



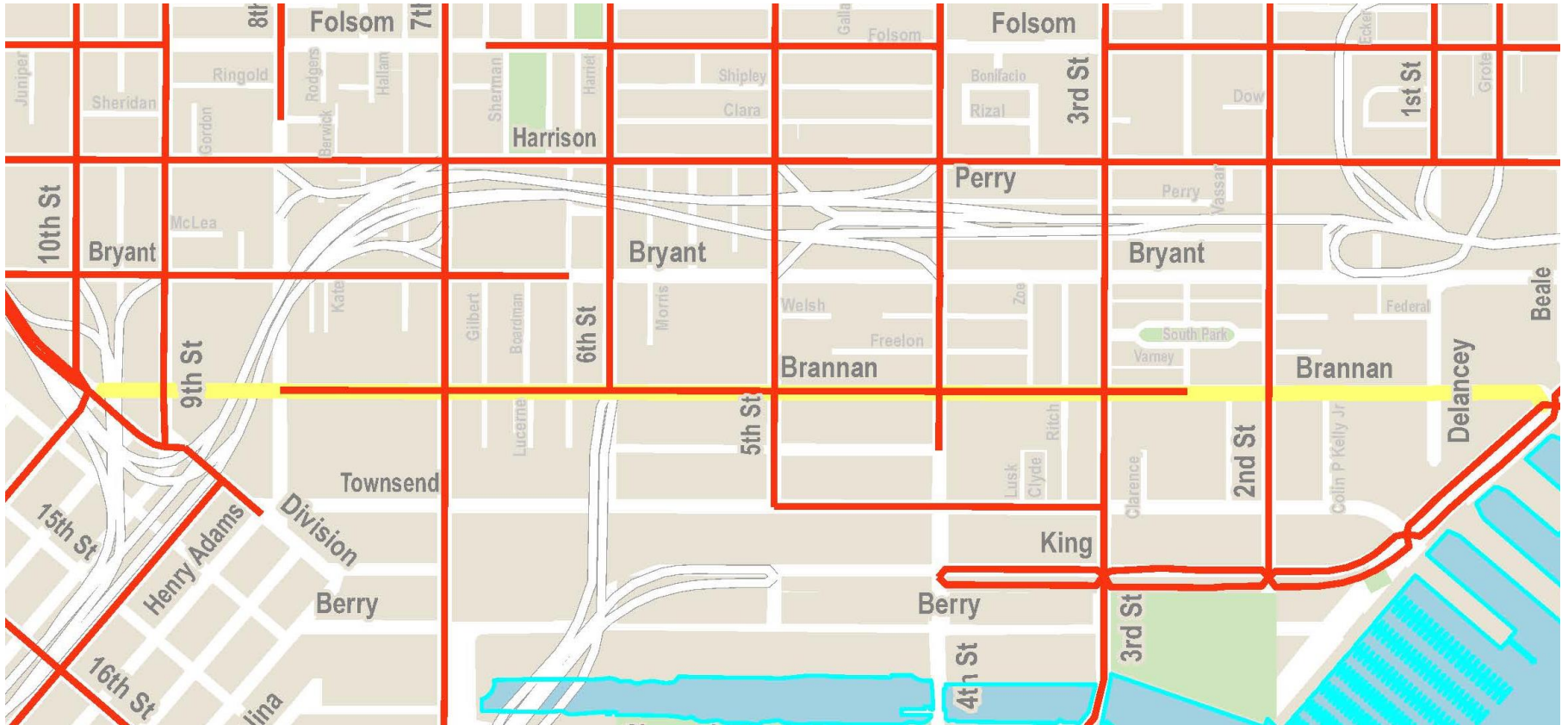

Vision Zero High Injury Network

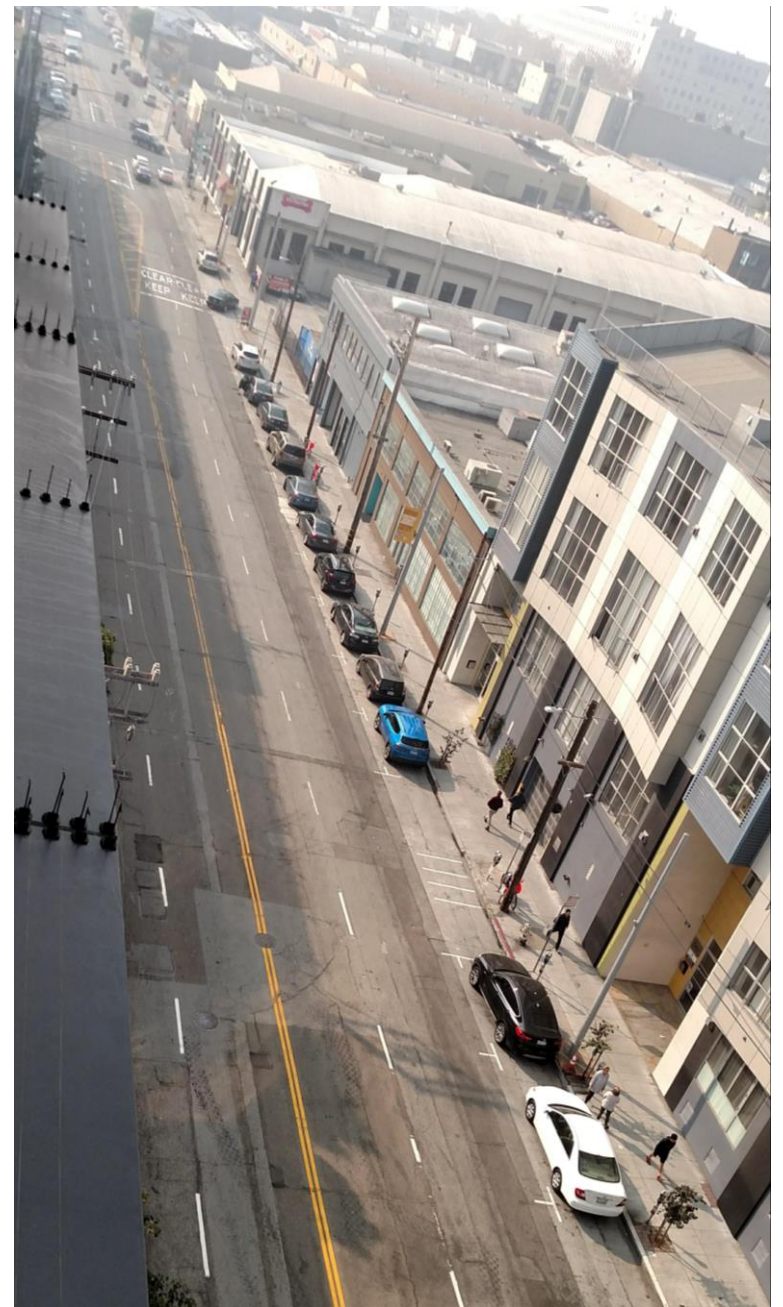


Project Corridor

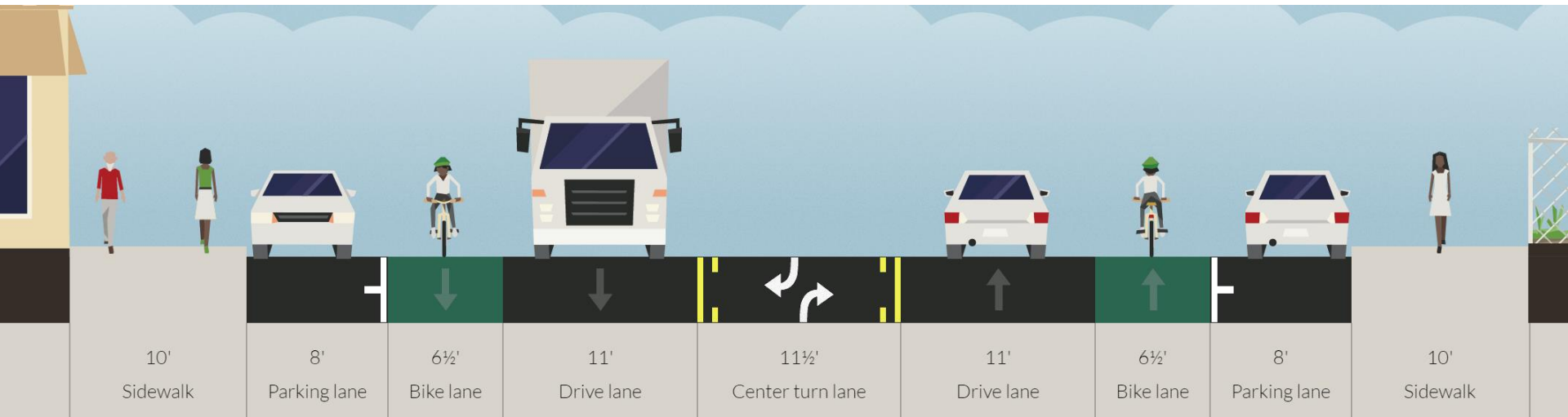


Project Goals

- Improve comfort & safety for all who travel on Brannan Street
- Improve Brannan Street to meet current pressing safety needs
- Adapt Brannan Street to meet transportation needs now and into the near future

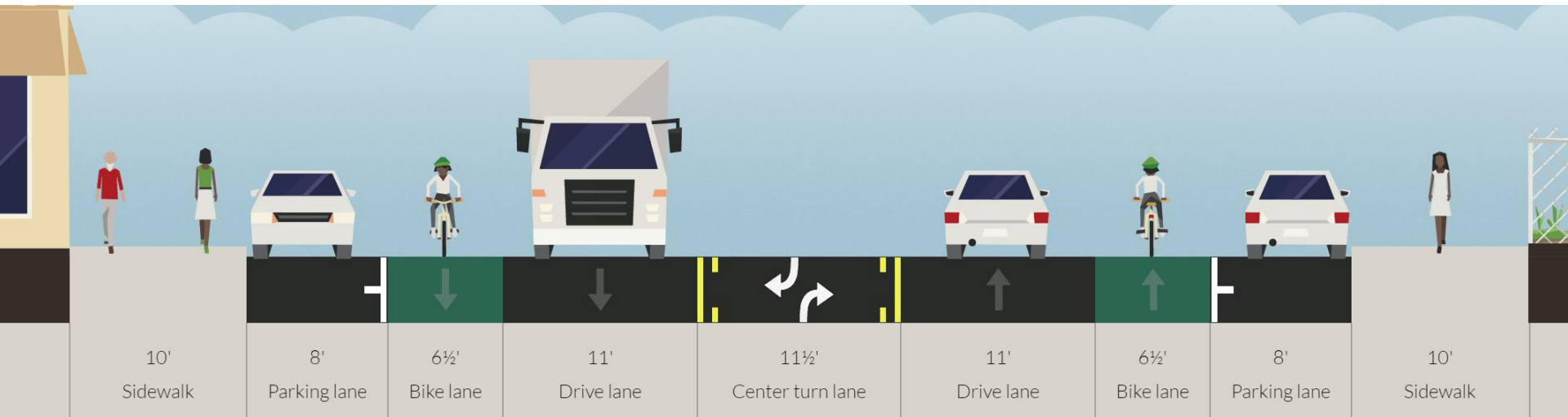


Safety Improvements



- Travel lane reduction (4 to 3)
- Bike lanes in both directions
- Pedestrian improvements: advanced limit lines, continental crosswalks, leading pedestrian intervals, more visibility at intersections
- Traffic signal timing changes

Road Diet Benefits



- Reduces number and severity of crashes
- Does not significantly change intersection capacity
- Reduces speeding and speed differential
- Simpler side-street vehicle movements

Community Engagement

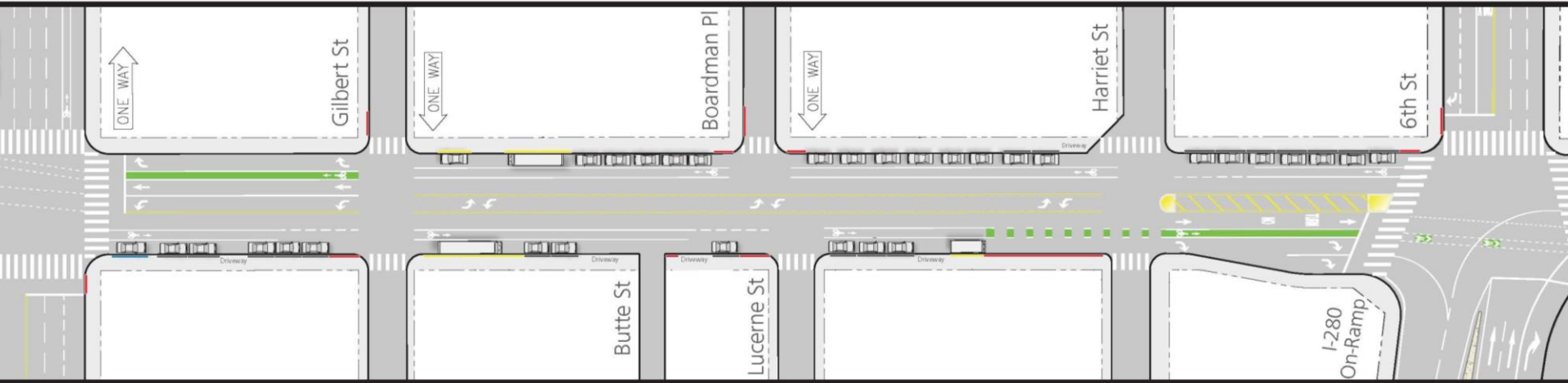
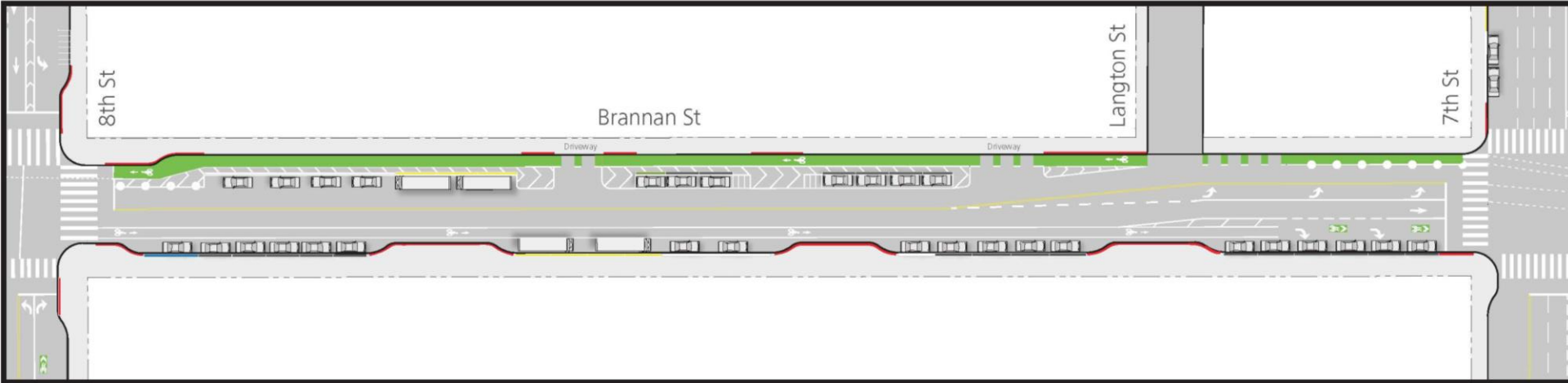
- Door-to-door conversations about project and parking & loading changes

- Over 20 public comments at Engineering Public Hearing



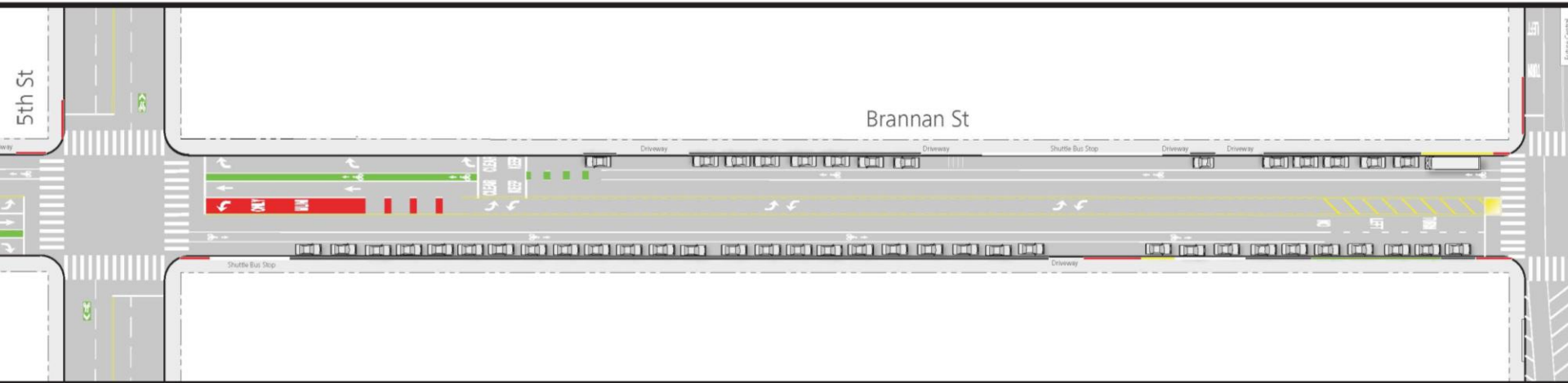
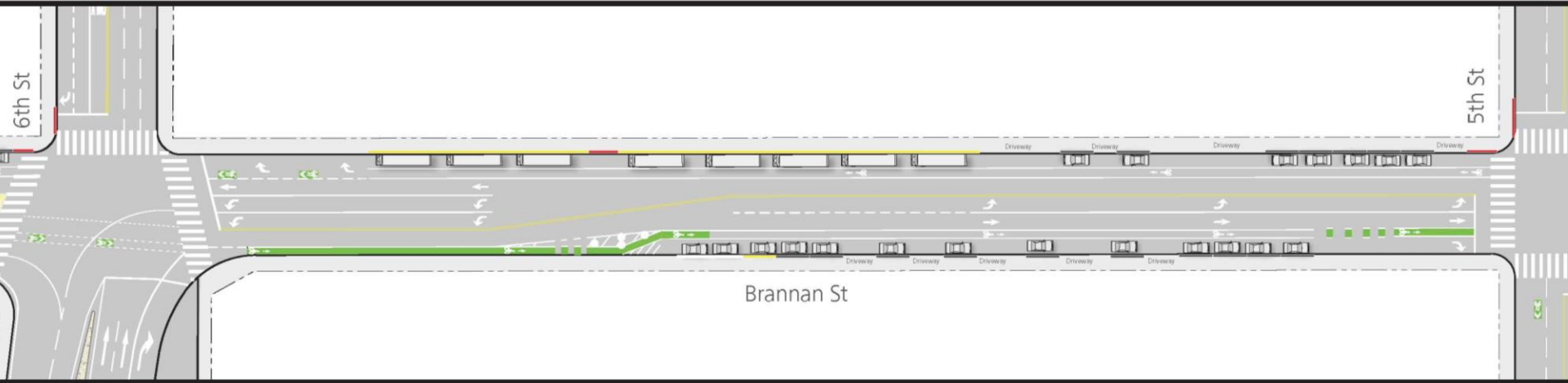
