ACCESSIBLE MEETING POLICY

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Policy and Governance Committee meeting will meet in the Union Square conference Room at One South Van Ness Avenue, 7th Floor, San Francisco, CA. The closest accessible BART station is the Civic Center Station at United Nations Plaza and Market Street. Members of the Committee will attend this meeting in-person. Members of the public are invited to observe the meeting in-person or remotely online as described below. Members of the public attending the meeting in person will have an opportunity to provide public comment on every item.

In addition to in-person public comment, the Committee will hear up to ten minutes of remote public comment on each agenda item. The Council will hear remote public comment on each item in the order that commenters add themselves to the queue to comment on the item. Because of the 10-minute time limit, it is possible that not every person in the queue will have an opportunity to provide remote public comment. Remote public comment from people who have received an accommodation due to will not count toward the 10-minute limit.

Union Square Conference Room is wheelchair accessible. Remote public participation is available upon request for individuals who cannot attend in person due to disability.
