

### **Construction Update**

#### **COMPLETE:**

- Storm drain relocation on eastbound Geneva Avenue.
- Sidewalk widening and concrete bus pad on eastbound Geneva Avenue.
- Median island relocation and widening.

#### **CURRENTLY IN PROGRESS:**

- Sidewalk widening and concrete bus pad on westbound Geneva Avenue.
- Median Island landscaping.
- Curb ramp upgrades.
- Pedestrian Lighting.







### **Moving Forward**

#### **NEXT STEPS:**

- Ocean Ave I-280 flashing beacon work to improve pedestrian safety.
  - Flashing beacons
  - Base repair
  - Grinding & paving
- Geneva Ave pavement restoration between I-280 and San Jose Ave.
- Red Transit Lanes on Geneva Ave to improve transit service and reliability.





#### **NEXT STEPS:**


- Relocation of J/K Trolley Poles to improve walkway safety and accessibility.
- Ocean Ave I-280 North on-ramp intersection work.

  - Curb ramp upgrades
  - Track replacement and tamping
  - Pedestrian lighting
  - Pavement restoration








**Construction Phasing Plan**


#### I-280 Off-Ramp Overnight Work





Ocean Ave Work, 3-Weeks




## Moving Forward – Transit Impacts Current Routes




