

# SAN FRANCISCO MUNICIPAL TRANSPORTATION AGENCY Order # 5138 FOR PUBLIC HEARING

The Sustainable Streets Division of the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing on Friday, August 16, 2013, at 10:00 AM, in Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, CA 94102, to consider the following proposals:

#### 1. <u>ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA N, 2-HOUR PARKING,</u> <u>9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY</u>

12<sup>th</sup> Avenue, both sides, between Balboa and Cabrillo Streets (600 Block) Balboa Street, both sides, between 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Funston Street (1100 Block) Cabrillo Street, both sides, between 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Funston Street (1100 Block)

#### 2. ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN

Munich Street, at Excelsior Avenue, stopping the stem of this "T" intersection

#### 3. <u>ESTABLISH – RED ZONE</u>

Evelyn Way, east side, from Juanita Way to 35 feet southerly

# 4(a). ESTABLISH – BIKE SHUTTLE PARKING, 6 AM TO 9 AM and 4 PM TO 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

Folsom Street, south side, between Fremont Street and Zeno Place (63-foot zone, removes meters #327 and 325)

# 4(b). ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO PARKING, 5:30 AM TO 11 PM, EXCEPT BUSES

Folsom Street, south side, from Beale Street to 80 feet westerly (4 meters #301 through 307) (Temporary due to construction at 201 Folsom Street from August 2013 to February 2014)

## 4(c). ESTABLISH - TOW-AWAY NO PARKING, 6 AM TO 9 AM, 4 PM to 7 PM, EXCEPT BUSES

Folsom Street, south side, from Beale Street to 80 feet westerly (4 meters #301 through 307) (Temporary due to construction at 201 Folsom Street from February 2014 to summer 2016)

### 5. REVOKE - LEFT LANE MUST TURN LEFT

Folsom Street, northbound, approaching 19<sup>th</sup> Street

#### 6. ESTABLISH – STOP SIGNS

45<sup>th</sup> Avenue, at Ortega Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP



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The following items were environmentally cleared by the San Francisco Planning Department on June 17, 2013, Case Number 2013.0807E.

#### 7(a). ESTABLISH – TRAFFIC ISLANDS (CURBSIDE)

Taraval Street, south side, from 46<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 25 feet westerly\*

Taraval Street, south side, from 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 40 feet easterly\*

Taraval Street, south side, from 47th Avenue to 25 feet westerly\*

Taraval Street, south side, from 48th Avenue to 25 feet easterly\*

Taraval Street, north side, from 46th Avenue to 60 feet westerly\*

Taraval Street, north side, from 47th Avenue to 30 feet easterly\*

Taraval Street, north side, from 47th Avenue to 55 feet westerly\*

Taraval Street, north side, from 48th Avenue to 60 feet easterly\*

Taraval Street, between 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Great Highway Frontage Road (this 30-foot diameter traffic circle is one of two options for a gateway treatment on the west end of the project alignment)

### 7(b). ESTABLISH - PERPENDICULAR PARKING

Taraval Street, north side, from 46<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue Taraval Street, south side, from 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue

The purpose of traffic engineering hearings for the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) Sustainable Streets Division is for residents to express their concerns regarding the posted parking and traffic changes affecting their streets. At the hearing, the public hearing officer, after reviewing the items and listening to residents, will make a decision as to whether the items are approved or not. Any interested parties are encouraged to attend.
