- (10.5) Approving Amendment #5 to Contract No. SFMTA-2008/9-52, Red Light Camera Automated Photo Enforcement Program, with Conduent State and Local Solutions, Inc. to increase the contract amount by \$400,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$9,900,000 and no extension of time. (Explanatory documents include a staff report, amendment and resolution.)
