Muni is working on multiple fronts to make getting around San Francisco safer, faster and more reliable for our customers. As part of this effort, we're creating a Rapid Network that will improve the frequency and reliability on lines and routes that carry 70% of customers, including the 5 Fulton. Several changes are proposed along the 5 Fulton corridor. These changes will build on those already implemented as part of the 5L Fulton Limited pilot project. Proposed changes include:

- **Replacing all-way STOP signs to reduce Muni delays.**
- **Adding pedestrian safety features including corner bulbs, pedestrian countdown signals and improved crosswalk markings.**

Your feedback is important to refining these proposals. Staff will be on hand at the open house to answer questions and discuss these changes. There will be no presentation.
