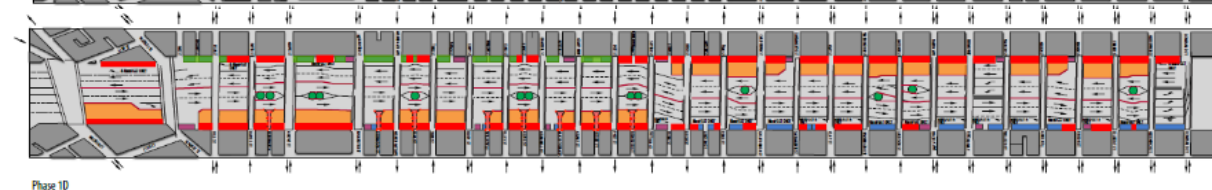


Project Schedule

- Phases 1C and 1D almost complete.

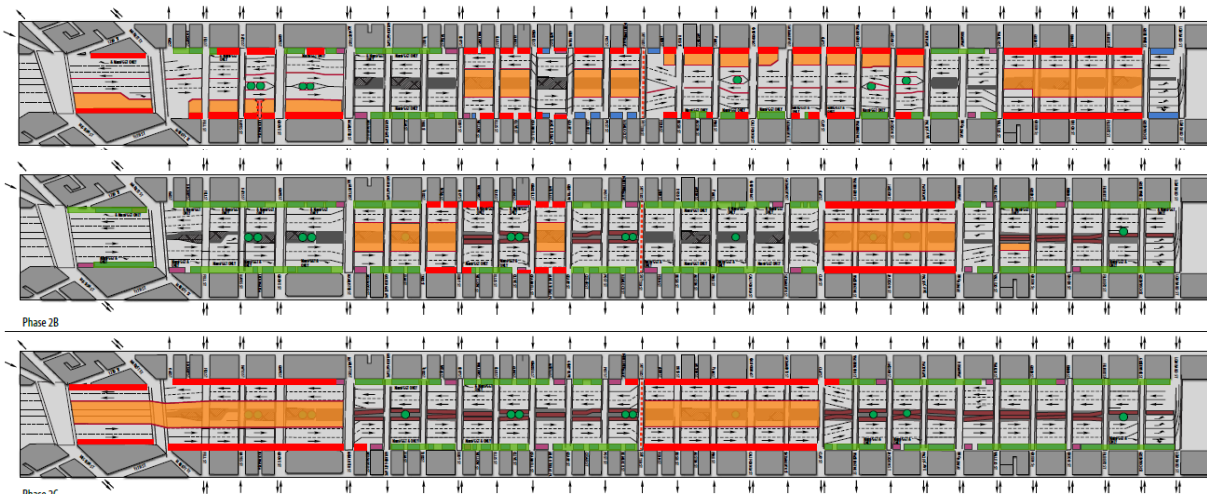

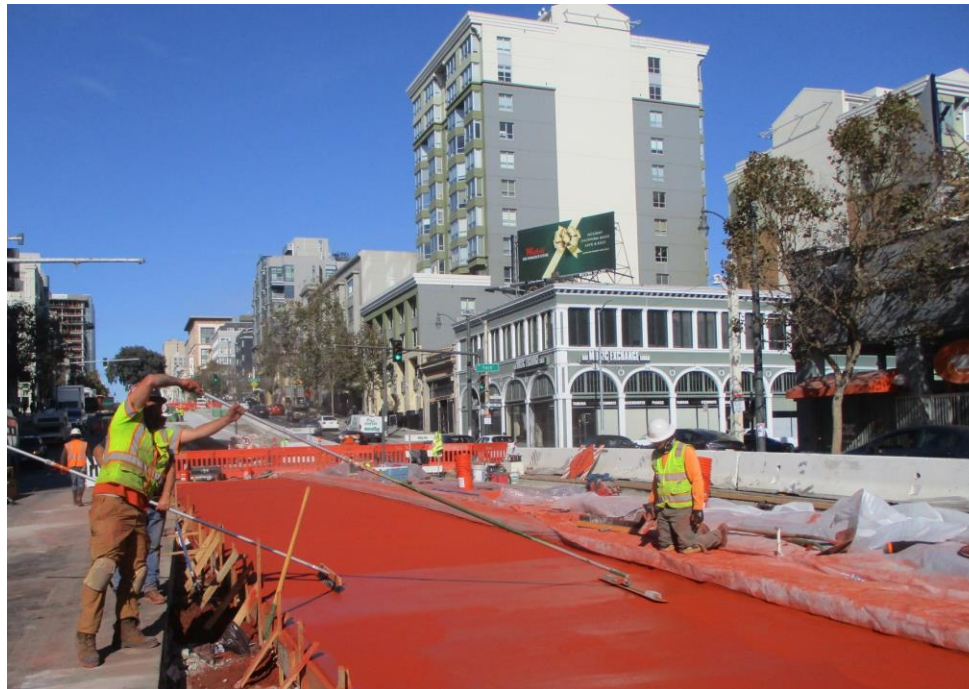

Construction update

- BRT Buildout Phase has begun
 - Construction in middle of the roadway
 - Construction of red transit-only lanes, median islands, landscaping, bus shelters, bulb-outs, pole setting installations



Contract Modification 12

- Compensates contractor for costs related to pedestrian monitoring services in the amount of \$2,589,381, for a total Contract amount not to exceed \$220,507,216, with no time extension.

Staff Updates

- **Directed Business Support Program closed**
 - Funding of \$5,000-\$10,000 available to eligible businesses; currently finalizing eligibility and awarding funds
- **SF Shines Storefront Improvement Program**
 - Grants and design services for businesses to improve their storefronts, including COVID-19 safety measures
 - Administered by OEWD, details at sf.gov/sf-shines

Staff Updates

Geary Rapid Project

As part of the [Geary Rapid Project](#), work to replace aging water and sewer lines between Masonic Street and Van Ness Avenue, in coordination with the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, continues. Transportation improvements, including upgraded traffic signals and streetlights, sidewalk extensions at bus stops and intersection corners, improved median refuges and roadway repaving, have also started and are being managed by San Francisco Public Works.

The Lombard Street Vision Zero Project includes constructing pedestrian safety and transit performance enhancements as well as utility improvements on US 101 (Lombard Street at Richardson Avenue) between Francisco Street and Van Ness Avenue.

- Project completion scheduled June 2020. CalTrans to repave the roadway at a later date.
