9th Street, east side, from Market Street to 95 feet southerly

ESTABLISH – FARMER'S MARKET PERMIT PARKING, 6 AM TO 9:30 AM, WEDNESDAYS

Leavenworth Street, 50-100 Block, east side, between Golden Gate Avenue and McAllister Street, at seven (7) general meter parking spaces # 60, 62, 66, 70, 72, 74, and 76

ESTABLISH – 30 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT

Winston Drive between Buckingham Way and Lake Merced Boulevard (existing speed limit is 25 miles per hour)

ESTABLISH – CROSSWALK CLOSURE
