Jonathan Rewers, Manager, Capital Finance & Programs, discussed the Capital Improvement Program for FY 2013-2015. Mr. Rewers stated the goals and objectives of the agency and five-year funding sources plan.

Terrie Williams, Deputy Director, Finance Budget & Grants, discussed the SFMTA Operating budget that was presented to the SFMTA Board. Ms. Williams stated that fares and operating grants have gone up, while parking and traffic fees have gone down. Ms. Williams stated that revenue sources were introduced to the Board.

Edward Mason commented on the MTC's funding allocation to smaller bay area transit agencies. Mr. Mason stated that city supervisors need to support modification of the funding allocation for vehicles from the MTC. Mr. Mason commented on looking at generating revenue sources from foodlets and commuter buses.
