ESTABLISH - PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 8AM TO 68PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

450 Guerrero Street, west side, from 10 feet to 94 feet north of the south property line (84-foot zone)

<u>ESTABLISH – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 7:30AM TO 10AM AND 3PM TO 6PM, MONDAY</u> THROUGH FRIDAY

722 South Van Ness Avenue, west side, from 18 feet to 62 feet north of the south property line (44-foot zone)
