





Phases 1C and 1D almost complete.



- BRT Buildout Phase in progress
 - Construction of median islands, bus shelters, bulb-outs
 - Installation of red transit lanes, pole setting



- Directed Business Support Program re-opened
 - Funding of \$5,000-10,000 available to eligible businesses; deadline now January 31, 2021.
- Corridor marketing plan being presented to Business Advisory Committee

Geary Rapid Project

As part of the <u>Geary Rapid Project</u>, work to replace aging water lines, in coordination with San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, continues. Surface transportation improvements, including upgraded traffic signals and streetlights, sidewalk extensions at bus stops and intersection corners, improved median refuges and roadway repaving, are also underway and are being managed by San Francisco Public Works.
