

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) is a leader in providing and regulating environmentally sustainable transportation options, including the taxi fleet. Over 90% vehicles used in the taxi fleet are low-emission and play a critical role in meeting the city's ambitious climate goals of 80% of trips taken by sustainable means of travel by 2030 and zero emissions by 2050. In order achieve our goals, the SFMTA's clean air taxi program offers a rebate up to \$3,500 per qualifying vehicle with a total of \$350,000\* in dedicated funding.

## The rebate is only for the following eligible vehicle types purchased since July 1, 2016:

- **\$2,500** for each hybrid vehicle
- **\$2,500** for each compressed natural gas (CNG) vehicle
- **\$3,500** for each Accessible CNG vehicle
- **\$3,500** for each electric or hydrogen fuel cell vehicle

## To request a rebate, please provide the following documents:

- Vehicle Registration (not temporary registration)
- Copy of sales invoice or purchase order
- IRS Form W-9
- For large cab company fleet purchases, a spreadsheet listing each vehicle's make, model, year, fuel type, VIN, and date vehicle was put in service as a taxicab
