ESTABLISH – GREEN METERS, <u>30 15-MINUTE PARKING LIMIT,</u>

9AM TO 6PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

1410 Franklin Street, east side, from 20 feet to 100 feet north of Sutter Street, at metered stalls no. 1404, 1406, 1408 and 1410 (80-foot zone)

-Comments received. Reviewed by the City Traffic Engineer, amended and forwarded for implementation by directive 6196.

<u>ESTABLISH – METERED YELLOW ZONE, COMMERCIAL LOADING, 30-MINUTE TIME LIMIT,</u> <u>7AM TO 6PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY</u>

222 Taylor Street, east side, from 108 feet to 150 feet south of Ellis Street, at metered stalls no. 218 and 216 (42-foot zone)

-No opposition received. Approved by the City Traffic Engineer and forwarded for implementation by directive 6196.

ESTABLISH – WHITE ZONE, PASSENGER LOADING

7:30AM TO 9:30AM AND 3:30PM TO 5:30PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

548 Delta Street, west side, from Leland Avenue to 60 feet northerly and from 70 feet to 114 feet northerly (104-foot zone)

ESTABLISH – YELLOW ZONE, COMMERCIAL LOADING, 30-MINUTE TIME LIMIT, 9AM TO 6PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

"2393" Sacramento Street, south side, from 37 feet to 81 feet east of Webster Street (44-foot zone) -No opposition received. Approved by the City Traffic Engineer and forwarded for implementation by directive 6196.

ESTABLISH – WHITE ZONE, PASSENGER LOADING AT ALL TIMES

455 Mission Bay Boulevard South, south side, from 124 feet to 164 feet east of 3rd Street, at metered stalls no. 425 and 427 (40-foot zone)

ESTABLISH – YELLOW ZONE, COMMERCIAL LOADING, 30-MINUTE TIME LIMIT, 7AM TO 1PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

California Street, north side, from 26 feet to 70 feet east of Locust Street replacing metered stall no. 3456-Q.

ESTABLISH – GREEN METER, 15-MINUTE PARKING,

9AM TO 6PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

California Street, north side, from 70 feet to 92 feet east of Locust Street at metered stall no. 3454. -Comments received. Reviewed by the City Traffic Engineer and forwarded for further evaluation.

California Street, south side, from 17th Avenue to 10 feet westerly (10-foot zone)

California Street, south side, from 10 feet to 32 feet westerly (22-foot zone)
