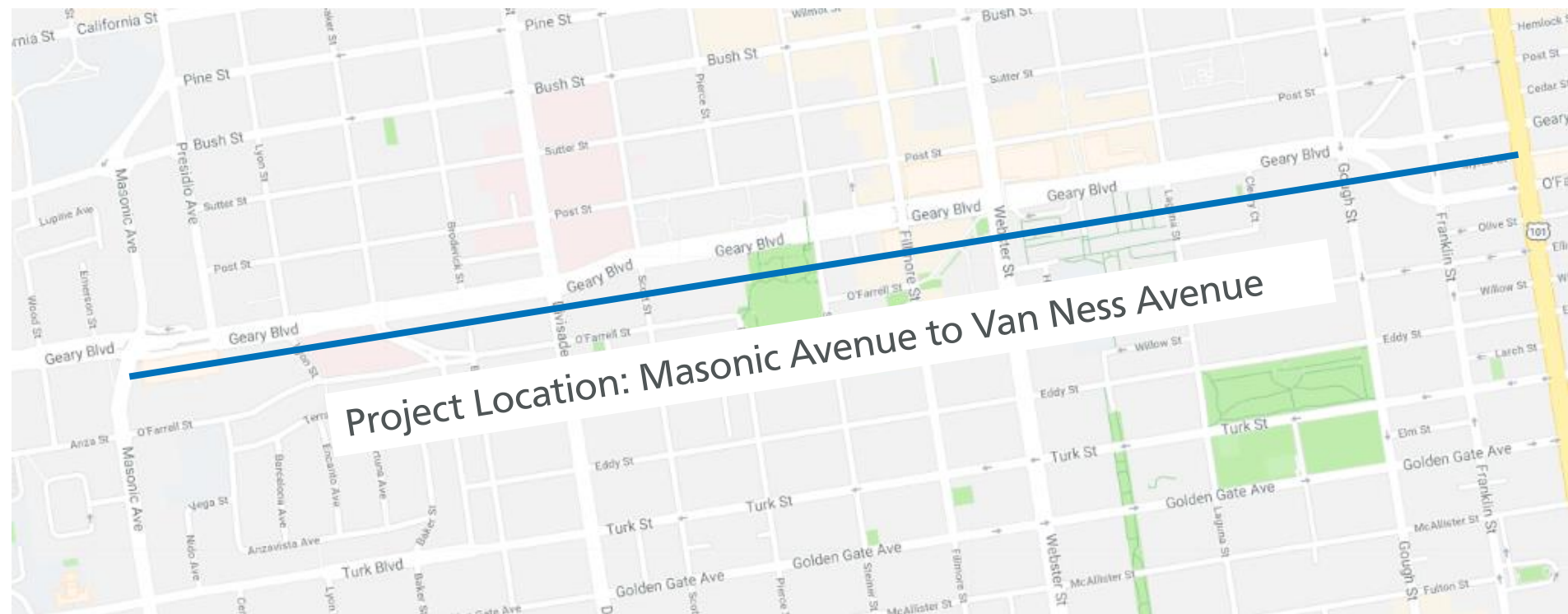

7. Geary Water/Sewer contract update with SFPUC and JMB Construction

WW-674 Geary Boulevard Sewer and Water Improvements



- Work is occurring between Masonic and Steiner
- Overall utilities scope 8% complete

7. Geary Water/Sewer contract update with SFPUC and JMB Construction

Sewer Main Work

- Rehabilitation or replacement of approximately 1.5 miles of aging sewers
- No service disruption expected
- Status: 5% complete



7. Geary Water/Sewer contract update with SFPUC and JMB Construction



Water Main Work

- Replacement of approximately 2 miles of aging water mains
- Some disruption in service is expected
- Status: 15% complete



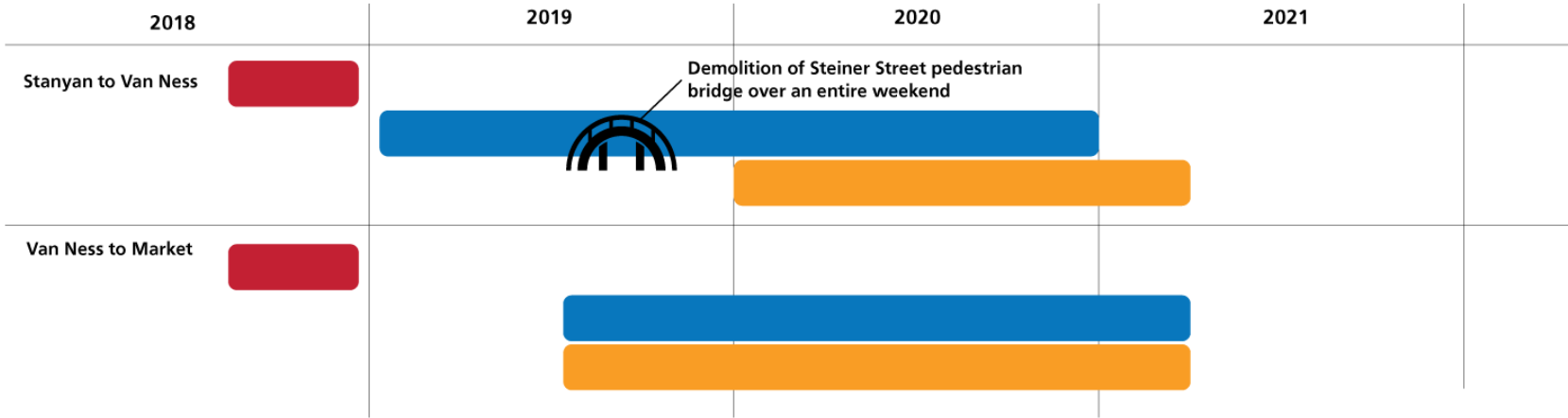

8. Geary Rapid – Implementation update

Overview



Transit and safety treatments

- Bus-only lanes
- Pedestrian safety treatments
- Bus stop changes
- Roadway striping changes

Utility upgrades

- Water main replacement on Geary (Masonic to Market)
- Fiber-optic cable conduits (Stanyan to Gough)
- Sewer main replacement (primarily Masonic to Van Ness)

Major transit and safety improvements

- Bus bulbs
- Upgraded traffic signals
- Pedestrian bulbs
- Roadway repaving (Masonic to Van Ness)

8. Geary Rapid – Implementation update

Van Ness to Market Street Contract (“East”)

- Advertised by SF Public Works on 2/15/2019
- Engineer’s estimate: \$6.4 million including water main scope
- Lowest bidder \$1.5M over the \$2.8M estimate (154%) for SFMTA’s scope of work.
- Moving forward to award contract and begin construction

8. Geary Rapid – Implementation update

Signal phasing changes at Geary/Laguna implemented April 11



- Some additional congestion for cars traveling on Laguna
- Received positive feedback as well as comments about Laguna congestion
- 4/18: New right-turn pockets added on Laguna on both sides of Geary
- 4/26: Signal timing adjustments made
- Will continue to monitor and adjust as needed

8. Geary Rapid – Implementation update

Masonic and Fillmore-Webster inbound transit shelters

- Completed permitting process
- Anticipate installation in early Summer 2019
- Power (and therefore NextBus real-time information) will not be available at Fillmore-Webster until construction of the permanent concrete bulbout

8. Geary Rapid – Implementation update

California Pacific Medical Center - Coordinated Work

- Re-paving and re-striping on Geary Street between Polk and Franklin streets complete
- Shelter installed

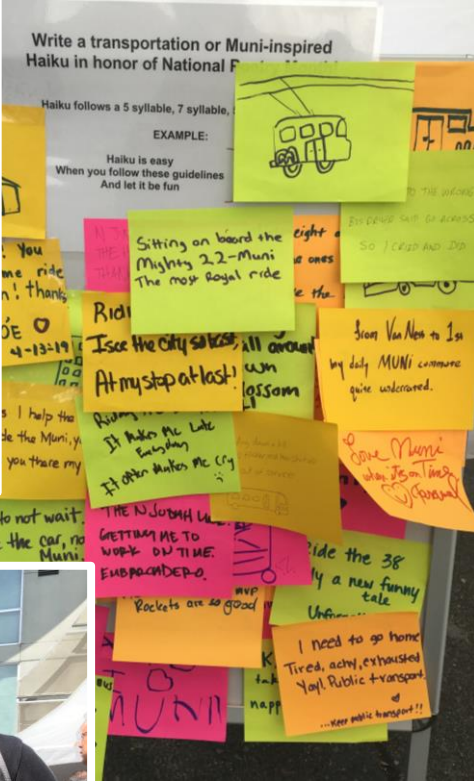
