- D. RESCIND MUNI FLAG STOP Innes Avenue, south side, west of Donahue Street. **PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.**
- E. ESTABLISH TOW AWAY NO STOPPING ANY TIME 11<sup>th</sup> Street, west side, from 147 feet to 170 feet south of Market Street; 11<sup>th</sup> Street, west side, from 196 feet to 227 feet south of Market Street; and 11<sup>th</sup> Street, west side, from 262 feet to 325 feet south of Market Street. - F. ESTABLISH PARALLEL PARKING 11<sup>th</sup> Street, west side, from 100 feet to 224 feet north of Mission Street. **PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.**
- G. ESTABLISH TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING EXCEPT PERMITTED CAR SHARE VEHICLES – 11<sup>th</sup> Street, east side, from 67 feet to 11 feet north of Mission Street (44-foot zone for 2 car share parking permit spaces--C500 & C501). PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.
- H. ESTABLISH RED ZONE 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, south side, from Arkansas Street to 25 feet westerly; 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, south side, from Arkansas Street to 60 feet easterly; and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, south side, from west Arkansas Street curb line to 40 feet easterly (between crosswalks). PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.
- I. ESTABLISH STOP SIGNS 23rd Street, eastbound and westbound, at Arkansas Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP. **PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.**
- J. ESTABLISH STOP SIGNS 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, southbound and eastbound, at Dakota Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP. **PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.**

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- K. ESTABLISH RED ZONE 23rd Street, south side, from 23<sup>rd</sup> Street/Dakota Street to 100 feet westerly. **PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.**
- L. ESTABLISH MUNI FLAG STOP 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, south side, west of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street/Dakota Street. **PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.**
- M. RESCIND MUNI FLÅG STOP –Dakota Street, south side, east of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street. PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.
- N. ESTABLISH STOP SIGN Watchman Street, westbound, at Missouri Street, stopping the stem of this "T" intersection. **PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.**
- O. ESTABLISH RED ZONE Missouri Street, west side, from Watchman Street to 65 feet southerly; Watchman Street, south side, from Missouri Street to 140 feet easterly; and Watchman Street, north side, from Missouri Street to 100 feet easterly. PH 9/2/16 Requested by SFMTA.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW**

The proposed parking and traffic modifications are subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301 provides an exemption from environmental review for operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities.

The San Francisco Planning Department determined that the proposed parking and traffic modifications are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301. The proposed action is the Approval Action as defined by S. F. Administrative Code Chapter 31.

Copies of the CEQA determinations are on file with the Secretary to the SFMTA Board of Directors, and may be found in the records of the Planning Department at 1650 Mission Street in San Francisco, and are incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency has received a request, or identified a need for traffic modifications as follows:

- A. ESTABLISH RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA W, 2 HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH W PERMITS – Potrero Avenue, eastside, between Mariposa Street and 18<sup>th</sup> Street.

- C. ESTABLISH BUS ZONE Donahue Street, west side, from Innes Avenue to 100 feet northerly; and Donahue Street, east side, from Innes Avenue to 80 feet northerly.
- D. RESCIND MUNI FLAG STOP Innes Avenue, south side, west of Donahue Street.
- E. ESTABLISH TOW AWAY NO STOPPING ANY TIME 11<sup>th</sup> Street, west side, from 147 feet to 170 feet south of Market Street; 11<sup>th</sup> Street, west side, from 196 feet to 227 feet south of Market Street; and 11<sup>th</sup> Street, west side, from 262 feet to 325 feet south of Market Street.
- F. ESTABLISH PARALLEL PARKING 11<sup>th</sup> Street, west side, from 100 feet to 224 feet north of Mission Street.
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- H. ESTABLISH RED ZONE 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, south side, from Arkansas Street to 25 feet westerly; 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, south side, from Arkansas Street to 60 feet easterly; and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, south side, from west Arkansas Street curb line to 40 feet easterly (between crosswalks).
- I. ESTABLISH STOP SIGNS 23rd Street, eastbound and westbound, at Arkansas Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP.
- J. ESTABLISH STOP SIGNS 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, southbound and eastbound, at Dakota Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP.
- K. ESTABLISH RED ZONE 23rd Street, south side, from 23<sup>rd</sup> Street/Dakota Street to 100 feet westerly.
- L. ESTABLISH MUNI FLAG STOP 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, south side, west of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street/Dakota Street.
- M. RESCIND MUNI FLAG STOP Dakota Street, south side, east of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street.
- N. ESTABLISH STOP SIGN Watchman Street, westbound, at Missouri Street, stopping the stem of this "T" intersection.
- O. ESTABLISH RED ZONE Missouri Street, west side, from Watchman Street to 65 feet southerly; Watchman Street, south side, from Missouri Street to 140 feet easterly; and Watchman Street, north side, from Missouri Street to 100 feet easterly.

WHEREAS, The proposed parking and traffic modifications are subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301 provide an exemption from environmental review for operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities; and, WHEREAS, The SFMTA, under authority delegated by the Planning Department, determined that the proposed parking and traffic modifications are exempt from environmental review pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301; and

WHEREAS, The proposed action is the Approval Action as defined by the S.F. Administrative Code Chapter 31; and,

WHEREAS, Copies of the CEQA determinations are on file with the Secretary to the SFMTA Board of Directors, and may be found in the records of the Planning Department at 1650 Mission Street in San Francisco, and are incorporated herein by reference; and,

WHEREAS, The public has been notified about the proposed modifications and has been given the opportunity to comment on those modifications through the public hearing process; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors, upon recommendation of the Director of Transportation and the Director of the Sustainable Streets Division approves the changes.
