

Sustainable Streets Division Directive Order No. 6816

Pursuant to the public hearing held on September 20, 2024, traffic movement and safety may be improved by the changes approved below. The Environmental Clearance for these items is noted on Order No. 6809.

1. ESTABLISH – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA I (Eligibility only, no signs) 3200-3249 block of 17th Street (Supervisor District 9) (Requires approval by the SFMTA Board) Lulu Brien, lulu.brien@sfmta.com

The proposed modification would add RPP eligibility to the residents of the 3200-3249 block of 17th Street between Capp Street and South Van Ness (Except for addresses already in RPP Area I) so they can purchase parking permits for their vehicle to park within RPP Area I.

This change is requested by a signed petition from the residents of 1-99 block of Woodacre Drive. This proposal changes current parking regulation on Woodacre Drive to conform with restrictions on nearby RPP Area H.
