
740,900

Almost three-quarters of a million GoBike trips were taken in San Francisco between the expansion launch in July 2017 and March 2018.







SAN FRANCISCO GOBIKE MEMBERSHIP



Gobike is primarily used by San Francisco residents!

As of April 2018, GoBike had 4,744 membership subscriptions (annual or monthly). About 80% of GoBike trips, were taken by members (annual or monthly) between July 2017 and April 2018. Only 20% of trips were taken by causal users (with a day or single ride pass).

GOBIKE USERS ARE MOST LIKELY TO TAKE TRIPS DURING COMMUTE HOURS (8 AM - 10 AM AND 5 PM - 7 PM).
