




Water System Investments

- Water System Improvement Program (WSIP)
 - 87 Projects, Seven Counties
 - \$4.8 Billion, 95% Complete
- Continuous System Upgrades Needed
- Ongoing Pipe Repair and Replacement, 15 Miles/Year



Geary Boulevard Sewer and Water Improvements





San Francisco
Water Power Sewer

- Rehabilitation or replacement of approximately 1.5 miles of aging sewers
- No service disruption
- A mix of trenchless rehabilitation and open cut construction





Water Line Work





- Replacement of approximately 2 miles of aging water mains
- Some disruption in service is expected
- Open cut construction





- Sponsored by the DigOnce program (Department of Technology) and MTA
- Installation of 1.75 miles of fiber optic conduit
- Conduits will be used for future fiber optic cables to provide internet services and connect traffic signals












Recent Outreach: Cherry Blossom Festival

At both open houses and design showcases:


- Notification: radius mailing, signs posted in corridor, in-person outreach to CBOs/neighborhood organizations, door to door outreach, email and website announcements

- Materials presented allow stakeholders to learn project goals, how proposals affect them, and get questions answered from project staff


Upcoming Outreach: Bus Stop Changes surveys




- 4 week campaign

- Supplemental way to seek bus stop change specific feedback


