17th Street Quick-Build Project

The 17th Street Quick-Build Project was approved by the San Work continues on the 17th Street Quick-Build Project. During May, SFMTA paint shop crew members began striping the new design onto the roadway. Work includes new striping for floating parking, green bike lane paint, and the addition of vertical deflection in the form of flex posts and rubber curbs. The crew is moving block-by-block with temporary signs posted alerting neighbors of temporary parking restrictions as the work progresses. Substantial work has been installed on 17th street from Mississippi Street to Carolina Street this month.


Oak Street Quick-Build Project

The Oak Street Quick-Build project team spent the afternoon on Bike to Wherever Day, talking to people in the Panhandle about the proposed changes for this vital connection in San Francisco's active transportation network. The project proposes a protected eastbound bikeway connecting to the existing bike lane east of Baker Street on Oak Street and complements the existing westbound facilities on Fell Street. The popular Panhandle shared-use path can be crowded at peak times. An alternative eastbound bikeway will create space for people walking and families riding together by offering a parallel facility for faster users and commuters. The project will also improve the safety of walking across the busy Oak Street and better connect Golden Gate Park, the Panhandle, and surrounding neighborhoods.

Frida Kahlo Way Quick Build Project

The Frida Kahlo Way Quick-Build Project was unanimously approved by the SFMTA Board of Directors on May 7, 2024. The SFMTA Board requested that project staff return in one year of implementation to provide an update, including evaluation metrics for the project and an update about transit passes for City College of San Francisco students. Construction has begun and will be substantially completed during the summer recess of City College and Riordan High School. Temporary parking restrictions and bus stop relocations will be in effect during the project's construction phase. Approved changes include adding a two-way protected bikeway, building bus boarding islands, transit stop changes, and parking and loading changes.
