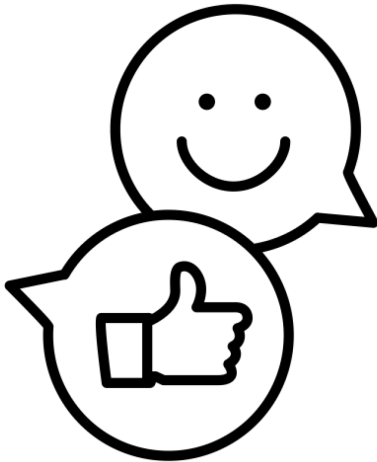

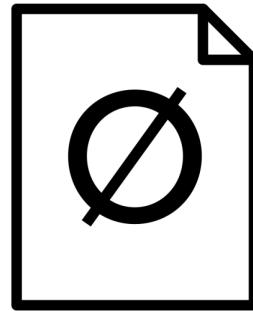


The goal of the 7th & 8th Streets Safety Project is to increase safety and comfort for everyone.

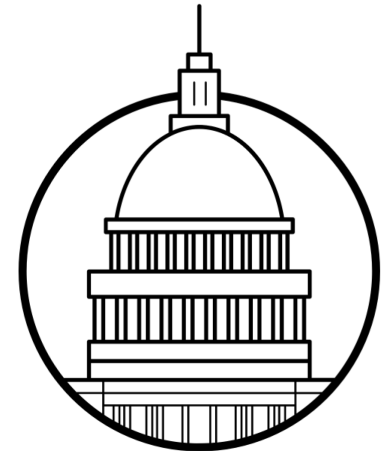

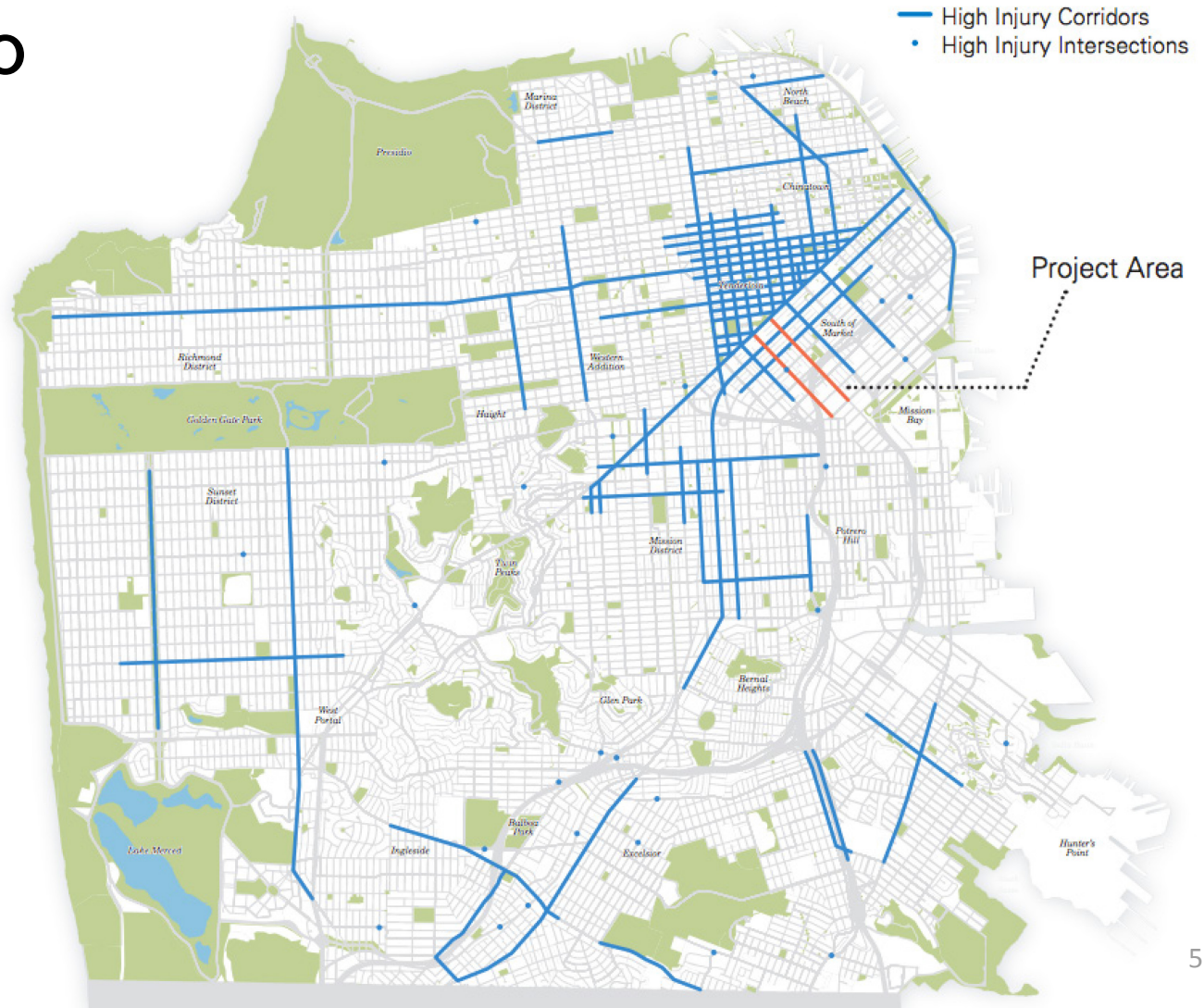

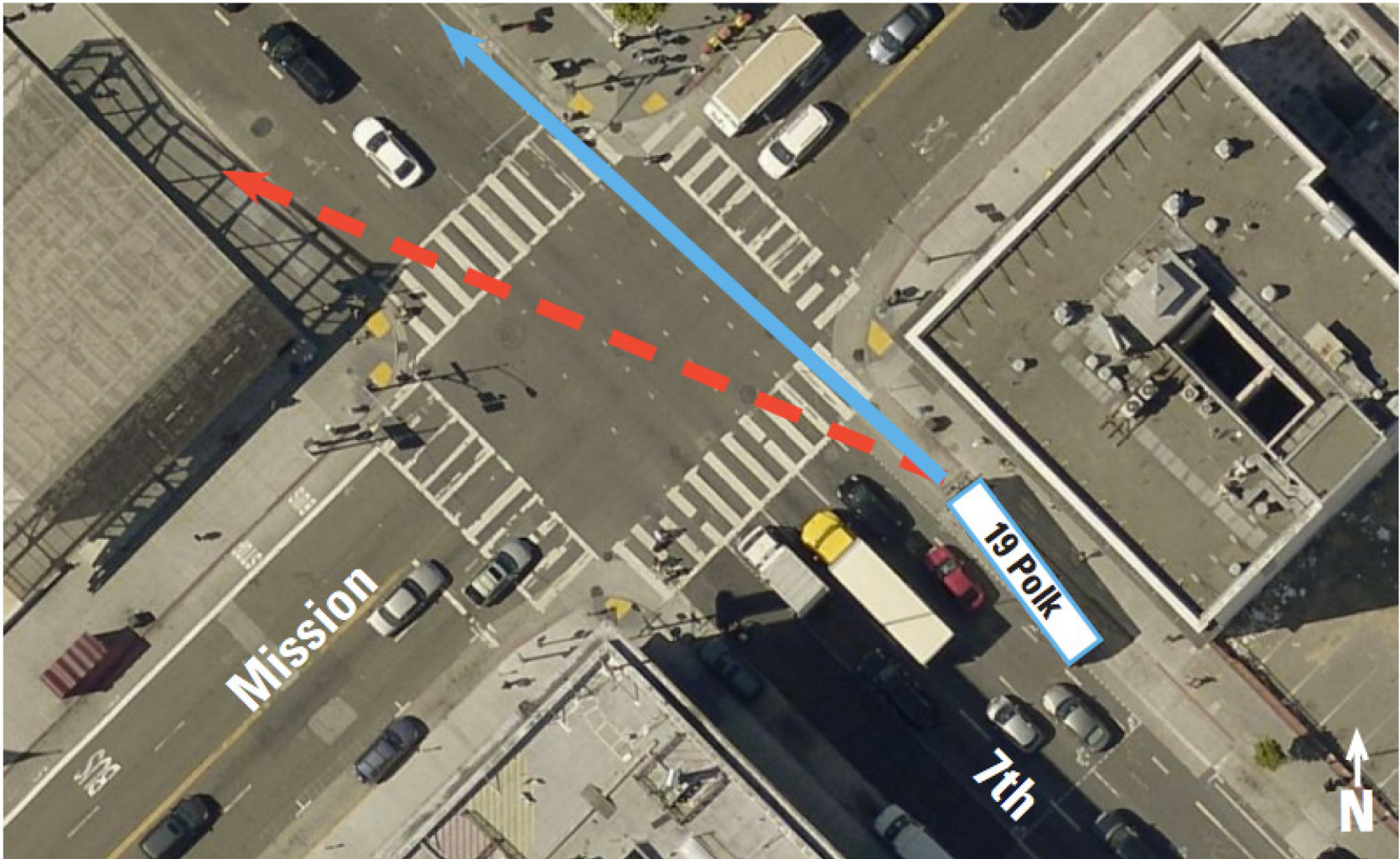

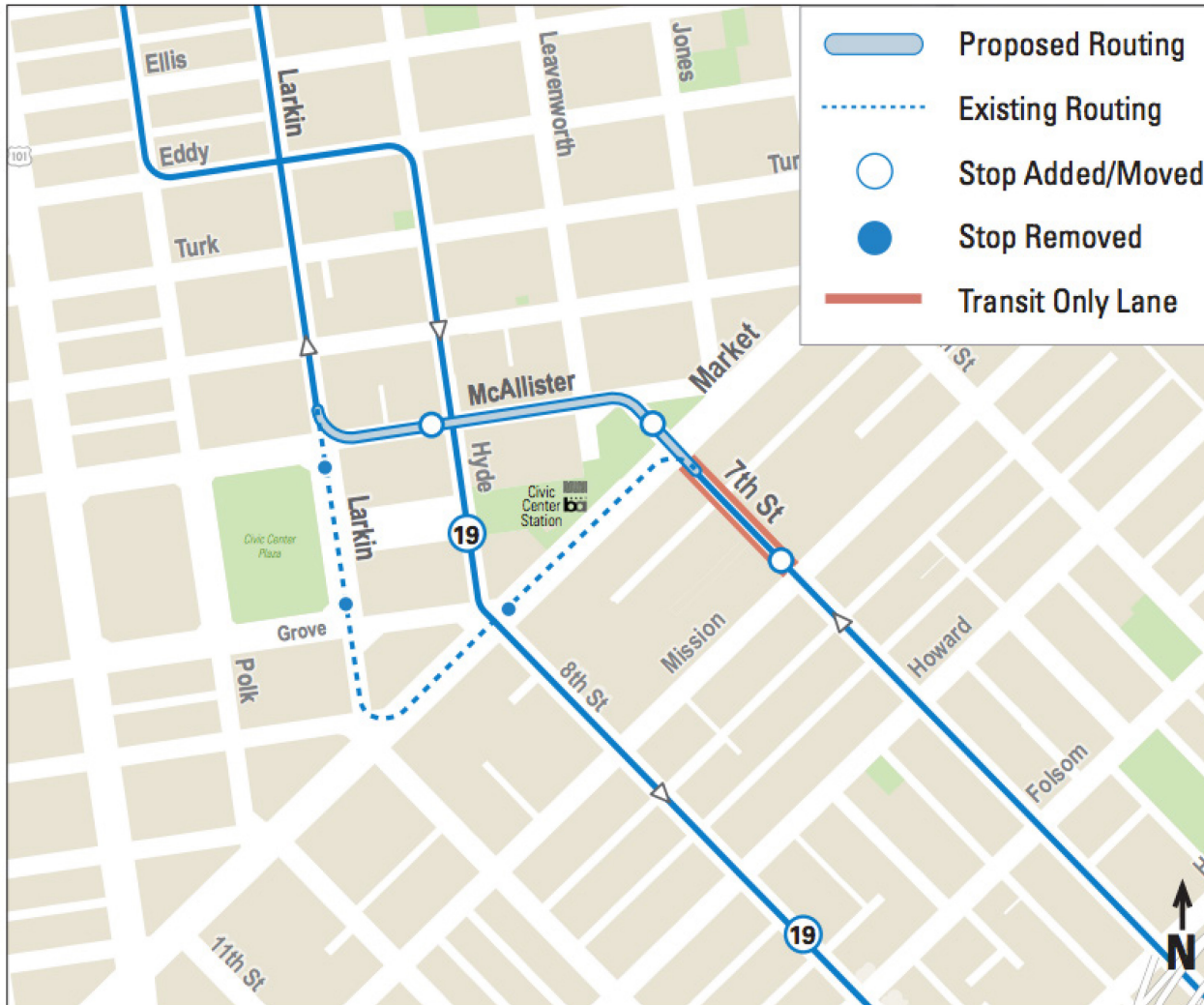
