage
Winter 2015:	Focused Circulation Study
Spring 2016:	<i>Public Outreach – Permanent Design Concepts</i>
Summer 2016:	Environmental Review for Permanent Improvements
Fall 2016:	<i>Public Hearing for Permanent Improvements</i>
2016 – 2017:	Final Design for Permanent Improvements
2017:	Construction of Permanent Improvements Begins
