## **Event & Outreach Updates**

#### What We've Been Up To

Ongoing: In-depth stakeholder engagement, including monthly meetings with the Potrero Yard Neighborhood Working Group.

June 2020: Held two community conversations about the project concept and Request for Qualifications (RFQ).

August 2020: Issued project's RFO, the first part of the developer selection process.

September 2020: Held CEQA public scoping meeting led by the SF Planning Department to review areas of analysis in the Environmental

Now: Creating project's Request for Proposals (RFP), the second part of the developer selection process. The RFP will include urban design, housing, and public benefits principles developed in partnership with the Neighborhood Working Group.

Now: Establishing rules for a long-term agreement with developer.

Look Ahead: Distribute RFP in early 2021 so up to three qualifying developer teams can produce project proposals that will be reviewed by an evaluation committee.

Look Ahead: Produce a Racial Equity Assessment to uplift equitable consequences of the project.

#### En qué hemos estado trabajando

En curso: Participación a fondo de las partes interesadas, lo que incluye reuniones mensuales con el Grupo de Trabajo del Vecindario sobre Potrero Yard.

Junio 2020: Tuvimos dos reuniones con la comunidad sobre el concepto del proyecto y la Solicitud de Calificaciones (RFQs).

Agosto 2020: Se emitió una Solicitud de Calificaciones del proyecto, que es la primera parte del proceso de selección de la Empresa de Desarrollo Urbano.

Septiembre 2020: Se llevó a cabo una reunión pública sobre la Ley de Calidad Ambiental de California (CEQA) dirigida por el Departamente de Planificación de SF para revisar las áreas por analizar en el Informe de Impacto Ambiental.

Actualmente: Se está creando la Solicitud de Propuestas (RFPs) del proyecto, que es la segunda parte del proceso de selección de la Empresa de Desarrollo Urbano. Las RFPs incluirán los principios del diseño urbano, la vivienda y los beneficios al público que fueron desarrollados en asociación con el Grupo de Trabajo del Vecindario,

Actualmente: Se esán estableciendo reglas para formar acuerdos de largo plazo con el desarrollador.

En el futuro: A principios de 2021, se distribuirá la RFP para que hasta tres equipos de las empresas de desarrollo urbano calificadas creen sus propuestas sobre el proyecto, las cuales serán evaluadas por el comité.

En el futuro: Se hará una Evaluación sobre la Equidad Racial para mejorar las consecuencias que tendrá sobre la equidad del proyecto.

#### RFQ & RFP Process

- Released RFQ at end of August 2020
- Received Statements of Qualification in November 2020
- Assembled RFQ/RFP scoring panel to review submissions

#### WG Subcommittees

- Housing: held in-depth discussions regarding housing, affordable housing, land use compatibility, employee housing, and how the project can contribute to community stabilization
- Public Benefits: convened multiple conversations regarding public benefit priorities, culminating in the Public Benefit Principles document to attach to the RFP
- Ground Floor Use/Urban Design: met and organized members' urban design and architectural priorities, reviewed and provided detailed comments to the Urban Design Guidelines, and completed prioritization exercise for ground floor active uses
