RESOLUTION No. 170516-060

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency has received a request, or identified a need for traffic modifications as follows:

- A. ESTABLISH BIKE LANE Bosworth Street, westbound, from 225 feet east of Elk Street to Bosworth Street/O'Shaughnessy Path (Class II Bikeway).
- B. ESTABLISH SIDEWALK WIDENING 1st Street, east side, from Mission Street to 20 feet northerly (5-foot wide bulb); 1st Street, west side, from Minna Street to Mission Street (2-foot sidewalk widening); Fremont Street, west side, from Mission Street to 14 feet northerly (5-foot wide bulb); Mission Street, north side, from 1st Street to Fremont Street (2-foot sidewalk widening); Mission Street, north side, from 275 feet to 389 feet west of 1st Street (4-foot wide bulb); and Mission Street, south side, from 338 feet to 389 feet west of 1st Street (4-foot wide bulb).
- C. ESTABLISH NO PARKING ANYTIME Mission Street, north side, from 283 feet to 401 feet west of 1st Street (removes 6 spaces #538, #540, #542, #544, #546, #548) Mission Street, south side, from 335 feet to 401 feet west of 1st Street (removes 3 spaces #539, #541, #545).
- D. ESTABLISH MIDBLOCK TRAFFIC SIGNAL Mission Street, at Shaw Alley.
- E. ESTABLISH RED ZONE Teresita Boulevard, west side, from 9 feet to 31 feet north of Marietta Drive (North) curb ramp.
- F. ESTABLISH RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA N, 2-HOUR PARKING, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA N PERMIT –Balboa Street, both sides, between 8th Avenue and 9th Avenue (700 block).
- G. ESTABLISH RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA L, 2-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA L PERMIT 4th Avenue, both sides, between Anza Street and Balboa Street (500 block).
- H. ESTABLISH RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA L, 2-HOUR PARKING, 8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, EXCEPT VEHICLES WITH AREA L PERMITS 6th Avenue, both sides, between Cabrillo Street and Fulton Street (700 block).
- I. ESTABLISH RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA Z ELIGIBILITY 3814 and 3820 24th Street.
- J. ESTABLISH NO TURN ON RED Market Street, eastbound, at 10th Street.
- K. RESCIND TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING EXCEPT PERMITTED CAR SHARE VEHICLES 20th Street, north side, from Connecticut Street to 40 feet westerly (40-foot zone, for 2 car share parking permits: Z067 and Z143).
- L. ESTABLISH TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING EXCEPT PERMITTED CAR SHARE VEHICLES – 20th Street, north side, from Missouri Street to 40 feet easterly (40-foot zone, for 2 car share parking permits: Z067 and Z143).
- M. ESTABLISH BLUE ZONE 20th Street, north side, from Connecticut Street to 20 feet westerly.

WHEREAS, The proposed parking and traffic modifications are subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301 provides an exemption from environmental review for operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has determined that the proposed parking and traffic modifications in Item A and Items E-M are exempt from CEQA (Planning Case Nos. 2016-015072ENV, 2017-002114ENV, 2017-004249ENV, 2017-003602ENV, 2017-002463ENV) pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301; The proposed action is the Approval Action for Item A and Items E-N as defined by the S.F. Administrative Code Chapter 31; and

WHEREAS, The Transit Center District Plan and Transit Tower Final Environmental Impact Report (TCDP FEIR) evaluated the environmental impacts of the proposed parking and traffic modifications in Items B-D; the Transit Center District Plan and Transit Tower Final Environmental Impact Report (TCDP FEIR) evaluated the environmental impacts of the proposed parking and traffic modifications in Items B-D; on May 24, 2012, the San Francisco Planning Commission in Motions 18628 and 18629 adopted the Transit Center District Plan (TCDP), certified its Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR), and adopted findings including a statement of overriding considerations and a mitigation monitoring and reporting program pursuant to CEQA; on September 7, 2012, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors in Ordinance 185-12 adopted the Transit Center District Plan; and

WHEREAS, On March 3, 2017, the Planning Department reviewed the proposed streetscape improvements described in Items B-D and determined that they are within the scope of the TCDP FEIR; no new significant effects have been identified, there is no substantial increase in significant effects already identified, and no new mitigation is required for the project; the SFMTA Board of Directors has subsequently reviewed the TCDP FEIR and CEQA Findings and the SFMTA Board of Directors adopts these findings as its own; and

WHEREAS, Copies of the CEQA determinations, Planning Commission Resolution, and CEQA Findings are on file with the Secretary to the SFMTA Board of Directors, and may be found in the records of the Planning Department at 1650 Mission Street in San Francisco, and are incorporated herein by reference; and,

WHEREAS, The public has been notified about the proposed modifications and has been given the opportunity to comment on those modifications through the public hearing process; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors, upon recommendation of the Director of Transportation and the Director of the Sustainable Streets Division approves the changes.
