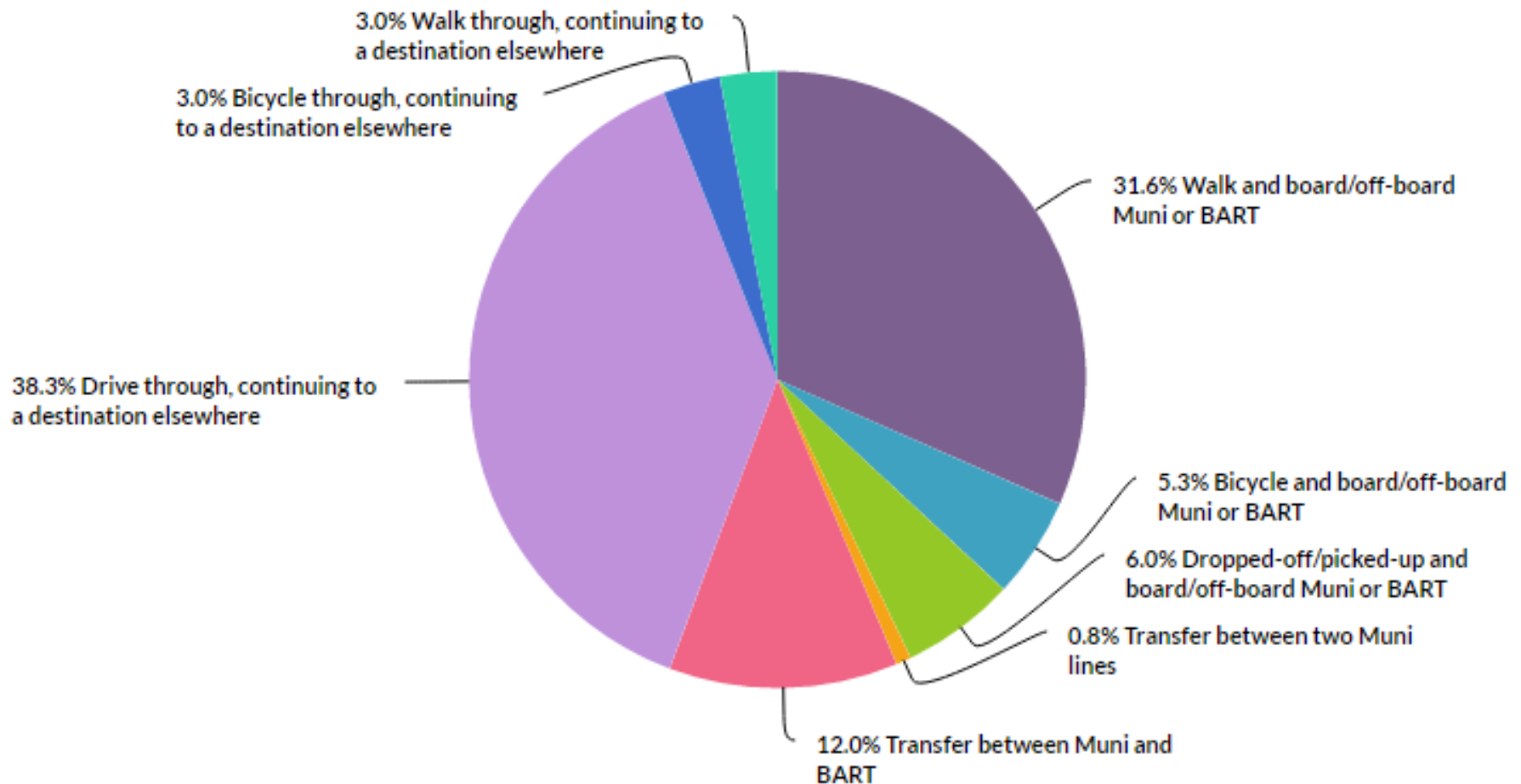

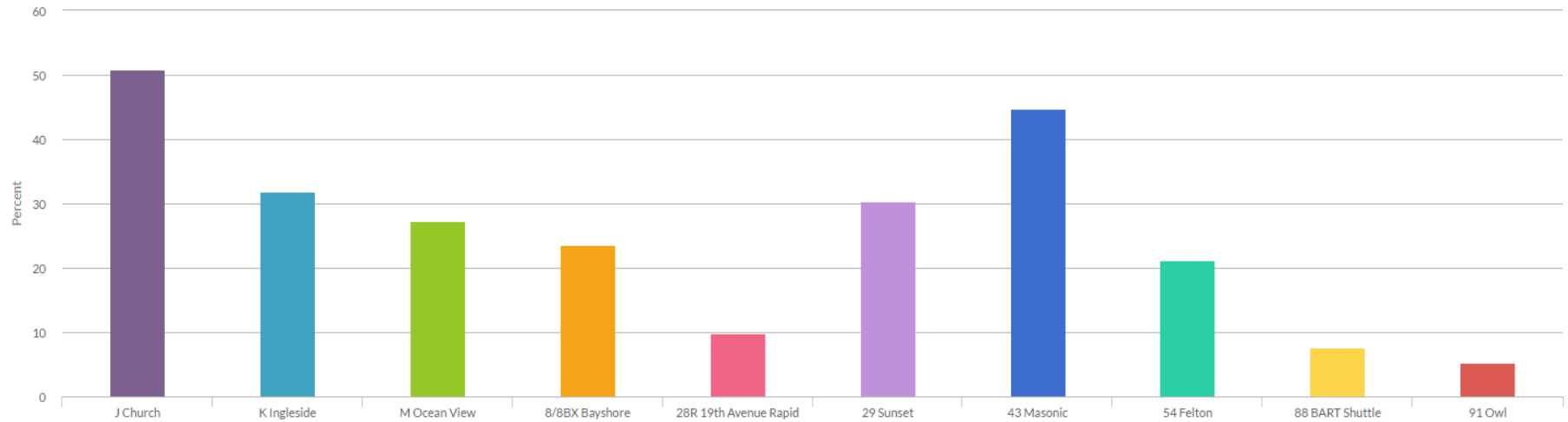

How do you most often use the Geneva Avenue/San Jose intersection area? (please select one)

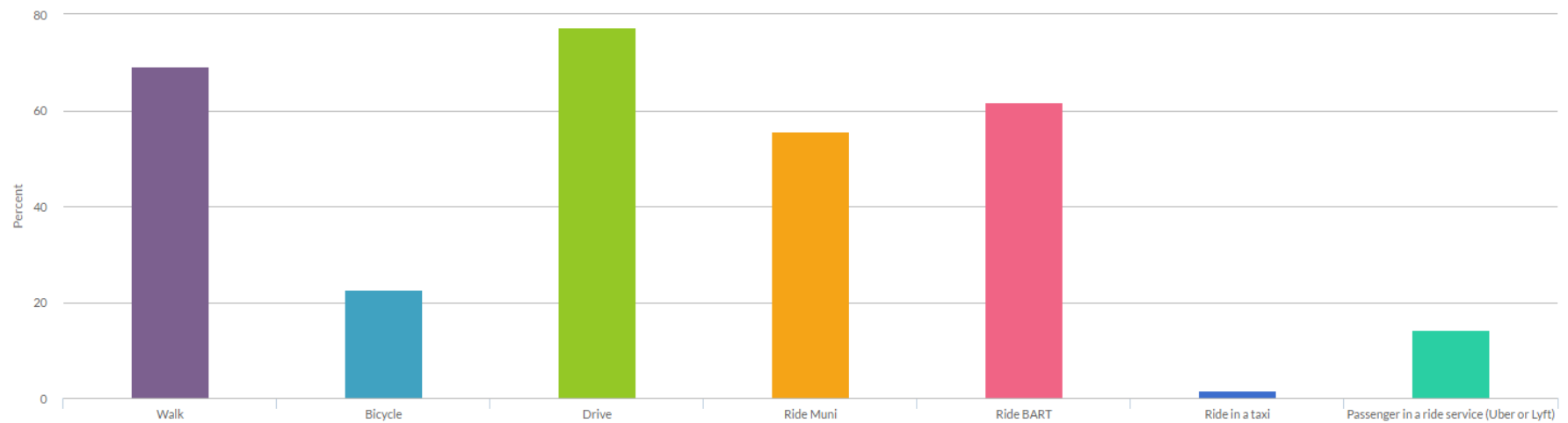

Which Muni lines do you board/off-board at the Geneva Avenue/San Jose Avenue intersection area? (select all that apply)

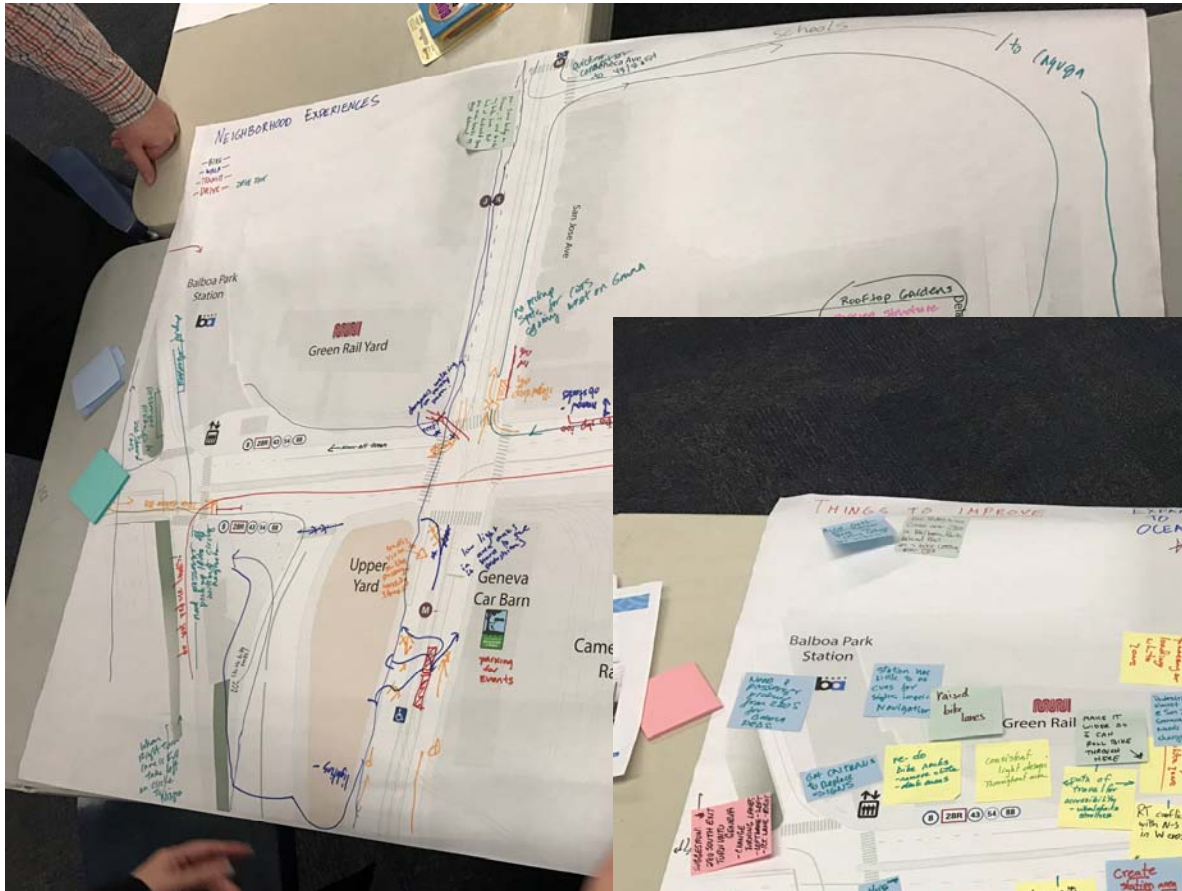


How do you travel through the Geneva Avenue/San Jose Avenue intersection area? (select all that apply)

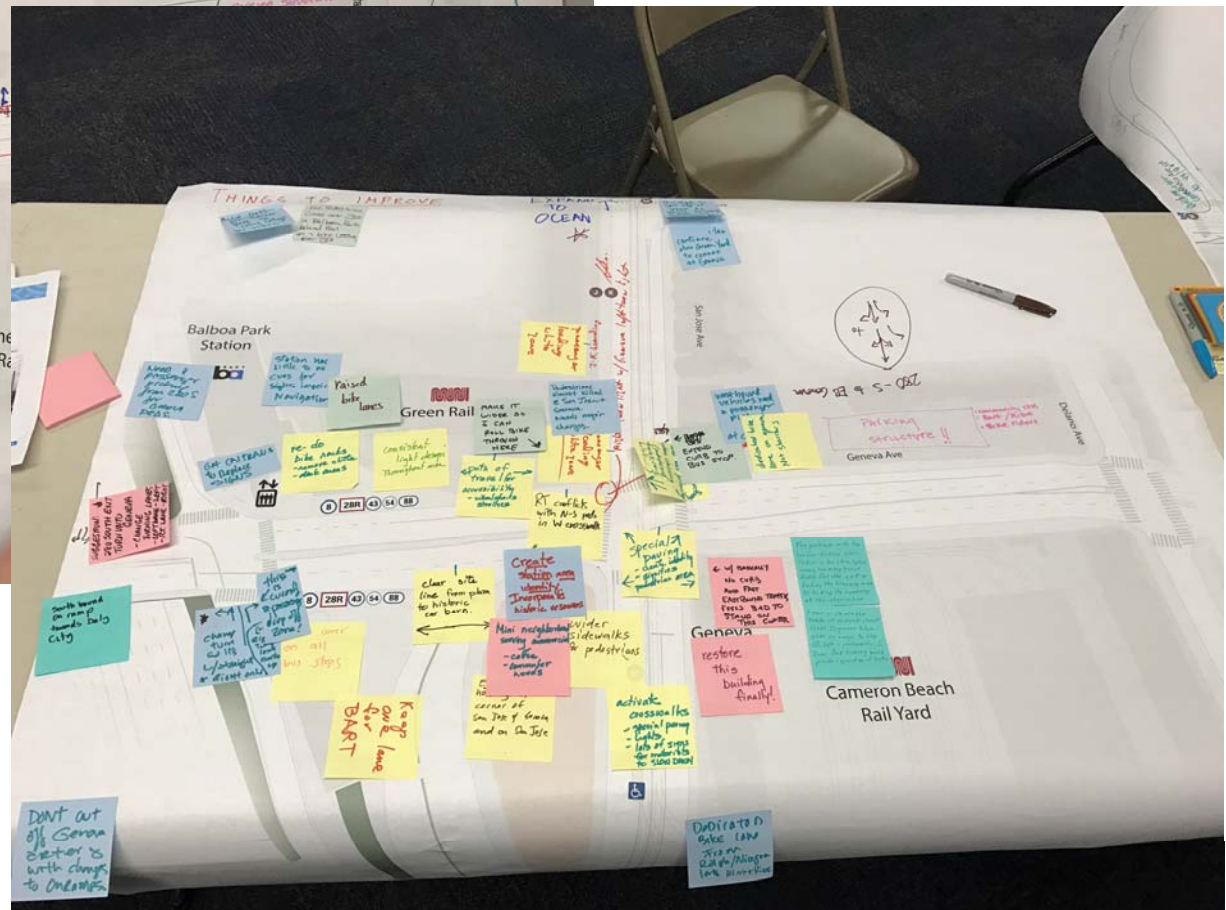




# Map Exercise

# What we Heard

## Pedestrian Concerns

- Need better crossing conditions (especially with turning cars)
- Being vulnerable as a pedestrian
- Connections to schools

## Transit Needs

- Desire for boarding area improvements (including M-Line)
- Enhance connections and access to transit

## Urban Design

- Need for beautification and wayfinding

## Bicycling

- Lack of existing facilities

## Traffic

- General congestion and confusion

# What we Heard

“Boarding situation for muni light rail lines is dangerous. Bicycling situation is treacherous. Overall, massive visual confusion due to light rail lines, complicated Muni and BART building designs and complicated traffic patterns makes it difficult to know where to go or what to expect.”

“Pedestrian Safety!!!!”

“Create station area identity. Incorporate historic resources”

“I want to see a higher priority on Muni and walking, and steps to decrease speeding traffic in the region.”

“Wider sidewalks for pedestrians”

“Better biking!”
