RESOLUTION No. 220628-064

WHEREAS, Under Section 8A.104 of the Charter, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) Board of Directors succeeded to the powers of the Mayor, City Human Resources Director, and the Board of Supervisors with respect to collective bargaining for employees in service critical classifications; and,

WHEREAS, The current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between SFMTA and International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM), Local 1414 expires on June 30, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, The SFMTA and IAM Local 1414 negotiated amendments to the MOU that were ratified by the membership of IAM Local 1414 on May 4, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, On May 25, 2022, the SFMTA, under authority delegated by the Planning Department, determined that the MOU with IAM Local 1414 is not defined as a “project” under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Sections 15060(c) and 15378(b); and,

WHEREAS, A copy of the CEQA determination is on file with the Secretary to the SFMTA Board of Directors, and is incorporated herein by reference; and,

WHEREAS, The new MOU, which shall be effective July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2024, and all other required information was publicly disclosed in accordance with Charter Section 8A.104(r) on May 31, 2022, and on June 6, after identifying a provision that did not conform to the tentative agreement, staff posted a conformed copy of the new agreement and all other required information on-line, and on June 7, the conformed copy was publicly disclosed and is on file with the Secretary of the SFMTA Board of Directors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the SFMTA Board of Directors does hereby adopt a successor Memorandum of Understanding between the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency and the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, Local 1414 setting wages, benefits and working conditions for represented employees for the term July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2024; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the SFMTA Board of Directors hereby authorizes the Director of Transportation to make non-substantive ministerial or administrative corrections to the MOU and to execute the MOU.
