


Harvey Milk Plaza lies in the heart of the Castro neighborhood at the intersection of Castro and Market Streets, and adjacent to Castro Muni Station. As a public gathering space, landmark, and transit hub, Harvey Milk Plaza holds a special place in the community.

The proposed accessibility improvements at the Plaza are targeted to address the challenging and non-ADA compliant grading at street-level, and the lack of a three-stop elevator that serves the Muni Station below. The new elevator and accessible paths, along with other much needed improvements such as better lighting and security, will contribute to the goal of providing a safe, user-friendly, and inviting public gathering space in the heart of the Castro community.

Below is a summary of proposed improvements



- 2. Widen sidewalk at Market Street bus stop to create a safer pedestrian path
- 3. Replace existing pedestrian light fixtures along guardrails
- 4. Provide opportunity to widen the Plaza by removing existing planters
- 5. Establish a direct and accessible connection from Plaza to elevator entrance
- 6. Position elevator at an ideal location to integrate with Plaza improvements
- 7. Provide opportunities for public art that celebrates the legacy of Harvey Milk and history of the community



2. MEZZANINE / CONCOURSE LEVEL




- 2. Improve security fencing to integrate with elevator and to create a safer station
