

PROPOSAL / REQUEST: ESTABLISH - CLASS 2 BIKE LANE Geneva Avenue, both directions, between Prague Street and Brookdale Avenue (Supervisor District 10 & 11) Upgrade narrow shoulders to 5 foot bike lane in both directions by narrowing existing traffic lanes. No changes to parking and no change to the number of lanes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION / COMMENTS - Existing condition is 2 to 5 feet shoulder on this segment of Geneva, with sharrows in the curb lane. - Converts existing Class 3 bike facility to a Class 2. Connects to existing Class 2 facilities at both ends of the project limits. No impact to on-street parking supply. No reduction in the number of traffic lanes. Proposed design matches SFMTA design proposal in 2017 for award and retention of ATP grant funds. Class 4 bike facility infeasible given the number and frequency of residential driveways (every 20-feet) along this ½ mile project length. - Adjacent to Crocker Amazon Playground (major recreation area with 5 soccer fields) and McLaren Park -Lane widths meet Muni and bike lane standards. Design reviewed and approved by Livable Streets and Transit Engineering.


Bike Map

Propose to upgrade wide shoulder to bike lane




Muni Map






Map of Approved and Proposed Temporary Transit Lanes







