Pursuant to San Francisco Transportation Code, Division II, Article 1100, Section 1113(s)(1), all San Francisco Taxis and Ramp Taxis shall be inspected every six months if they are used as spare vehicles, have 200,000 miles or more on the odometer, or if the vehicle is older than nine Model Years, and every 12 months for regular vehicles. Pursuant to 1113(s)(1)(B), a 19-point inspection must be conducted by an inspection station certified by the State of California.
