Polk Street, northbound and southbound, at Greenwich Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP

### 2. <u>ESTABLISH – UNMETERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING</u>

15<sup>th</sup> Street, north side, from 279 feet to 296 feet east of Folsom Street (17-foot zone for 4 motorcycle parking stalls)\*

#### 3. ESTABLISH – NO U-TURN

Portola Drive, eastbound, at Evelyn Way

#### 4. ESTABLISH – NO U-TURN

Geneva Avenue, eastbound, at Prague Street

### 5. <u>ESTABLISH – VEHICLES OVER 3 TONS PROHIBITED</u>

Miguel Street, between Laidley Street and Chenery Street

#### 6. ESTABLISH - TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING, 12 AM TO 6 AM, EVERY DAY

Crisp Road, both sides, between Revere Avenue and Quesada Avenue

### ESTABLISH – FLAG STOP

8th Avenue, east side, south of Judah Street

### 8. ESTABLISH – NO TURN ON RED

Quintara Street, eastbound and westbound, at 19th Avenue

### 9. ESTABLISH - NO PARKING ANYTIME

Whitney Street, west side, from Chenery Street to 15 feet northerly (as measured from the top of the curb ramp for a 6-foot wide bulb-out for a curb ramp and removes 1 unmetered parking space)

Items denoted with an asterisk (\*) can be approved by the City Traffic Engineer after the public hearing and such approval constitutes the CEQA **Approval Action** under S.F. Administrative Code Section 31.04(h). Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.
